

All the baskets were given out before Easter and I know the children were delighted to receive them. Thank you to all!

When items are available at our outreach, we give our clients gently used clothing, towels and bedding. Any donated clothing or bedding should be washed or dry cleaned for sanitary reasons. Our clients are very grateful for these extra items. All donations are truly appreciated by those who cannot afford to purchase them on their own.

Pierre définit la condition sacerdotale du baptise.
