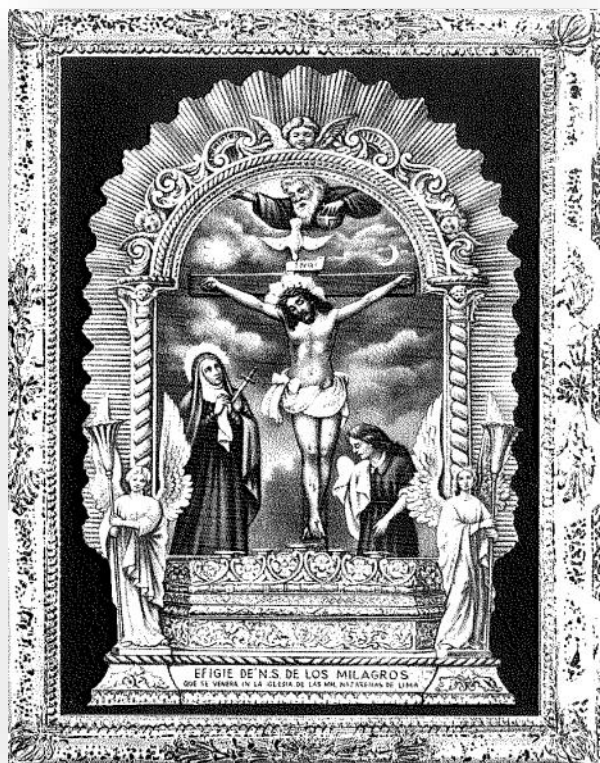

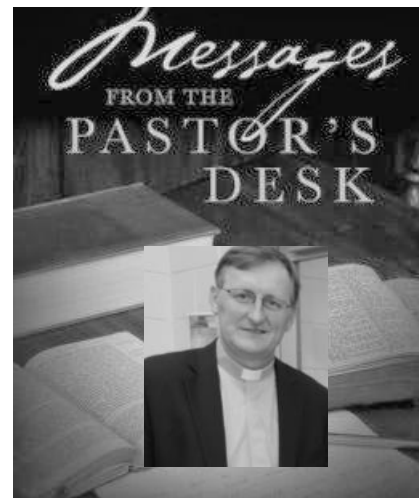

## 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This week with the night temperatures going to thirties, we realized that winter is around the corner. Any moment it could go to freezing and probably it will come soon. But this is only the reminder, that life is always progressing and every day we are closer to the Lord.

In the Gospel of this Sunday we heard James and John trying to secure for themselves a good place in God's glory in Heaven. Place of importance and close to Jesus himself, but motivated totally by selfish, immature vision of Heaven. Jesus makes it work by adjusting the dialogue about the cup and the baptism to the answers given by the Apostles intending not to humiliate them, but to teach them about what is going to happen. Then, Jesus teaches them about the way that authority should be administered and used to accomplish its purpose and not as a personal advantage over others. The great lesson about the authority, is about the prominence of service and of common good, seen from the position of the Savior, who as Jesus stated came not to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many. It became a dramatical teaching moment, where the disciples were dissuaded from their selfish vision of heaven to the understanding of Jesus' laying down his life for all people in total humility of service. Jesus finds the strength to serve in knowing his Father's love, and assurance of the eternal glory coming from the authority of God the Father. All of his doing is subjected to this knowledge with total abandonment and confidence. As for us, it's to ponder this event of the Gospel and make it our own personal experience by trying to be in harmony with Jesus' way.



Last weekend we had our two Bishops visiting us for the vigil of canonization of Saint Oscar Romero, Bishops Barres and Brennan. It was a nice community moment be it in the Mass celebration, be it in the reception after. I want to thank everyone who participated and helped Marge Baum, Pastoral Associate to organize it all. Once more we have seen, that when we come together in faith and good will, we can prepare and share a good spiritual and material feast. I thank you all for this participation and the moment of simple, honest sharing of time, spirituality, food and the presence of our Bishops with personal moments and pictures. I thank the Salvadorian Consul for his participation with us. It's another lesson for us, that serving others works for family and community building. Good times together make the family strong.

As for celebrating, this weekend we will celebrate with Peruan community with the feast of Our Lord of the Miracles. Jesus is the Lord ! Let's participate and know better their culture and spirituality. May the name of the Lord be praised !!!

By this weekend we will have our pilgrims from Rome return from the Canonization. We are waiting for their account of the events. God bless El Salvador ! Saint Oscar Romero pray for us !!!

As for our service to the Lord and to others we all may consider our part and try to do what we can. Regarding the Saint Joseph Memorial Garden on the back of our church, you may see the Cross raising from the ground and getting the final shape. On the walls of the Cross we will place all of our memorial plates from the stones around the property. If you have more than one memorial plates for your family you may inform us before we place them on the wall so we could place them next to each other if you wish, and not casually in any place on the wall. If you wish someone to be memorialized on this Cross Wall you may consider making a considerable donation to the parish and Marge Baum our Pastoral Associate will arrange for the memorial plate to be made. We may consider placing in the garden couple of benches etc. As I mentioned last week in the bulletin the cost of the project and surrounding sidewalks, with removal of stones and placing them on the wall is \$ 20,000 so you may consider donating towards it as well. If we ever run short of place on the wall, we can always raise it up. Heaven is the limit. As for repositioning of the Stations of the Cross outside, I am waiting for the Scouts to get their act together. If I knew that it will take them forever to do it I would have left it with the Emaus group who placed already the posts for the Stations next to the church.

Next big project waiting to be done is the remaking of the second floor of the office building, as we have decline the lease of it because of some legal inconsistencies in its usage that needed to be addressed, so we will use the building now totally for the church purposes. The way it's built favors the use for retreat and gatherings. We will have to repair and refurbish the place preparing it for this new usage.

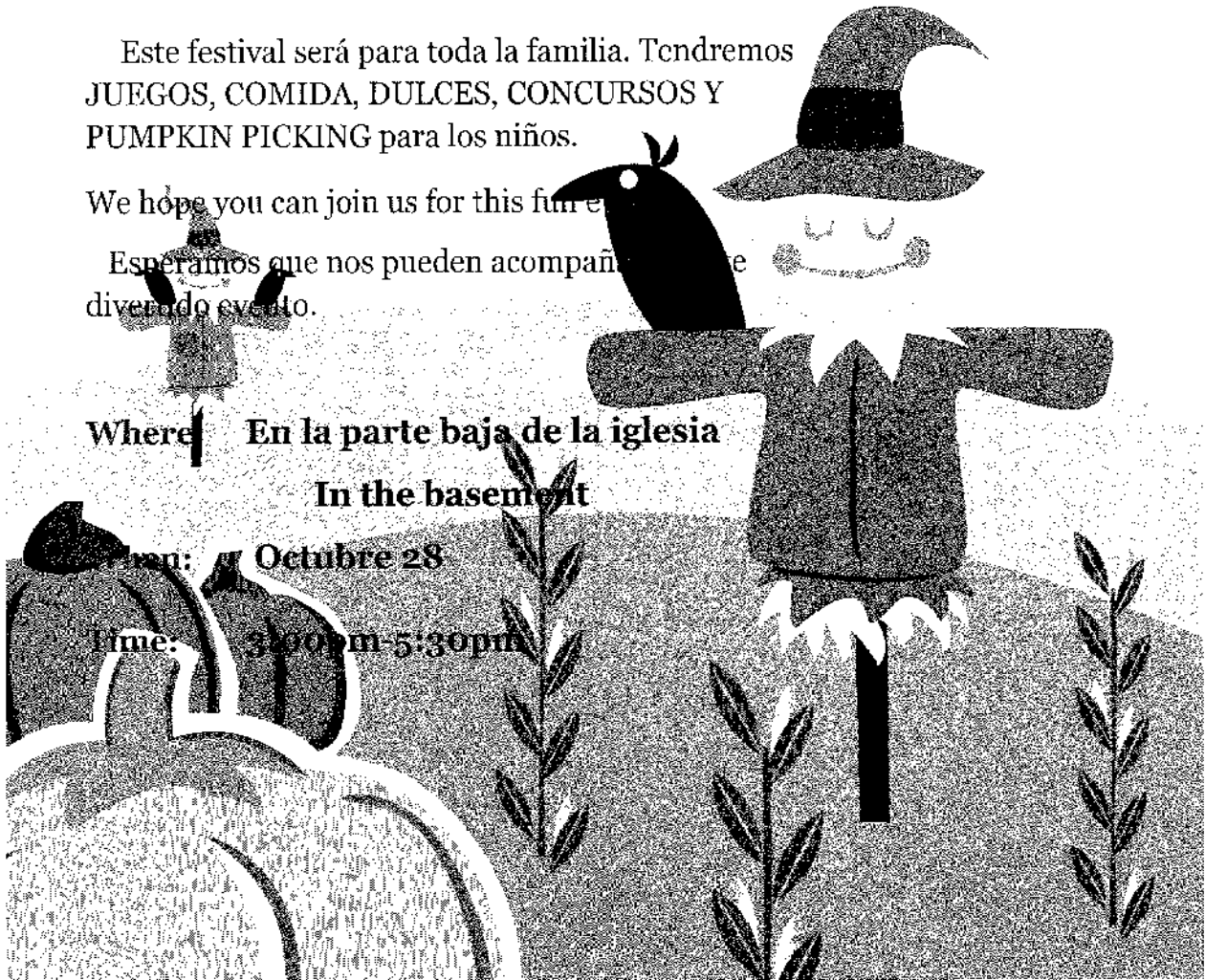

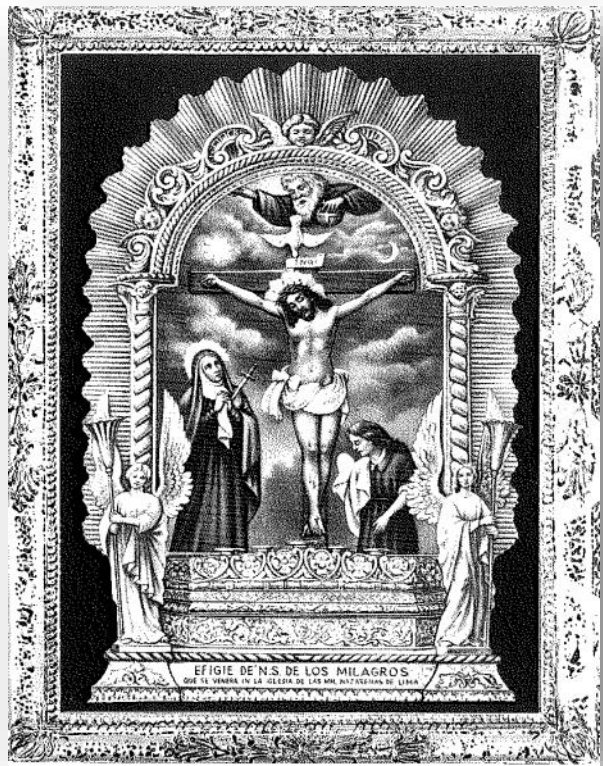

**XXIX DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO (B)**

*Isaías 53, 10-11... A que refiere el profeta cuando afirma que el justo se saciara de conocimiento?? Qué tipo de "sabiduría" la de un Dios que tritura con el sufrimiento a "su siervo"?? Refiere al conocimiento de la cruz. Y es que el sufrimiento es 'algo humano', o más bien algunas actividades humanas lo llevan implícito. El mejor ej.: cuando una mujer da a luz; otro ej., estudiar para coronar unos estudios, estudiar es un sufrimiento, sino pregúntele a los chicos que comenzaron recientemente el curso escolar y ya claman por vacaciones. Se sufre físicamente para tener salud y quizá hasta una esbelta figura, aunque algunos la genética nos gana, pero hacemos el intento. También, hay un sufrimiento espiritual o en la fe, algunos están escogidos a afrontar dificultades y pocos hasta el Martirio, la Iglesia canonizo a uno de sus mas fieles exponentes: O. Romero.*

*Hebreos 4, 14-16... Y la casta de este siervo de Yahvé (Jesús)...es el de un sumo sacerdote que ha sido probado en todo exactamente como nosotros, menos en el pecado. Surge una pregunta: ..que significa "menos en el pecado"?? Pues Cristo es Redentor, no peca pero asume las cargas de los hombres sumidos en el pecado, entrega su vida para que nosotros alcancemos misericordia. En ambiente judío, el día del Yom kippur (día de la expiación), se escogía un cordero manso que luego se enviaba al desierto para ser devorado por las fieras queriendo significar la salvaguarda de los elegidos de Dios...para un cristiano, Jesús es el Cordero de Dios que quita el pecado del mundo.*

*Marcos 10, 35-45... Los hijos del Zebedeo piden a Jesús sentarse uno a la derecha y otro a la izquierda (no sabían lo que pedían)... Sacados del error, se les hace entender que para llegar a la Vida eterna, no hay otro "camino que el de la cruz o del sufrimiento"...habla de martirio cuando refiere a si sus discípulos serán capaces de beber el mismo cáliz del Maestro..."El hijo del hombre no ha venido a que le sirvan, sino para servir y dar su vida en rescate por todos."*

**La demande des fils de Zébédée (Mc 10 :35-45)**

Maintenant que Jésus vient, pour la troisième fois, de mettre devant les yeux de ses amis l'inexorable sort qui l'attend, ils n'ont pas davantage manifesté leur capacité d'accueil (10,32-35). La demande de Jacques et Jean, ces 'suiveurs, de Jésus dès la première heure, qui ont tout quitté pour lui (1,19-20), ne manque pas pourtant d'audace. Ils voudraient s'assurer d'une situation d'avenir.
