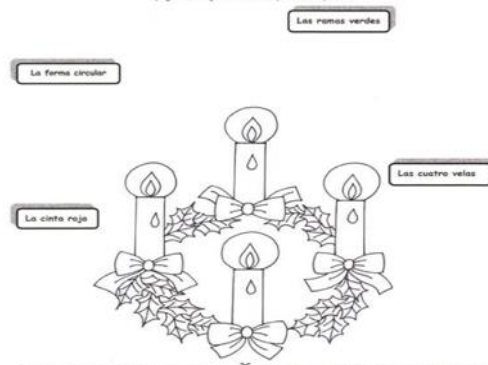

## « Tu vas concevoir et enfanter un fils ; tu lui donneras le nom de Jésus »



Le ton de l'évangile est celui d'un conte populaire. Les contes commencent toujours par : « Il était une fois... », on nous présente les personnages, l'époque, l'endroit et le sujet. Celui-ci arrivera au point culminant du récit, et il y a un dénouement à la fin.

Saint Luc, d'une manière similaire nous raconte, avec un ton simple et accessible, la plus grande l'histoire qui ait jamais existé. Il ne nous présente pas un récit créé par l'imagination, mais une histoire vraie tissée par Dieu lui-même avec la collaboration de l'humanité. Le point culminant est : « Voici que tu vas concevoir et enfanter un fils ; tu lui donneras le nom de Jésus » (Lc 1,31) Ce message nous dit que Noël est proche. Marie, nous ouvrira la porte en collaborant à l'œuvre de Dieu. L'humble demoiselle de Nazareth entend avec étonnement l'annonce de l'ange. Elle prie Dieu d'envoyer Celui qui a été choisi pour sauver le Monde. Dans sa simplicité, Elle était loin de se douter, que c'est Elle que Dieu choisirait pour mener à bien son plan.

Marie vit des moments très intenses, dramatiques, dans son cœur : Elle tenait à rester vierge ; Dieu lui propose désormais une maternité. Elle ne comprend pas : « Comment cela va-t-il se faire ? » (Lc 1,34) demande-t-elle ? L'ange lui dit alors que sa virginité et sa maternité ne se contredisent pas, mais que par la force de l'Esprit Saint elles s'accordent parfaitement. Cela ne veut pas dire qu'elle comprend mieux avec cette explication. Mais cela lui suffit, car elle comprend que le prodige qui est sur le point de se réaliser sera l'œuvre de Dieu : « Car rien n'est impossible à Dieu » (Lc 1,38). Et c'est pour cela qu'elle répond : « que tout se passe pour moi selon ta parole » (Lc 1,38). Qu'elle s'accomplisse ! Que cela se fasse ! Fiat ! Oui. Une acceptation totale de la Volonté de Dieu, sans trop comprendre, mais sans réserve ni conditions.

A cet instant même, « le Verbe s'est fait chair, il a habité parmi nous » (Jn 1,14). Le conte populaire devient alors la réalité la plus divine et la plus humaine. Paul VI écrit en 1974 : « Marie est la réponse que Dieu donne au mystère de l'homme ; et Elle est la question que
