24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This week we celebrated the memorial of 9/11 and we prayed for the victims and survivors of that tragic day. We prayed for the families of those who lost their lives and for the healing of their hearts. We prayed for the end of terrorism and violence on our streets.

This week we celebrated as well the feast of the Exaltation of the Cross and the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows, with Bishop Barres invitation to fast and pray for all victims of abuse by clergy, and all victims of abuse in the schools and all institutions and homes. We pray for healing of all those who were hurt, specially for all children and youth. We all make a commitment to safety and security of children and youth be it in church, be it in school, on the streets or at home. Our prayer has to be accompanied by vigilance and acting when necessary.

Considering the above, I will seek advice from Parish Staff and Pastoral Council to move forward with the project of installation of some security cameras on the property and in the buildings. It is for the sake of improving our safety by a better possibility to monitor it. Maybe if we install at least one camera for live streaming on the internet, so that we could have live access to see Mass and the main Altar on the internet in present moment ? Could be used to see weddings and funerals by those that cannot be present, or by home bound of our parish to have possibility to see our Mass?

Recently we restored the property around the Vietnam Memorial, partially on our property as well as on Knights of Columbus side, with installing some lawn donated to us by Delea Sod Farms. It looks beautiful and clean and hopefully we will find a donor to install there another memorial bench, as some use those benches to meet and to pray.

Doing that project we had to change partially our sprinkler system, and it was all rechecked and fixed for better service around the property. In that process I became aware how many of the memorial stones are in the invisible places, how many of them are out because of lost trees or alternated landscape. Number of those dogged memorial stones we are storing on the back of our property. So I am considering of making some kind of memorial wall or better a memorial cross wall, in line with the St Joseph statue, on the elevator side of the church lawn. The memorial cross would accommodate all plates from memorial stones. I consider that move as well for the sake of clearing the lawn from the obstacles for landscaping and grass maintenance. Those stones in front of all the cherry trees are very impractical for cutting the lawn. As you can see many of the stones were partially shaved by lawn mowers, and you can imagine what it does to the equipment. No wonder people don't want to do it, because it consumes too much time to work around those stones, and it is damaging to the equipment. Last two years the landscaping was done for free by Gonzalo Marroquin and others who helped, sometimes Cesar Guardado with his family and Hugo De Larca with his crew. But I cannot ask them to do it forever, with those obstacles to do it fast and damaging the machines, the trees are enough to go in circles, imagine how annoying are those stones. Bob from Soup Kitchen is considering donating to the parish a small tractor lawn mower, so you may see me doing it around or you can come and do it for the parish, but by then we will have to move those memorial stones.

If you have ideas to make it better please don't hesitate to talk to me. If anyone wants to consider contributing towards the new Memorial Cross Wall in the garden of St Joseph please let me know. I asked already for the project estimate and I will let you know the price of it. Another project is the restoration and relocation of the outside Stations of the Cross. I am waiting for the Scouts, to complete what the Emmaus Group has started by planting already the new posts for the Stations around the front east side of the church.

In the Gospel of this Sunday Jesus is asking Apostles: - Who do people say that I am ? - and then He directed same question towards the disciples themselves: -But who do you say that I am ? - ??? It is the answer to this powerful question that will direct our lives. It will inspire the way we live our life, the way we work and pray and have fun. It will affect the way we treat others. It has a power to transform our lives if only we find time to stop and answer it for ourselves.

Surprisingly, it is soon after Peter gives his powerful profession of faith, that Jesus utters his harshest words ever said to anyone in the Gospel: - Get behind me, Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do. - How terribly mistaken can our human thinking be ??? How far from God's will can our will be ???

Lord save us from our erroneous and selfish human preservation thinking. Save us from presumption and arrogance of thinking that we know the best. Lord save us from Satan's snares.

Lord save us !!! God bless everyone !!!

24º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO-B

Is. 50:5-9...El libro de Isaías presenta “4 canticos del siervo de Yahvé”, el de hoy es el tercero, en este el siervo habla y Yahvé le responde con su cercanía e inspirándole una respuesta de fe ante el sufrimiento. Cual es nuestra respuesta de fe a la reciente conmemoración del 9/11? Cual es tu respuesta de fe ante la realidad circundante? Solo se puede dar una respuesta apropiada si tenemos un permanente dialogo con Dios. En el sentido mas exacto el “cantico” refiere a Cristo.

St. 2:14-18...Continuamos reflexionando a cerca de “los pobres”, del que ni tiene alimento ni vestuario adecuado. A la desatención a las necesidades de otros, el texto descifra una gran interrogante: Que es necesario para vivir cristianamente? Y da la respuesta: “...si la fe no se traduce en obras, esta completamente muerta”, es como si yo tengo la Biblia sobre mi escritorio pero nunca lo leo, “es un adorno en mi escritorio”. Tengo de adorno ‘la fe’?

Mc. 8:27-35...A la pregunta: “...y ustedes, quien dicen que soy yo”, Pedro responde ‘de cajón’: “tú eres el Mesías.” Cuando Jesús les da a conocer que es necesario que el “Hijo del hombre padezca”, la respuesta del Apóstol es diferente. Cual es nuestra respuesta ante el compromiso cristiano? Como llevamos la cruz?...recordemos que Cristo es el “siervo sufriente”, el nos dio ejemplo haciendo el camino del Calvario, hagamos nuestro el caminar de Cristo, ‘no hay cristianismo sin cruz’. Y no es una exaltación del sufrimiento sin sentido, la fe nos invita a darle sentido a nuestro diario vivir.

La profession de foi de Pierre, la première annonce de la Passion et de la Résurrection de Jésus

Jésus entraîne ses disciples très au large (v.27) a. La première interrogation leur demande : « Pour les gens, qui suis-je ? » Il s'agit d'un véritable sondage d'opinion. Il faut savoir ce que le grand public pense de la personne du Maître. Pour les uns, Jésus est assimilé à Jean Baptiste ou à Elie ; pour d'autres, a l'un des prophètes antiques (v.28)

Reconnaître en Jésus un grand prophète n'est pas sans valeur : c'est un premier pas dans la foi. La réponse de Pierre retentit comme un éclair lumineux dans un ciel sombre (v.29). C'est une profession de foi non équivoque. Par la bouche du premier d'entre eux, les disciples montrent qu'ils sont finalement parvenus à donner à Jésus son exacte identité : « le Messie ». C'est-à-dire l'Envoyé spécial de Dieu – celui qu'il a littéralement 'consacre' - pour établir son Règne sur la terre, de façon décisive.

Et la furtive expression 'il fallait' veut discrètement inscrire la souffrance et la mort du Messie dans un insondable dessein de Dieu pour le salut des hommes (cf. Lc 24, 25-27).

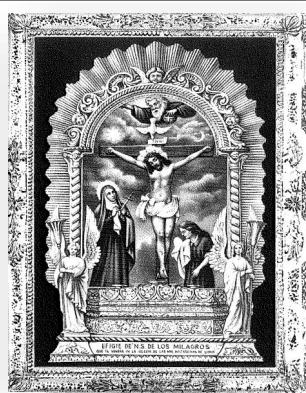

Below and to the right of Jesus is his mother, the Virgin Mary with her heart pierced by a metaphorical sword of sorrow. Kneeling and weeping at the foot of the cross is St. Mary Magdalene. Every year in October, hundreds of thousands of devotees from all races and economic backgrounds participate in a religious procession honoring the image through the streets of Lima. Boulevards are decorated in purple to celebrate the Lord of Miracles. Please join us for the Mass of Celebration of Señor de los Milagros.

BISHOP GUY SANSARICQ - COMING TO WESTBURY

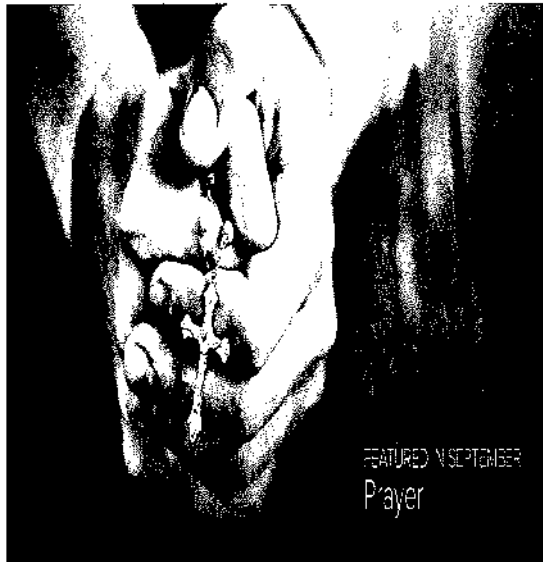

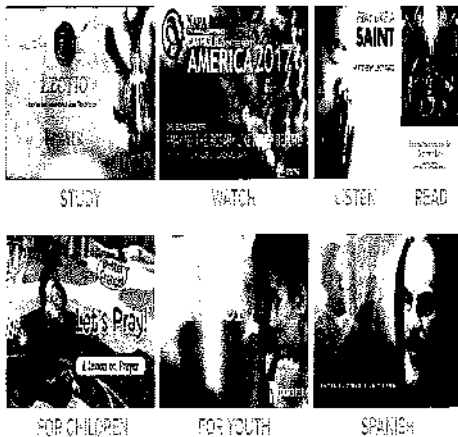
