3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Last Sunday we had a big meeting with all our Eucharistic Ministers, and I hope it was informative and helpful. It was a little long because of the number of things that we need to mention and even translate to Spanish. We were around 50 persons and I believe we all were impressed to see all this number of ministers.



I am grateful for everyone's involvement and service. It would be impossible to attend to all the sick and home bound persons without the dedication of our Eucharistic Ministers. This same is with the distribution of Holy Communion at Masses, it would be considerably longer and without possibility of serving under both species. We thank all Eucharistic Ministers for their dedicated service to the parish and to the sick. If anyone has any questions about anything related to this Ministry, please come up after the Mass any day and clear your concerns with any of the priests, or with Marge in the office. Once more: THANK YOU ALL AND EVERYONE who serves as Eucharistic Ministers.

As you noticed on the rectory we covered the wooden part of it with the plastic siding, and protected the edges of the roof with aluminum, so that we could avoid repainting the wood parts that would be very difficult because of the rusting old paint. This way it's done once for life time. We replaced some missing aluminum siding on the church's roof, as it was torn down by the past hurricane winds. We made as well the roofs over the stairways on the back of the church, as the cracks in them allowed the water to penetrate into the walls of building.

We are finishing the door opening from the convent chapel to the office part of building, to facilitate the use of the conference room and of the bathroom in that part by the users of those spaces. This week we took down most of the Christmas decorations, with some flowers left for this Sunday. The remaining poinsettias will be given away on Monday for those who want them. Some of them continue to grow if you know how to care for them. I want to thank everyone for their helping hands with those decorations. It goes smoothly when there is a good number of willing people. Thank You all for taking care of our church. With the green color we are back to the Ordinary Time. After business and emotions of Christmas and New Year, it is a quiet time of reflection and enjoyment of the fruits of Christmas, that is the closeness of the Lord, and the brotherhood between all people of good will.

As we started to read our book, *"Perfectly Yourself"* we realize that what the author says about the- longing for fullness - for fulfillment - is found in the depths of our hearts. That longing to love and to be loved, the longing to belong - to that fullness. For me Christmas is the beginning of the answer to those questions and longings. It is an experience of belonging to God, as I perceive that Christ wants to belong to us all, and to everyone individually. Emmanuel - God with us, God is with me. He belongs to me, I belong to him. He belongs to the earth, we belong to heaven.

In the Gospel of this Sunday we are told - this is the time of fulfillment - the fullness is given to us in Christ. Take it or miss it. Take it for what it is and be transformed by it, or miss it and you will never experience the fullness and fulfillment of those longings. Be touched by Christ, and never be alone, never be the same, be transformed, be loved, be fulfilled, be happy.

God bless everyone !!! God loves You !!!

This weekend we will experience our belonging to each other as we celebrate the feast of OUR LADY OF ALTA GRACIA - Our Lady of a high grace with our Dominican community. Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.



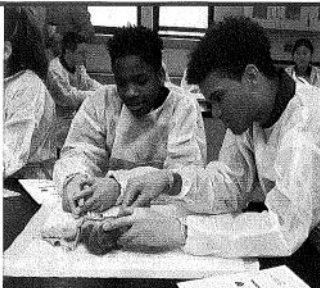

"Venez derrière moi, je vous ferai des pêcheurs d' hommes".

La parabole de Jonas met en valeur le repentir immédiat des habitants de Ninive. De son cote, l'Apôtre Paul avertit les Chrétiens de Corinthe que leur conversion ne souffre pas d'être ajournée, puis que le temps est limite et que ce monde passe. Paul insiste sur l'imminence du retour du Christ et sur la certitude que l'avenir dernier de l'homme s'est fait tout proche dans le Christ ressuscite. La double scène de vocation rapportée par l'Evangile de Marc s'inscrit dans ce même climat d'urgence.

Il y a une exigence radicale. Le disciple doit comprendre qu'il lui faut quitter sur-le-champ sa profession et sa famille. Rompant les liens sociaux et familiaux, les disciples quittent tout pour suivre le Christ. Cette présentation abrupte néglige volontairement de signaler les rencontres préalables de ces hommes avec Jésus et leur cheminement intérieur jusqu'a l'éveil de leur vocation, dans le but de mettre en évidence l'importance primordiale de l'appel de Dieu dans toute vie chrétienne et apostolique. Aujourd'hui encore des hommes et des femmes acceptent de se vouer corps et âme a la tâche qu'ils ont librement choisie en réponse a un appel de Dieu. Prenons le temps dans la prière e rendre grâce pour l'appel que Jésus leur a adresse et de dire notre joie, et nos difficultés a travailler ensemble.
