

The Supreme Gift

On July 25, 2018, Bishop Barres will issue a Diocesan Pastoral Letter entitled *The Supreme Gift: The Gift of Life*. This letter will be published on the fiftieth anniversary of Pope Blessed Paul VI's Encyclical Letter *Humanae Vitae*, "On Human Life". In that encyclical, the Holy Father reasserted the Church's long-standing teaching that the use of contraception is not morally permissible. Bishop Barres' letter is a serious attempt to teach this important and neglected moral truth of the Church to a new generation of the faithful. With the upcoming canonization of Pope Paul by Pope Francis on October 14, 2018, there could be no better opportunity to re-present this teaching to our people. What follows will assist priests in preaching about *Humanae Vitae* and *The Supreme Gift* and introducing both to their parishioners.

Humanae Vitae

Humanae Vitae, issued by Pope Paul VI on July 25, 1968, is in three main sections. In Section I, "Problems and Competency of the Magisterium", the Holy Father sets forth the origin of the Encyclical in the question being raised in his time as to whether newly developed forms of contraception might be morally permissible. He also asserts the ability of the Magisterium to teach on such matters of moral theology. In Section II, "Doctrinal Issues", the Pope states the teaching of the Church that the direct interruption of the possibility of procreation in the marital act "must be totally rejected as a legitimate means of regulating the number of children." (HV, 14) He quotes Gaudium et Spes: "Marriage and marital love are ordained by their very nature to the procreating and educating of children. Offspring are clearly the supreme gift of marriage, a gift that contributes immensely to the good of the parents themselves." (GS, 50) In this section the Holy Father gives a small treatise on marriage and the nature of married love. He speaks of the two "ends of marriage", the "unitive" and the "procreative", which may never be separated. He speaks of "conscious parenthood", the idea that a couple must be open to being parents together, and the permissibility of using natural family planning to space the births of children for just reasons.

In this section Pope Paul also prophetically asserts that the use of contraception in society will: (1) Lead to an increase of infidelity in relationships. (2) Lead to a general weakening of morals throughout society. (3) Lead men to lose respect for women. (4) Lead public authorities to force contraception upon people for the public good. Additionally, the Holy Father adds the danger that people will come to think that they, and not God, have complete dominion over their own bodies, and may therefore use or alter them at will.

In Section III, "Pastoral Directives", the Holy Father warns public authorities that they must safeguard morals and the family; he encourages scientists, doctors and nurses to use their abilities in favor of life and not against it; he begs spouses to live their marriages as God intended; he stresses with priests that it is their solemn duty to teach the truth about marriage for the salvation of souls; and finally he tells bishops that promoting this teaching is their greatest work at the present time.

The Supreme Gift: The Gift of Life

Bishop Barres' fifteen-page pastoral letter is in four parts. Section I, "The Historical Context of *Humanae Vitae*", explains briefly how the encyclical letter came to be, and how the Pope himself explained that the document was "not just a declaration about a negative moral law ... it is above all a positive presentation of conjugal morality in relation to its mission of love and fruitfulness."

In Section II, "An Explanation of the Teaching of *Humanae Vitae*", Bishop Barres gives his own summary of the encyclical in four pages. The most important teaching of the encyclical is in its very first line: "God has entrusted spouses with the *extremely important mission* of transmitting human life." (*HV*, 1) Marriage is a gift from God that has within it a mission for the couple to be co-creators with Him of new human life, and to cooperate with Him in bringing forth new souls. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* says: "The Church teaches that every spiritual soul is created immediately by God — it is not 'produced' by the parents — and also that it is immortal". (*CCC*, 366) This means that in the moment when the parents conceive a child, the immortal soul of that child is also created immediately by God. "Therefore, from the moment of its conception life must be guarded with the greatest care." (*GS*, 50) This means that God Himself wills not only the life of every child ever conceived in the world, but also the eternal life of that child. It is not possible for any child to be "unwanted" since that child has first been "wanted" and then "willed" into existence by Almighty God. Even if the parents do not want the child, God does, otherwise the child would not exist. God does not merely allow the parents to be co-creators of human life with Him, He allows them to cooperate in assisting Him in bringing new souls into existence, who are made to live forever with God in eternal life.

The circumstances of the modern world do not allow us to change the Church's long-standing moral teaching. For a couple to accept the gift of marriage, but refuse the *supreme gift* of children, is to say "No" three times: "No" to God; "No" to each other; and "No" to the child. It is taking a gift and, without gratitude, using it in a way the Giver never intended. The two "ends of marriage", "unitive" and "procreative", may never be separated. The marital act unites a couple as a physical and outward sign of a deeper and inner spiritual reality. As they were united by God in a solemn covenant on their wedding day, when they promised to give themselves to each other completely by their vows, so every act of sexual intercourse in marriage renews that covenant. *Their bodies follow where their souls have already gone*. That is why contraception introduces a lie into the marriage. Contraception says: "I love you, and will give myself to you, but not totally, there is something I will keep for myself and deny to you and to God." This is why contraceptive relations cannot complete the other end of marriage, that of uniting the couple. In fact, contraceptive sex places a physical and spiritual barrier between the spouses, and so pushes them further apart rather than bringing them closer together. It is destructive of love.


In Section III, "Pope Blessed Paul VI: A Prophet for Our Times", Bishop Barres gives a three-page explanation of how Pope Paul VI was prophetic in predicting the consequences for society should the use of contraception become widespread (the four dangers enumerated above). This is a very effective way to preach on *Humanae Vitae*, since everywhere throughout society we see the destructive effects of the "contraceptive mentality" that Pope Saint John Paul spoke of. This section also includes a long list of current problems in the culture, which can be effectively used from the pulpit.

In Section IV, "Pope Saint John Paul II & Pope Francis", Bishop Barres explains how these two popes in particular have been great defenders of *Humanae Vitae*, and Pope Paul's teaching on marriage, married love, and the gift of children. Pope Francis has identified a "social and spiritual crisis" so severe that "never before has proclaiming the Gospel on the Family ... been more urgent and necessary." Bishop Barres explains how Pope Francis' defense of the environment cannot be separated from his defense of human life. Pope Francis has said: "The defense of the environment and the fight against exclusion demand that we recognize a moral law written into human nature itself, one which includes the natural difference between man and woman, and absolute respect for life in all its stages and dimensions." The letter also includes some other, longer, inspiring quotations from Pope Francis that may be used to great effect from the pulpit or in parish bulletins.

In Section V, "Humanae Vitae: A Document of the Past, A Solution for the Present, A Path for the Future", Bishop Barres explains that he sees this anniversary of Humanae Vitae as a God-given opportunity to teach something about the Catholic Faith that is absolutely crucial to marriages, families, and our lives as Catholics. Understanding the teaching of Humanae Vitae, believing it, and living it, is one of the first and most important answers to the crisis of our time. The Bishop believes that the future Pope Saint Paul VI wrote Humanae Vitae more for our times than even for his own. Bishop Barres says to priests: "I want to thank the priests of the diocese for their dedication to serving God and His people in the vineyard of the Lord. In this fiftieth anniversary year, I encourage all my priests to read again the Encyclical Letter of Pope Paul VI, and to use this, my letter, as a tool. Help your parishioners come to see the truth and beauty of the Holy Father's teaching. Preach it from the pulpit, teach it to married couples and to those preparing for marriage, and help them to live it by your pastoral care, your counsel, and your administering of the sacraments. As Pope Francis constantly reminds us, we must cultivate the 'art of accompaniment,' so that we do not tell people the way, but rather walk that way with them ourselves. Then we will truly be coworkers of the Lord, helping Him in the most important pastoral work of our times: forming, restoring and healing our families."








Jésus nourrit cinq mille hommes (Mc 6,30-34)

C'est pour rendre compte de leur mission que les disciples rejoignent leur Maitre (v. 30). L'heure d'un premier bilan est venue pour les missionnaires. C'est la seule fois où, dans son évangile, Marc donne aux Douze leur nom approprié d'"Apôtres": "Envoyés". Le Maitre invite ses amis à prendre du recul par rapport au monde, pour jouir d'un repos bien mérité (v. 31a)

A travers ce passage, Marc insiste sur sa sollicitude particulière à son égard. L'expression "saisie de pitié" est très forte en grec. Et cette compassion de Jésus est comparée à celle d'un berger pour ses brebis perdues.

Comme un véritable berger pour son peuple, Jésus commence par enseigner la Parole de Dieu qui révèle le sens de la vie (Deut 8,3; Mt 4, 4; Sg16, 26), puis il veille à ce que tous aient de quoi manger.

Mes chers amis, Jésus dans l'Evangile de ce jour nous invite à agir en vrais pasteurs. Nous vivons dans un temps où l'incompréhension bat son plein. C'est le siècle même de l'individualisme, l'égocentrisme. Comme filles et fils d'un même Père, nous sommes appelés à faire la différence dans une société, un monde tant ravagé par la haine, la violence et luttes intestines.
