Second Sunday of Easter

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Since the year 2000, the 2nd Sunday of Easter is called Divine Mercy Sunday, when the Holy Father John Paul II canonized St. Faustina and officially designated that Sunday to be called so. The origin of the feast goes back to year 1935, when it was first celebrated publicly in Vilnius, today its country of Lithuania, than it was Poland.

The whole devotion is based on revelations made by Jesus to the nun, Sister Faustina Kowalska, who had those revelations starting on February 22, 1931. Jesus asked her to paint the image of himself, that she had seen. He wanted her to spread his message of mercy and trust.

The message is to make us aware of God's Love and Mercy for all. God wants us to know, that his Mercy is greater than all our sins, and he wants to give it to all who would come to him in trust. So God wants us to ask for his Mercy, he wants us to be merciful to others and he wants us to have trust in him, to abandon ourselves to his merciful love, and so to experience joy and healing of knowing Jesus heart.

Jesus in his revelations to Faustina calls her his secretary, as he was encouraging her to write a diary of what she had received from him. Jesus friendship with Faustina, should teach us how close we can be to him, who is waiting for our response to his love.

There are few aspects of devotion that Jesus proposes to Faustina:

- honoring the Image of Divine Mercy Jesus; it is the image of a risen Jesus, with the hand raised in blessing and open heart from which the red and white rays shine forward, with the words - Jesus I trust in You !
- the Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday: is the 2nd Sunday of Easter celebrated with public veneration of the image of Divine Mercy, with Confession and Indulgence attached to it for those who participate.
- the Chaplet of Divine Mercy; it is a prayer on the rosary beads, that Jesus thought to St Faustina.
- the Novena of Divine Mercy; it is nine days of prayer with special intentions for every day in preparation for the feast of Divine Mercy.
- the Hour of Mercy; it is the prayer at 3 pm every day, in commemoration of Jesus death on the cross.
- the whole message of Jesus is recorded by Saint Faustina in - Diary - the book that she wrote recording all that Jesus wants to teach about his Mercy for all people.

Saint Faustina died of tuberculosis on October 5, 1938 at the age of 33. In her Diary, we find many promises of Jesus to those who will venerate his Image, who will pray the Chaplet, who will promote his Mercy.

John Paul II made Saint Faustina the First Saint of the Third Millennium on Divine Mercy Sunday in year 2000, establishing that feast for the whole Church as a way to face the challenges facing the humanity, and a way to prepare the whole world for the Second Coming of Christ.

Jesus said to Faustina: - Recite the Chaplet.... Whoever recites it will receive great mercy at the hour of death. Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even in the case of the most hardened sinner, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. At the hour of their death, I defend as My own glory every soul that will say this chaplet; or when others say it for dying person, the indulgence is this same. Through the chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask is compatible with My will.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

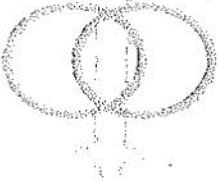

Now that the hectic days of Lent are over, we are fully involved in the joy of the Easter season. These days are marked with a special kind of happiness that should really envelop our entire day. Because of what Jesus did for each of us, fulfill His Father's will, going to the Cross and Rising from the dead, eternal life forever with God and those who love God is a reality open to each of us! ALLELUIA!!!

The Season of Easter is a perfect time for all of us to learn more about our Faith, about the reality of Jesus' Passion, and Resurrection. The Church this special time of learning this moments of Catechesis *Mystagogy*. La Misericordia define nuestra actitud ante cada persona.

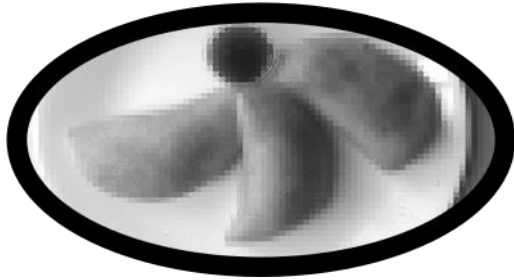
La actitud del amor activo hacia el prójimo es otra condición para recibir gracias.

Mon Seigneur et mon Dieu!

En ce premier dimanche après Pâque, l'Église nous invite à tourner notre attention vers le mystère de la Divine Miséricorde, selon la demande de Jésus lui-même à Sainte Faustyna Kowalska : « Je désire qu'il y ait une fête de la Miséricorde. Je veux que cette image que tu peindras, soit solennellement bénie le premier dimanche après Pâques. Ce dimanche doit être la fête de la Miséricorde ». Pourtant, les textes de ce dimanche ne nous parlent pas directement de la Miséricorde. Ce qui est touchant ici, c'est que Jésus va consentir à la demande de Thomas. En invitant son Apôtre à avancer la main et à la mettre dans son côté, Jésus va bien lui donner une « preuve » tangible de sa résurrection. Mais en même temps, il lui intime de cesser d'être incrédule et de devenir croyant. En fait, Jésus invite Thomas à dépasser une incrédulité qui ne concerne pas le fait de la résurrection mais son interprétation. C'est au niveau du sens à donner à l'événement de la résurrection du Seigneur que Thomas doit passer de l'incrédulité à la foi. Nous comprenons alors que l'acte de foi que Thomas est invité à poser est celui de croire que la miséricorde du Seigneur a triomphé de son péché qui a contribué à clouer Jésus sur la croix. Le Ressuscité l'appelle à sortir d'une culpabilité mortifère pour accueillir la vie nouvelle de son Esprit. Thomas n'était donc pas en quête d'une preuve de la résurrection. En réalité, Thomas demandait un « signe » pour oser croire en la miséricorde. En ce dimanche, contemplons comme Thomas ce Côté ouvert pour nous et écoutons Jésus nous dire : « En ce jour les entrailles de ma miséricorde sont ouvertes, je déverse tout un océan de grâces sur les âmes qui s'approcheront de la source de ma miséricorde ; toute âme qui se confessera et communiera recevra le pardon complet de ses fautes et la remise de leur punition ; en ce jour sont ouvertes toutes les sources divines par lesquelles s'écoulent les grâces ; qu'aucune âme n'ait peur de s'approcher de moi, même si ses péchés sont comme de l'écarlate. »
