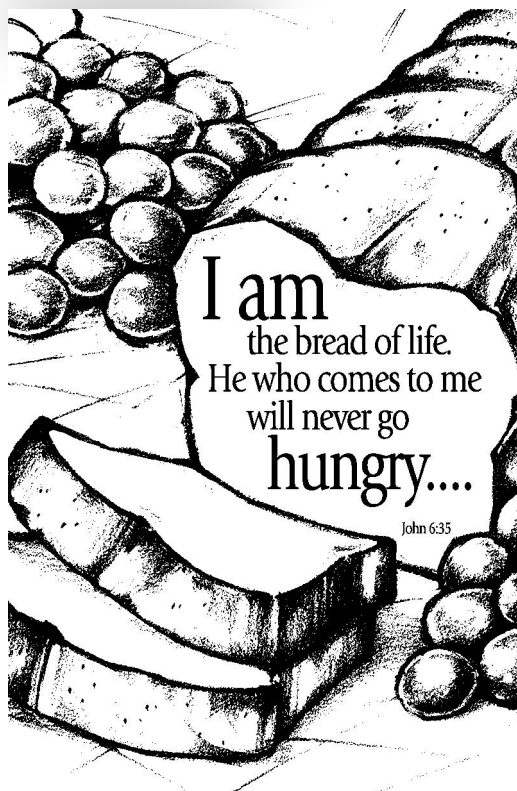

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

PARROQUIA SANTA LUCIA: PARROCO Fr. MILCIADES AYALA.

La Parroquia está asentada en el barrio Santa Lucía de Villarrica una ciudad situada a 176 km de Asunción, capital de la República del Paraguay.

Resumen de un artículo escrito sobre la Parroquia Santa Lucía por el periodista *Juan Carlos Decoud*, publicado en Abccolor, un diario de ámbito nacional en Paraguay.

Santa Lucía es un barrio entre otros de la periferia de Villarrica. Pero en poco más de una década, este vecindario ganó un desarrollo impetuoso liderado por la parroquia del lugar, que agregó a su labor religiosa una pluralidad de obras de promoción social. Con trabajo y testimonio, Santa Lucía logró la confianza de vecinos, compatriotas y extranjeros.

La incapacidad de las instituciones públicas muchas veces es compensada por organizaciones de la sociedad civil, como las iglesias.

Las iniciativas se fueron multiplicando con el correr de los años y surgieron como respuestas desde la fe a problemáticas de la zona.

1. Hogar de ancianos: La Parroquia Santa Lucía adquirió fama como refugio de varios ancianos abandonados y, consecuentemente, la demanda de albergue creció paulatinamente. Alberga actualmente a 29 personas de la tercera edad, de las cuales 21 son mujeres. Casi todos los residentes sufren dolencias que les impiden caminar con normalidad, por lo que requieren de constante cuidado. El Estado apenas cubre una parte de los gastos.

2. Dispensario médico: El acceso a la salud se ve afectado en Paraguay por una deficiencia histórica en las políticas y la voluntad de los gobernantes. Por lo tanto, la comunidad de la parroquia Santa Lucía también detectó la necesidad de construir un dispensario médico para las personas de escasos recursos. Atiende actualmente a más de 300 pacientes por semana. Prioriza la salud de la mujer; entre sus servicios se encuentra un programa de prevención y diagnóstico del cáncer de mamas y cuello uterino; una de las principales causas de mortalidad de la mujer en la zona. Como parte del proyecto, este centro asistencial atendió a más de 12.000 mujeres desde su creación.

3. Farmacia Social: Entre otras prestaciones, provee medicación gratuita a más de 200 enfermos de epilepsia. De esta manera, casi veinte comunidades rurales de Villarrica lograron mayor acceso a la salud.

4. Educación: Casi 500 adolescentes suman bullicio al Colegio de la parroquia Santa Lucía. La mayoría vive a kilómetros de distancia y llega caminando para poder estudiar. Los jóvenes provienen, mayoritariamente, de zonas rurales y de familias con pocos recursos.

5. Hogar para mujeres jóvenes de escasos recursos: Después de la detección de una cantidad creciente de mujeres jóvenes con deseos frustrados de estudiar carreras de nivel universitario, se generó el proyecto de la residencia que hoy alberga a 18 chicas.

6. Radio Comunitaria Parroquial: También cuentan con una radio comunitaria, la Santa Lucía FM 107.3

SANTA LUCIA parish: Parish priest Fr. MILCIADES AYALA.

The parish sits in the neighborhood Santa Lucía Villarrica city located 176 km from Asunción, capital of the Republic of Paraguay. Summary of an article written about the Santa Lucía parish by journalist Juan Carlos Decoud, published in Abccolor, a journal of national scope in Paraguay.

Saint Lucía is one neighborhood among others on the periphery of Villarrica. But in little more than one decade, this neighborhood won an impetuous development led by the parish of the place, which added to its religious work a plurality of works of social promotion. With work and testimony, Santa Lucía achieved the trust of neighbors, countrymen and foreigners. The inability of the public institutions often is compensated by organizations of civil society, such as churches.

The initiatives were multiplying with the passing of the years and emerged as responses from faith to problems in the area.

1. Senior citizen housing: the parish of Santa Lucía acquired fame as a refuge for several abandoned elders and, as a result, the demand for hostels grew gradually. It is currently home to 29 seniors, of which 21 are women. Almost all residents suffer from ailments that prevent them from walking normally, therefore they need constant care. The State covers just a portion of the expenses.

2. Medical clinic: access to health is affected in Paraguay by a historical deficiency in the policy and the will of the rulers. Therefore, the community of Saint Lucía Parish also detected the need to build a medical clinic for the poor people. It currently serves more than 300 patients per week. It gives priority to women's health; among its services is a program of prevention and diagnosis of breast and cervical cancer; one of the main causes of death of women in the area. As part of the project, this medical center responded to more than 12,000 women since its inception.

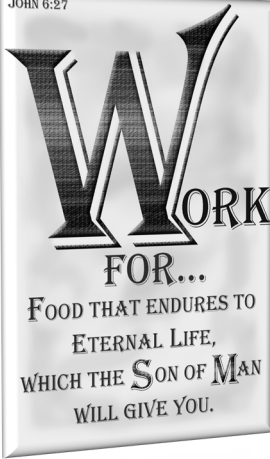
3. Social pharmacy: Among other benefits, provides free medication to more than 200 patients with epilepsy. In this way, nearly twenty rural communities of Villarrica achieved greater access to health.

4. Education: Nearly 500 teenagers attend the Santa Lucía parish school. Most live kilometers away and walk to be able to study. Young people come, mostly from rural areas and from families with very few resources.

5. Home for young women of scarce resources: after detection of a growing number of young women with frustrated desires to study college-level careers, the project of the residence that today is home to 18 girls was generated.

6. Parish community radio: They also have a community radio station, the Saint Lucía FM 107.3

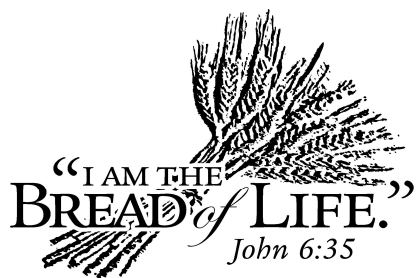
