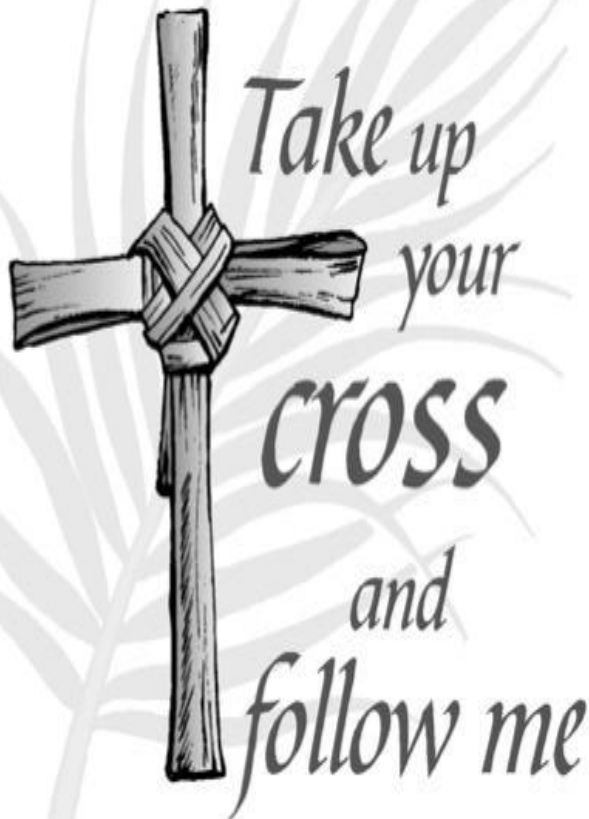

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The readings of this Sunday speak of love of God and for God. Some description of that love is very similar to description of human love, I guess being the part of human experience it should be this way. It is interesting, how human persons we perceive the love of God with our senses. Bible describes to us, how different people responded to it on the extent of centuries.



In the first reading Prophet Jeremiah speaks of being duped by the Lord, that translates into being seduced, deceived, tricked; but he quickly explains, that he let himself into it willingly, as God's attraction was too strong to resist, even against the human ridicule. Jeremiah's relationship with God can be felt as a burning fire in his heart, in his bones, hard to endure.

The psalmist speaks of his body longing and thirsting for God, as dry land does for water. His soul clinging to God for protection and life, rejoicing in God's glory and praising God.

St. Paul urges his readers, to offer themselves as a living sacrifice, spiritual worship to God, as something that is good, perfect and pleasing to God.

In the Gospel, Jesus explains to his disciples, what he is going to endure for the love of them and for the salvation of all people. Jesus is not saying how nice is his love, how beautiful and romantic is his plan of salvation, but he mentions how dramatic and radical that love is. But for Peter it seems too much, and even unnecessary. It should never happen to you, he says to Jesus.

How wrong is Peter's statement we learn from Jesus' harsh answer to Peter: "Get behind me, Satan!" Than Jesus states to Peter and other disciples, how sacrificial love must be. He says: "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." All this, even to the point of losing one's life. Who of us wants to embrace the vision of love presented here by Jesus??? Who of us remembers, that love is more in self sacrifice, than in self gratification??? It goes against our human likes and against our human notion of love as something predominantly joyful and pleasant, self satisfying.

Jesus' lesson of love includes in it a necessary sacrifice of self for the sake of those whom we love. The recompense for true love, will be collected by us at the end of times, when he invites us to his Father's glory. Jesus forces us to widen our perspective beyond this life. If it was only this life that mattered, it would always end in defeat, because this life ends with death. It would mean that death kills everything, even love. But God is the origin of love and of life, before we ever existed, and God is the destiny of our life and our love even after our death. So Jesus is revealing to us, that love goes further than death, and our death to self is the ultimate test of it in life.

*Let's fall in love with God, His love is eternal. His love is forever!!!
How is your love ???*

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos,

Las lecturas de este Domingo hablan del amor de Dios y por Dios. Alguna descripción de ese amor es muy similar a la descripción del amor humano, supongo que el ser parte de la experiencia humana debería ser así. Es interesante, como las personas percibimos el amor de Dios con nuestros sentidos. La Biblia nos describe como diferentes personas respondieron a ella a lo largo de los siglos.



En la primera lectura el Profeta Jeremias habla de ser engañado por el Señor, que se traduce en ser seducido, engañado; pero rápidamente explica que se dejó llevar por ello voluntariamente, ya que la atracción de Dios era demasiado fuerte para resistir, incluso contra el la ridiculez humana. La relación de Jeremias con Dios se puede sentir como un fuego ardiente en su corazón, en sus huesos, difícil de soportar.

El salmista habla de su cuerpo anhelando y sediento de Dios, como la tierra seca lo hace por el agua. Su alma se aferra a Dios en busca de protección y vida, regocijándose en la gloria de Dios y alabando a Dios.

San Pablo insta a sus lectores a ofrecerse a si mismos como sacrificio vivo, culto espiritual a Dios, como algo bueno, perfecto y agradable a Dios.

En el Evangelio, Jesus explica a sus discípulos lo que va a sufrir por amor a ellos y por la salvación de todas las personas. Jesus no esta diciendo cuan lindo es su amor, cuan hermoso y romántico es su plan de salvación, pero menciona cuan dramático y radical es ese amor. Pero para Pedro parece demasiado, e incluso innecesario. Nunca debería pasarte a ti, le dice a Jesus.

Cuan equivocada es la declaración de Pedro que aprendemos de la dura respuesta de Jesus a Pedro: “¡Apartate de mi, Satana!” De lo que Jesus les dice a Pedro y otros discípulos, cuan sacrificado debe ser el amor. Dice: “Quien quiera venir en pos de mi, debe negarse a si mismo tomar sus cruz y seguirme.” Todo esto, hasta el punto de perder la vida. ¿Quién de nosotros quiere abrazar la visión del amor presentada por Jesus? ¿Quién de nosotros recuerda que el amor es mas en sacrificio que en gratificación? ¿Va en contra de nuestros gustos y en contra de nuestra noción humana del amor como algo predominantemente alegre y placentero, auto satisfactorio.

La lección de amor de Jesus incluye un necesario sacrificio de uno mismo por el bien de otros a quienes amamos.

La recompensa por el amor verdadero, será recogida por nosotros al final de los tiempos, cuando el nos invite a la gloria de su Padre. Jesus nos invita a ampliar nuestra perspectiva mas alla de esta vida. Si solo importara esta vida, siempre terminaría en derrota, porque esta vida termina con la muerte. Significaría que la muerte lo mata todo, incluso el amor. Pero Dios es el origen del amor y de la vida, antes de que saliéramos, y Dios es el destino de nuestra vida y nuestro amor incluso después de nuestra muerte. Así que Jesus nos esta revelando que el amor va mas alla de la muerte, y nuestra muerte a nosotros mismos es la prueba definitiva en la vida.

Enamoremos a Dios, Sus amor es eterno. Su amor es para siempre!!!

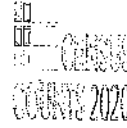

Bereavement Support Groups

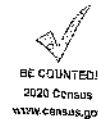
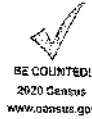
