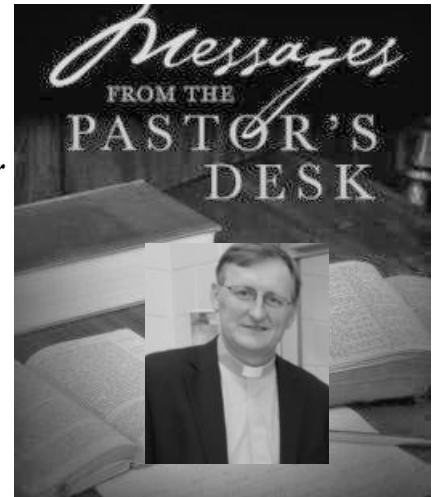
*Happy New Year Everyone !!!*

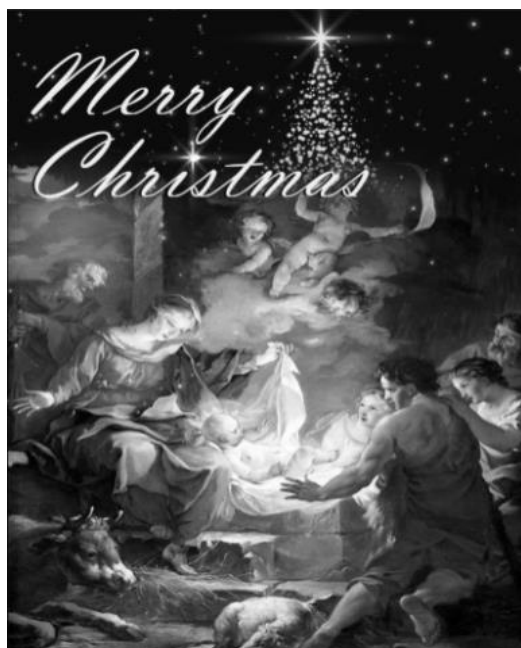

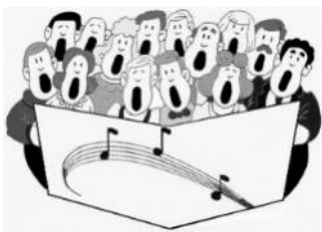
