12TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This Sunday we celebrate the birth of John the Baptist. It is very unusual because normally we don't celebrate the birthday of the Saints, except for Jesus and the Blessed Mother. But it comes from the fact, that John the Baptist is a very unusual Saint. He is a very great Saint. He makes a bridge between two different eras in the life of the world. He connects the Old Testament with the New Testament, as we could say it in the biblical sense from today's perspective.

He is the last of the Prophets of the Old Testament, and he is the first Prophet of the New Testament. John's birth is foretold by the Prophets. He is called for his mission since his birth, to be a Prophet to the nations. He was called to proclaim a divine favor in which we all share now.

John was filled with the Holy Spirit from his mother's womb at the meeting of Saint Elizabeth with the Blessed Mother; as the Gospel says he leapt for joy. John matured in the Spirit by prayer and fasting in the desert, and then he heralded the Advent of the Messiah, he prepared the way for the Lord.

Since the fourth century this feast is celebrated in the western and eastern church six months before the birth of Christ. Saint Augustine found this appropriate date near the summer solstice, so after the feast of John's birth the daylight begins to grow shorter, whereas after Jesus' birth it increases, as Saint John told us: I shall decrease so that he can increase - talking about Jesus - the true light of the world.

There is much to be learned in our Christian life from Saint John the Baptist. The way in which God sees, treats, prepares and approaches Saint John the Baptist, in the same way God acts with us. John's total dedication to preparing the way for the Lord gained him Jesus' praise, when Jesus told that -there is no greater man born of a woman than John the Baptist.

He dedicates his whole life to preparing others to receive Christ into their lives, and he does it to the point of losing his own life. St. John the Baptist is a great example of how the promises of the Old Testament bring the believer to the person of Christ the Savior, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world. Looking at Saint John the Baptist we may think about how God prepares a mission call for each one of us, He has a job a call for us to accomplish. What is this call, what is this job for me ??? Did God really have a plan for me even from before my birth ??? if so what is it ???

How important is this in realizing, that our life and life of every human person begins at conception, with God's plan already laid out for us. If we ever doubted if someone cared about us, now we should know, that God does care always, even from before our birth. The way God prepared John the Baptist and the way in which Jesus interacts with him, we see how much God wants to have a relationship with us. On the other side John's faith makes him anticipate what God has prepared for us.

What John the Baptist did, he did not do it for himself, but for you and me to prepare and to receive Jesus into our lives. His life still today affects the life of every Christ's believer. If only we could identify with the person of John the Baptist our life would be transformed even today, by the same promises that shaped the life of the Prophet. It only depends on our attitude of faith and on allowing our soul to be filled with the Holy Spirit, as John's was filled from before his birth at the meeting with Jesus in Mary's womb.

Let us allow ourselves to be loved by God, as Saint John the Baptist was loved. Let us love ourselves as Jesus loves us. Let's never doubt this love, and it will shape our lives and it will fill us with joy and happiness.

Come Lord Jesus !!!

Happy feast day!!! of John the Baptist, the greatest man ever born of a woman as Jesus said. God bless everyone !!!!

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism: For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Marriage: Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

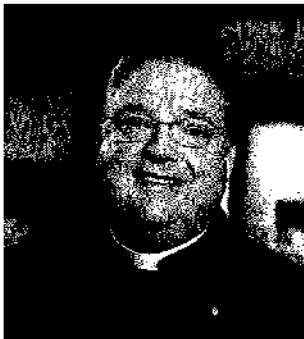

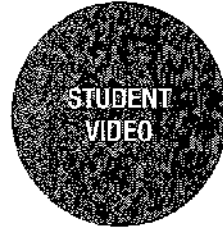

En contexto secular el Día de S. Felicitaciones a los matrimonios celebrados recientemente. Esta Fiesta tiene unas primeras Vísperas (Junio 23), y la misa propia (Junio 24)...en Junio 25 tuve la dicha de celebrar mi primera Eucaristía hace trece años...me encomiendo a sus oraciones.
