

23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

It is hard to believe, that we are 16 years into the war on terror initiated by the 9/11/2001 attacks of Islamic terrorists, that changed the course of human history into aggression after aggression by many violent attacks that claimed many lives and injured thousands if not millions of people affected by wars and outbursts of violence. Who could count how many Islamic terror attacks happened in the world since 9/11? We know that they are countless. That continual war changed forever the way we live and think, the way we travel and look at other people. It made us distrustful and reserved, uncertain and vulnerable, unbelieving and sad that such things keep happening. Where did the humanity get from the goals of human solidarity and commitment to peace and development.?

For me as polish national, it is forever inscribed in my polish mind the date of 9/01 that refers to year 1939 when the 2nd World War started by Germany attacking Poland. It brought death and devastation to countless millions of people around the whole world. It changed human history forever, yet we see it didn't make humanity to learn the lesson, we continue the wars as if we didn't have enough of devastation and destruction. I guess it's preferred topic for Hollywood and electronic games - violence and destruction. The world didn't learn lessons from 9/01/1939 and didn't learn them either from 9/11/2001.

Our culture and humanity values are in decline, not speaking about the decline of faith and morality as we see the world overtaken by relativism and privet interest. The world is more selfish and self centered, without forgetting that there are a lot of good and holy people, but the manipulation of culture and politics are driven by selfish people. That, leads us to where we are in Brentwood, we have our own SEPTEMBER MEMORIAL, when on the evening of 9/13 and than on evening of 9/14/2016 the bodies of two girls, Nilsa and Kayla were found, and what lead to further finding of bodies and gang violence victims. It is hard to believe that it is only a year from those fatal happenings. It feels like years of history past by, but it is only a year in real time. For the families that suffered the loss of their children it must feel like decades of pain and unbelief that their kids are not with us anymore.

My impression is that it is for so long that it is happening, especially that the number of victims was multiplied and it builds up into this place of unsolved pain, that doesn't seem to go away. As we approach those sad September Memorials, we continue to pray for the victims, may their sacrifice inspire us to better our community and our families, may it open our eyes to the reality of our youth and children being affected by street violence and school bullying and peer pressure to conform to certain trends, strange to the faith and family values.

We offer our prayers, sympathy, and help for the families directly affected by those tragic events. As a parish and community, let us search for ways to make more space and give more attention to our children and youth, proposing new ways to make them involved in church and community life. Lord help us to transform this September Memorials into life lessons, so that we would not have to repeat them again. Do you have solutions to those problems ? Let's pray and do what we can to continue to educate our children and youth.

On September 14th is as well the Feast of the Exultation of the Cross, and on the 15th is the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. Is that coincidence? When will we finish the lessons of The Cross? Or when will we begin it? It is a crucial lesson for our lives and this is why the feast of the Blessed Mother is right next to it, as She and The Cross are inseparable. Do we want to be inseparable from the Blessed Mother and from the Cross? What is the meaning of The Cross for our lives ? What is our cross and how do we carry it? Do we really have to learn the lesson of the Cross in our lives? Is there Resurrection without The Cross? How come that happiness stands next to the cross?

It is incomprehensible to the human mind, it is called the paradox of the Gospel, something that is opposed in itself. stands together. Life and death. Light and darkness. Beginning and end. Suffering and happiness.

Today's Gospel speaks about the brotherly correction. Yes, we need to correct each other when we make mistakes or we make something wrong, but first of all we need to make sure that we are right where we supposed to be. The example speaks much louder than words, which supported by love can make the whole difference. The Gospel ends with the promise: "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

Let's take that promise and stand by each other always, so we will have the Lord on our side in whatever we do, so maybe than we will be able to understand and support each other in all circumstances of life. Let's pray together as we have common needs, hopes and goals.

May God bless all who carry the crosses in their lives, and may we all be able to stand by them with compassion and love.

God bless everyone !!! God bless Brentwood !!! God bless Saint Anne's !!!
