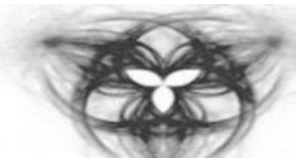

Trinity Sunday



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

With the feast of Pentecost we concluded the Easter season, and now we are back into Ordinary Time. The red color for the decorations that we had for Pentecost, we will keep until the Confirmation of our youth on June 2nd. Let it be a reminder for us to pray for our youth and for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit for the whole parish. After the Corpus Christi Feast on June 3rd, we will go to green color, that is proper for Ordinary Time. We remember that new liturgical year starts with Advent, followed by Christmas Season, then Ordinary time, Lent and Easter Season that ends with Pentecost followed by Ordinary time. On the extent of liturgical calendar we contemplate all mysteries of salvation starting with creation of the world and the fall of Adam and Eve, then the promise of salvation and it's complete unfolding, with foretelling the end of times and the Second Coming of Christ in glory to judge the living and the dead. In ordinary time we contemplate and enjoy all mysteries, that we have learned from salvation history. We have time to assimilate them and put them into practice in our daily lives.

This Sunday we contemplate the mystery of the blessed Trinity. The knowledge of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit comes from Christ revealing it to us. This believe in the Blessed Trinity characterizes those who call themselves Christians. It is Christ who reveals to us the Three Persons: of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Christ was very clear about the existence of that mystery of Three Persons, of their unity, and of the distinctions. How they blend into one and how they remain particular. Jesus prepares us to know each person particularly and from this revelation, we can assign for each person a particular role in the regard to creation. The Father as the Creator, the Son as the Savior, and the Holy Spirit as the Sanctifier. That mystery of the Blessed Trinity, is the food for our minds for all eternity. Jesus says: "the Father and I are one," then he says to Philip: "if you have seen me you have seen the Father." And again he says: "if I go, I will send you a Counselor, the Spirit of Truth, the Paraclete."

So today after all this divine revelations, we have some human revelations regarding our parish life. After eight years of good service to our parish, Fr. Eden will be transferred to serve on another assignment in the parish of Saint Martha's in Uniondale and in the parish of Saint Boniface in Elmont. We want to thank him for all those years of service, he will be missed, but I am sure that he will remain in contact with us. As it is with all transfers, it will happened during the last week of June, until then we all have our time to express our gratitude towards him. We wish him all the best on his new assignment. Thank you Fr. Eden and God bless you always !!!

As for our parish we will have Fr. Charlince Vendredy come to us from the parish of Saint Boniface. As Fr. Eden, so Fr. Charlince speaks very good English, French, Creole and some Spanish. In next week's bulletin you should find some biographical notes from Fr. Charlince about himself. Please welcome him into our parish as you welcomed me three years ago. As the end of our school year is approaching, and Summer is at our door, we start preparing for our parish Feast of Saint Anne that we will celebrate on Sunday, July 29th. We are making an announcement about looking for volunteers for the roasting of the pigs, today we start the announcement of the parish Mega Raffle and the sale of the tickets for it. We will try to sell 400 tickets with increased number of prizes, depending how many tickets we sell above the number 300 from last year. First prize is \$10,000. For further information look in the bulletin.

I invite all groups within the parish to participate in the Parish Feast. Please make sure that your group activities do not coincide with that feast. To help with the preparations please feel free to contact Kathy Fella, Esperanza Justiniano and Paul Jean. You may help with: decorations, entertainment, food, drinks, logistics setting up, preparing the gift baskets, selling the tickets, and more. Don't be just an observer be a participant. New ideas are welcomed, please bring it to the attention of the above mentioned persons or the parish staff. I thank you all for your collaboration, let us make it a parish success, by having a lots of fun.

First Holy Communion: Children usually begin Religious Education studies in the First Grade and are prepared for Communion in the Second Grade. Call the Family Faith Formation Office (231-7344) to register your child the summer before the school year begins.

Confirmation: This Sacrament is currently celebrated in the Eighth Grade after 2 years of preparation. Please call the Religious Education Office (231-7344) for more information.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at any time to arrange for the Anointing of the Sick either at home or in the hospital.

Reconciliation: The Sacrament is celebrated every Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Church or by appointment.
