## Seventh Sunday of Easter

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Happy Mother's Day to All Mothers !!! May You be Blessed with good health, may the Lord grant you all your prayers, may he bless your family in every way, may You see the success of your children and grandchildren !!!

It is the greatest of all gifts, to be a mother, to be literally giving life it is most Godlike thing to be done by any creature. It is to have a power directly from God to expand eternity by adding to it another "star" - "soul" of another human being, that will create its own "galaxy" of life, another universe. It is totally cosmic and heavenly what a mother can do with a little or big help from the father.



In the dailiness of life we may take this gift for granted, but it is a monumental gift standing out as most special of all gifts ever received. What the mother does, no one else can do, yet the gift of life itself it is only the beginning of life giving, that continues in nurturing that life into its own independence, eventually letting it go to create its own purpose and happiness. Sometimes, that nurturing person may be the adoptive mother, that took on the responsibility to complete the process of "life giving". We are never enough grateful for what we have received from our mothers. We can't give back enough to our mother for what she has given to us. We need to be forever grateful towards her and yet we will never match up to what she has given us. Lord bless our Mothers for all they have done for us.

I want to thank Bertha and Deacons John and Andre and all Religion teachers for preparing our kids for First Communion. It was all beautiful and solemn, and kids were all beautiful and prepared to be initiated into the Eucharist to receive Jesus physically into their lives. The weather kept us in for pictures, so there was little crowd confusion with pictures, but considering the numbers and occasion we can excuse the crowd, as everyone was trying to get little piece of the church and it's space for themselves for the memory, and I totally understand that, and I don't complain. Jesus was always surrounded by crowds, and I wish it was so every Sunday. I would not mind it at all. I pray that parents of our First Communion children seen and experienced the fullness of Christ's love, and will want more of it for themselves and for their children. May it be true. I thank Georgina Grant from the Michael Grant Funeral Home, for the courtesy of the flowers for the First Communion Masses, as they were beautiful. As always I thank all of you for your support and help to the parish in any way.

### SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

**Baptism:** For children under 5, please contact the Parish Office (273-8113) for an appointment to speak with a Priest or Deacon at least several weeks before the Baptism. For older children, contact the Office of Family Faith Formation (231-7344).

**First Holy Communion:** Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

**Confirmation:** This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

### SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

**Sacrament of the Sick:** Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

**Reconciliation:** The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.

### SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

**Marriage:** Congratulations! Couples planning to marry should make an appointment with a Priest or Deacon at least eight (8) months in advance of the wedding to allow time for adequate preparation.

**Holy Orders:** Is God calling you? Call a Priest or Deacon to discern a possible vocation to the Priesthood, Diaconate or the Religious life.

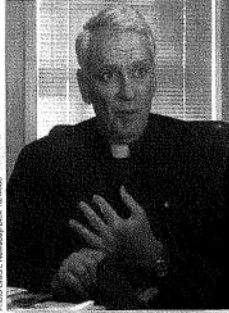

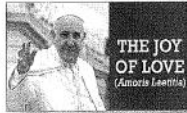
## BOOK TALK SERIES

Speaking on:  
*Pope Francis' Exhortation "The Joy of Love" (Amoris laetitia) and the Sacrament of Marriage.*

Does the Exhortation say anything about annulments for those whose marriages have ended in divorce? Why is there such controversy about the Pope's mention of the "internal forum"?



### MSGR. JOHN ALESANDRO'S BIO

Msgr. John Alesandro holds degrees from Cathedral College, Brooklyn; Seminary of the Immaculate Conception, Huntington; North American College and the Gregorian University, Rome; and St. John's University Law School, New York. He has served as both Chancellor and Vicar General for the Diocese of Rockville Centre. Governor Mario Cuomo appointed him as a founding member of the N.Y.S. Task Force on Life and the Law. Monsignor has published many articles and has taught at Catholic U. in Washington, at Fordham, and St. John's Law School as well as at Molloy College. His parish assignments have included St. Dominic's, Oyster Bay as well as St. Thomas the Apostle in West Hempstead, where he currently resides.

### Marie dans les religions-1

Marie occupe une place bien particulière au cœur des religions. En découvrir la richesse permet de mieux comprendre ce qui aujourd'hui encore fait l'objet d'un culte à Marie, mère de Jésus. Dans la Bible, elle est présente dans les 2 Testaments. Dans l'Ancient Testament, la figure de la Vierge apparaît déjà en Isaïe 7,14; Michée 5,2-3 : " La Vierge concevra et enfanta un Fils" et en bien d'autres endroits comme la Femme de la Genèse qui écrasa la tête du serpent. Dans le Nouveau Testament, c'est Luc qui enduit le plus. Son évangile commence par la naissance miraculeuse de Jean Baptiste annoncée par l'ange Gabriel qui se rend près de Marie pour lui dire qu'elle va avoir aussi un enfant, comme sa cousine Elisabeth. Ensuite dans l'évocation de la naissance et des premiers mois du Christ. Marie joue le premier rôle, Joseph reste dans l'ombre. Marc ne mentionne Marie que de façon occasionnelle. Matthieu, dans sa généalogie qui ouvre son Evangile, s'intéresse à Joseph; il précise simplement que Marie se trouve enceinte par la fait de l'Esprit Saint. Joseph tient le rôle principal: il pense à répudier Marie, c'est à lui que l'ange apparaît pour lui expliquer la situation et lui dire de donner le nom de Jésus à l'enfant. Dans l'Evangile de Jean, deux moments-clés de la présence de Marie: aux noces de Cana et au pied de la croix. A Cana, Marie invite les serviteurs à agir sur la parole de Jésus: "faites tout ce qu'il vous dira". Et avant de mourir sur la croix, Jésus confia sa mère à l'apôtre Jean. Ajoutons encore la présence de Marie au milieu des disciples réunis le jour de la Pentecôte( Actes des Apôtres)
