## Fourth Sunday of Easter



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

***“I am a good shepherd. A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. “***

This is what Jesus literally did at Easter time, his Passover was to change everyone's life and death. Already in his time of proclamation of the coming of God's Kingdom, Jesus was promising eternal life to those who believed in him, but it was hardly understood as we had seen with the disciples not being able to recognize that the Passion, Crucifixion and Death were necessary way of achieving the goal of Resurrection. They were confused and lost about it, and it took them considerable amount of time and Jesus apparitions after Resurrection, before they reconciled with those facts.

The 4th Sunday of Easter it is called a Sunday of a Good Shepherd. It refers to the Gospel when Jesus calls himself with that name. This parable becomes a literal expression of what happened to Jesus, and he invites us to follow him in life, so that he would be ours in death with the gift of the resurrection. Jesus is the Shepherd, yet he became as well the lamb who was sacrificed to redeem the flock.

The only thing that Jesus is asking of us is the courage of faith. Faith that follows the voice of the Shepherd and lives by accomplishing the works of love. To live with the perspective of resurrection, is to live doing good for oneself and for others; it is to live sharing the promise and hope of salvation.

I have a couple of friends, a married couple, that for 10 years worked different shifts. He was working during the nights, and she was working during the day. They were overlapping early in the morning or early in the evening. They took care of the kids and of the house as it was necessary. But when the husband changed the job and now both worked during the day, they started to spend more time together, and than they realized that there are many things about each other that were irritating them. They would say to each other - why do you do this, or why that way not the other ? Simply they each developed their own habits and costumes of ways and situations that the other wasn't aware of, and when it came to evidence it became the source of annoyance and irritation because of lack of knowledge and understanding of each other. But because both of them became aware of that dynamic, they needed to ask the questions and come to know each other again and to accept the differences and each other the way they were. Sometimes they needed to change by accepting the way of the other because it was in some way better or more practical.

Jesus knows everything, he knows the best way, but it is up to you and to me to discover, or to find out from him what is it that way for me. Which is the best way for me to be happy with life, to be happy with myself, to be happy with others. ???

Jesus said: ***“I am the way, the truth and the life, no one comes to the Father except through me “*** - do you believe this ??? Do you know better way ???

Where is the source of your happiness ??? What makes you happy ??? What makes you sad ??? Where do you find a place for Jesus in your life ??? Is He a deciding factor ??? Or He is not a factor at all in your decision making ???

Jesus is a Good Shepherd, He brings peace and joy, He brings health and happiness, He brings meaning to our lives.

Is He your Shepherd ??? God bless everyone!!!

**First Holy Communion:** Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

**Confirmation:** This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

### SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

**Sacrament of the Sick:** Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

**Reconciliation:** The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.

### SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

**Marriage:** Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

**Holy Orders:** Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

### Domingo IV de Pascua

“Yo soy el Buen Pastor, dice el Señor; conozco a mis ovejas y las mías me conocen”, reza el versículo de introducción al Evangelio este domingo. Desde el AT, la figura del “pastor” es muy relevante. En el principio, Dios quiso ser “pastor para su pueblo”, posteriormente esta función recayó sobre los Patriarcas, los Jueces, los Profetas y los Reyes (David y Salomón), hasta llegar al mismo Jesús tal como lo leemos en Jn. 10, 11-18. El rol de pastor es ejercido de forma perfecta por Dios (AT) y por Jesús (NT), pero de manera imperfecta entre quienes antes y después ejercieron o ejercemos esta función, y pues, ser pastor no es una función exclusiva de los Ministros de la Iglesia, sino también de muchos que tienen a su cargo “conducir a otros”: los padres a sus hijos, el catequista a niños y jóvenes (y adultos), el maestro de escuela a sus alumnos, etc., lo importante es “apacentar”, y esto último no quiere decir “alcahuetear”, al contrario el mismo ejercicio de pastorear nos lleva a “jugarnos el afecto con las personas”, muchas veces toca corregir, que esta última acción debe, sin embargo, ser ejercida con mansedumbre y con unción, pues al final de cuentas también todos somos “ovejas” y respondemos a la voz del Buen Pastor.

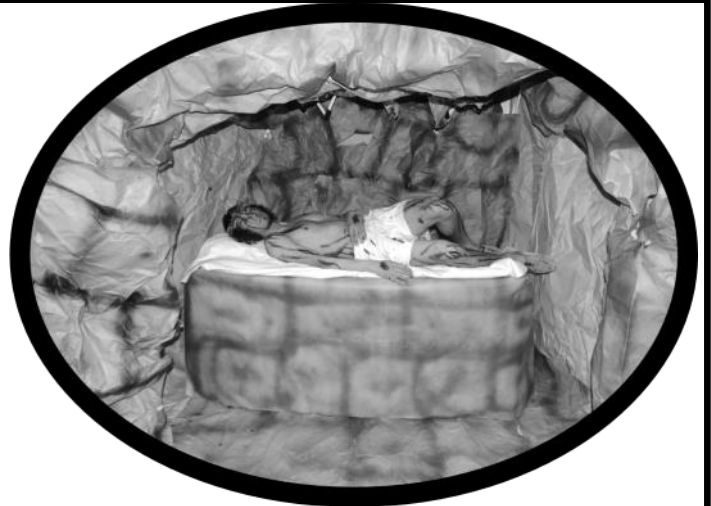

## Fr. Eden Invites All to Join Him in 2019 in Greece

### ITINERARY

**Day 1** Depart JFK for Venice

**Day 2** This afternoon we arrive in Venice and transfer to our hotel by late-afternoon. You will have a short period of free time before our welcome dinner.

**Day 3** We make a pilgrimage to St. Anthony's burial site and Basilica in the morning, where we will also have Mass. Afterwards, we will visit the medieval Scrovegni Chapel, adorned with priceless masterpieces by Giotto. Late afternoon shopping before we return to the hotel for dinner.

**Day 4** Today we explore Venice, with the highlights being St. Mark's Basilica, St. Mark's Square, the Rialto Bridge and walks along the magnificent canals. There will be time for shopping in the mid-afternoon along with an optional excursion to the island of Murano to view and purchase world-famous Murano glass.

**Day 5** We leave for Milan, where upon arrival we will stop at the Milan Cathedral and the monastery of Santa Maria Delle Grazie, where we will view Da Vinci's world-famous painting of the "Last Supper" (ONLY THE FIRST 20 PEOPLE TO SIGN UP CAN BE GUARANTEED A TICKET). Late afternoon shopping among the exclusive shops around the Cathedral.

**Day 6** Departing Milan for Athens, we will have a panoramic tour including Hadrian's Gate, the Ancient Agora and the Roman Catholic Cathedral of Athens before checking into our hotel.

**Day 7** Today is devoted to exploring Athens, including the Acropolis and it's ancient Parthenon. After a tour of the affiliated museum, we continue to Mars Hill, where St. Paul preached of the "Unknown God" the ancient Greeks had been taught to recognize and Syntagma Square, the heart of the capital city. We will have some time late in the afternoon for shopping at the outdoor market.

**Day 8** We visit the Corinth Canal and the ancient city of Corinth to view the Temple of Apollo, the Agora (market) and Bema Seat before taking in the areas where Paul preached the "Good News" to the Corinthians.

**Day 9** Setting sail for a one day cruise, we will choose from a variety of options depending upon the ultimate size of the group and availability. Among the possibilities are a stop in Hydra to see its cobblestone alleys unique architecture and donkeys that still provide public transportation and Aegina to see its pistachio groves and the majestic Temple of Aphaea and the Byzantine monastery of Agios Nektarios.

### Je suis le bon berger

Aujourd'hui, en ce dimanche des vocations, j'ai envie de parler à Jésus de ce troupeau dont il a pris la tête. Il ne va pas si bien. Oui, Jésus, ton troupeau est malade. L'Église est devenue puissante. Tous se disaient chrétiens, ce qui ne les empêchait pas de faire la guerre ! Hélas, ce n'est pas toujours lorsque chrétiens étaient les plus nombreux qu'ils étaient les meilleurs ! À chaque génération, en effet, il faut se convertir. On ne nous met plus à mort, mais notre voix se perd dans l'oubli. Nous pouvons en être désolés et rêver du temps mythique où les églises étaient pleines. Mais peut-être pouvons-nous saisir ce changement de décor comme une chance, une grâce. Ne serions-nous pas appelés à réentendre la voix du berger qui nous appelle chacun, chacune par notre nom ?
