

14TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

As I am writing this article it is Friday, June 29th, but because of July 4th holiday, we have to submit the bulletin material early today. I am saying it to you, so that you are aware of the fact that sometimes I cannot be too precise in mentioning the things that are happening in the present time.

On Wednesday, June 27th we sent Fr. Eden to his new assignment and we had also welcomed Fr. Charlince Vendredy for his service with us. We wish both of them fruitful apostolate. Just to let you know, that you can easily communicate with Fr. Charlince, because he speaks: English, Spanish, French, Creole, and probably some other languages. So feel free to engage him in a conversation and come to know Fr. Charlince.



As in the years before, we have as well with us Fr. Milciades, who will assist us through the months of July and August, so that Fr. Victor and I can take some vacation time. In fact Fr. Victor already went to El Salvador, and he will be back for the Feast of Saint Anne's. As you know, Fr. Milciades comes from Paraguay, and it is for number of years, that he comes to help during the summer here in the United States. We are grateful for his generous spirit and his spiritual presence and love for everyone in our parish. So I ask all of you to make them feel welcomed, as it is in the spirit and culture of Saint Anne's Parish. Though we are many, we are one parish family.

As we are heading into July, the initial weather forecast is very good, and I hope that you had a great 4th of July holiday. There is nothing as important as family and friends. Our capacity to take care of our home, our family and our friends, is vital for us in order to take care of parish family and church family. As friends of Jesus we continue to build our relationship with Him, but as well we invite others into that friendship.

This morning we have sent on leadership retreat a group of 11 youth with Velma from our Family Faith Formation office and with Tony Bellizzi, our Youth Ministry Leader on a retreat week. They went to retreat house in Goshen New York, and we pray, that they have a good experience of God and of the fellowship with other youth from around Long Island.

This is my wish for everyone during the summer months, that we all enjoy the glory of God in the beauty of nature and in prayer and Sacrament, and then in family and community experience.

In the Gospel of this Sunday, we have people that wonder at the wisdom of Jesus. And they asked themselves: where did she get all this wisdom? It is a time, when we pour out our hearts into the heart of Jesus, and then we allow Jesus, to pour out into our hearts his love and his life. As Jesus says to the Samaritan woman in Jn 4:14; -whoever drinks the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again and a woman answered: - give me that water then I will never be thirsty again, nor will I have to come here to draw water. - With her we ask Jesus to nourish our hearts and our souls always.

Lord teach us the wisdom of life and the wisdom of your love, so that receiving it with faith we may be prepared to share our life with you and with others.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

Holy Orders: Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life. DEVOTIONS
