2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

It was a beautiful season of Christmas and New Years, that we celebrated and with the Baptism of the Lord and last Monday we entered into the Ordinary Time. We still have the Christmas decorations on the altar as the flowers keep so well we will take it down during the coming week. I want to thank everyone who participated in any way to help and advance our celebrations. I want to mention from musicians, choirs, liturgical functions personnel, cleaning and decorating persons, to Pageants and parties that were done before and after Christmas. The last one was done on Epiphany by our Haitian Community, with excellent food, hospitality and entertainment. Thank You All, for bringing together the joy and many expressions of it together, motivated by faith to share in the joy of Christmas. I thank all donors of

gifts for Outreach, and I thank You for your generosity to the parish.

Last weekend after the first clearing of snow, Hugo cleaned and moved good deal of snow with his bobcat, to make the parking cleaner and more efficient and prepared us for Sunday and for the melting of the snow. Thank You Hugo!

After Sunday night shortages of power, later during the day we found out that all the water pump motors in heating systems and motors for moving the air in the church were off with minor damages to the switches, and office internet router was damaged. We were lucky that it didn't happen on the colder nights, that could have caused some other damage and lots of cold inconvenience. Even in that defect we were blessed, that it happened in good time not to create too much confusion.

Last Sunday we baptized 21 of our children at the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses. Those children will be receiving other Sacraments during the course of the year. I hope you didn't feel too inconvenient by the extended service and picture taking after. I believe it's good for us to see how many of our children participate in our Faith Formation program. Than at those Masses as well we see the candidates for the Easter Sacraments, that after the liturgy of the Word go for their formation classes.

Now, that we are back into Ordinary Time, we will take care of our regular business of working on our improving daily service. This Sunday at 5:00 pm Mass and after, we want to meet with all Eucharistic Ministers to talk about serving with renewed zeal and reorganization of ourselves, as some people moved on and are not with us anymore, so we will reorganize the list and talk about the issues and bettering our services.

Next Saturday at 7:00 pm Spanish Mass, we will have the celebration of Our Lady of Altagracia, the feast of the Blessed Mother venerated in the Dominican Republic. After the Mass, traditionally we will have the reception at the lower church with food and entertainment prepared by the Dominican community. Let's taste the faith, food and joy of life of this Caribbean Island. All are invited.

Than next Sunday at the end of Masses, we will have the presentation of a new group to our parish, that some parishioners belong already to, it is Neocatechumenal Way. You will find the announcement in the bulletin this weekend. This group will offer a way of practical living of faith for those that search for their Christian identity. They want to help us to invite to the church and evangelize those who are far from the church. Given, that Brentwood has a big population, and we have a lot of space in the church, I did accept their offer to help with the Evangelization of our town. Let's hear what they have to say. The meeting place for the group will be the hall at the K of C on Monday's and Thursday's evenings starting next week.

The Saturday of 27th some representatives of different groups will go for an Evangelization training, as a fruit of the 5 Encounter process of revitalization of Ministries and missionary approach to ministry in all groups of the church. All groups need to be open to reinventing themselves, and to make themselves open to the Gospel hospitality and Sacramental life.

In the Gospel of this Sunday we find a chain reaction to the person of Christ. It is a typical example of how Evangelization works through the witness of life and of faith. John the Baptist points to Jesus, than his disciples follow Christ, than Christ invites them to stay with him, to share with him, than they announce to others that they found the Christ and brought them to Christ. This is the model that each group in the church needs to adopt, as how the friendship and the love of Christ is received and shared.

Come and see, Jesus said to the disciples as an answer for their longing to know God and to make an experience of Him. God bless everyone !!!

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.

Les Dimanches du Temps Ordinaire

En dehors du Temps Pascal, du Carême et de l'Avent, il reste, dans l'année de l'Eglise, trente-trois ou trente-quatre semaines qui constituent le Temps Ordinaire et se déroulent en deux périodes dont la durée est liée a la date de Paques: 1- du 7Janvier au Carême (Mercredi des Cendres); 2-de la Pentecôte au Temps de l'Avent. Contrairement aux Dimanches du Temps Pascal, du Carême et de l'Avent, les dimanches du Temps Ordinaire cèdent la place aux Solennités et aux Fêtes du Seigneur lorsqu'elles tombent un dimanche: Dédicace de l'église, Présentation du Seigneur, Transfiguration, Croix Glorieuse, Dédicace de la Basilique du Latran; ainsi qu'aux solennités des saints lorsqu'elles tombent un dimanche: Assomption de la Vierge, Nativité de Jean Baptiste, apôtres Pierre et Paul, la Toussaint, les Fidèles Défunts.
