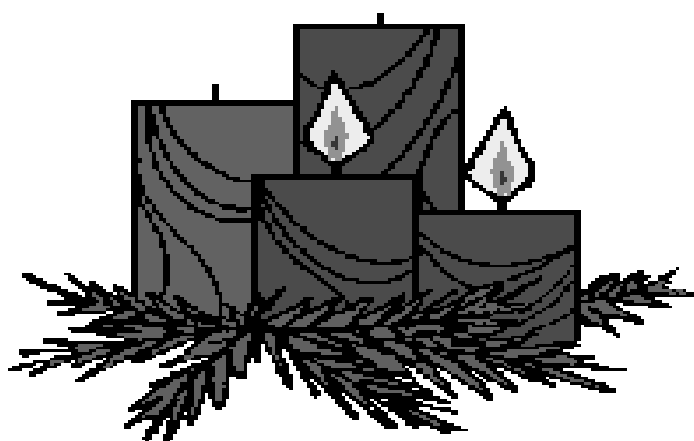

2nd Sunday of Advent

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This week we celebrated in Liturgy the feast of the Immaculate Conception, the Patroness of the Church in USA. The Blessed Mother is the only human person that is Full of Grace. Jesus is fully human but in the same time He is as well fully divine. The Blessed Mother received the grace of the freedom from Original sin so to become a worthy God-bearer. She is capable of recognizing and fulfilling God's will in all things. Her life is a perfect response to the plan of Salvation for the rest of humanity. It's plenty to admire and to learn for us as we contemplate the life and person of Blessed Mother. This is why until you and I learn to correspond to God perfectly, until then, we need to ponder the virtues of Mary, it will help us and set us on right course towards it.

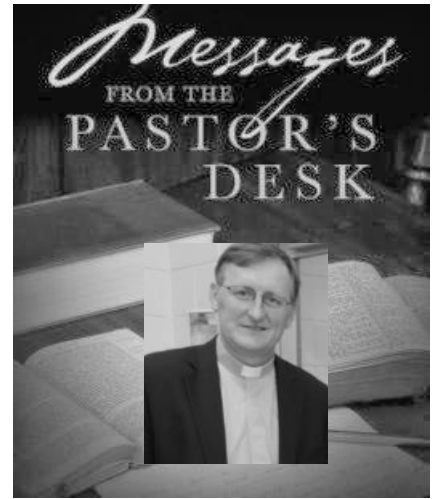
This coming week we will contemplate the apparitions of Blessed Mother to Saint Juan Diego, with the message of tender motherly love for him and for all people. Let's receive it and make it our own. "Am I not here who am your Mother?" -as the Blessed Mother spoke to Juan Diego. Hear those words, make them your own, perceive their love for you and stop acting as a orphan who doesn't believe in love.

As we enter into the Advent, Saint John the Baptist calls us to prepare the way of the Lord. That preparation he compares to making a highway in the desert for the Lord to come to us with Salvation. The way to make that preparation is through the spirit of repentance. As we get rid of all our sins before the Lord, as we repent of all our wrong doings, attitudes, and our evil thoughts, we become like that open highway through which the Lord comes to us with the experience of his salvation. He takes away our sins, He makes us free and happy persons.

Are you this happy person who allowed the Lord into your heart ??? Or are you the miserable person who is always unhappy, bitter, criticizing the rest of humanity for not catering to your world vision and not corresponding to your plans??? If you are unhappy person you need to repent of your sins, so that you can allow the glory of God enter your heart, your life. Holding on to your sins, to sins of other people makes us unhappy and miserable. If you are happy, it must be the Lord who gives you the happiness. If you are unhappy, it's you holding on to your own unhappy vision of life. We complicate our relationship with the Lord by putting the obstacles on our way to salvation and our happiness. Let's ask the Lord, what is it that makes me unhappy, that makes me miserable and let's surrender it to the Lord. Than the desert of our hearts will change into the beauty of flowered garden, where the Lord brings forth the beauty of all living things. Enjoy the beauty of this Advent as you wait for the Lord who comes !!! Come Lord Jesus - I am yours !!!

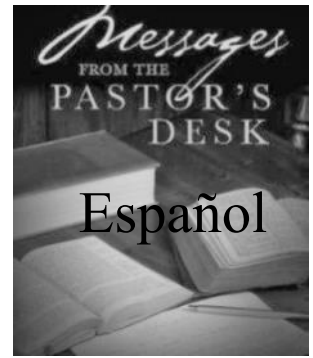
As I said on some Masses of last Sunday, I want to mention to all about the sad occurrences of finding a Host, left after the Masses in the Holy Water at the exit from the church. It happened few times after the Sunday 5 pm Mass, and last Saturday it happened after the 5pm Mass. It is not normal, and it must be stopped. Surely it is a mentally confused person, because it would not come to the mind of a normal person to do it. It seems to be spiteful to all community and to what we believe as Church. The Consecrated Host, we believe is the Body of Christ and we owe it the greatest respect. If someone has no intention of respectful receiving and eating it, then they shouldn't receive it at all. As a community we need to be vigilant to identify this disturbed person. It has to stop. Whoever this poor person is we need to stop this person from disrespecting the Eucharist. No one is forced to attend the Mass, and no one is forced to receive Holy Communion. Only those who believe it is the Body of Christ should receive the Host. I will ask the ushers to stand by the Ministers of the Eucharist and observe, that all who take the Host will consume it right after receiving it in front of the ministers. Let us remember about saying: "Amen", as the words: "the Body of Christ" are said by the ministers, same with the words: "the Blood of Christ", the answer to them is: "Amen", that means - I believe!!!

Please let's help the whole community by identifying this mentally disturbed person by praying and being vigilance. That vigilance let it extend to all our activities in the parish. If you see something strange or out of normal, please let me know, or communicate it to any person from the parish stuff. Let's be attentive, as someone may be acting wrong because they are hurting in some way and they don't know how to express their hurt. They may be confused about being pressured to receive Communion, as they stand in the line of people coming out of the bench's in the church. Those people feeling pressure about the reception of Holy Communion may be aggressive and inappropriate in responding when they are approached by others. Please be attentive and careful, gentle and polite. As we do this, I will actively reconsider putting cameras into different areas of our church building and property to help monitor any strange behavior. This will be done to help us with security on the parish grounds. It is our home and we have to make sure it is safe for all. I want to thank everyone who are concerned, and I ask your help in being responsible for all we have and do. God bless everyone !!! Fr. Stan



Queridos hermanos y hermanas.

Esta semana celebramos en la liturgia la fiesta de la Inmaculada Concepción, la Patrona de la Iglesia en los Estados Unidos. La Santísima Madre es la única persona humana que esta llena de gracia. Jesús es completamente humano, pero al mismo tiempo, también es completamente divino. La Santísima Madre recibió la gracia de la libertad del pecado original para convertirse en un signo portador de Dios. Ella es capaz de reconocer y cumplir la voluntad de Dios en todas las cosas. Su vida es una respuesta perfecta al plan de salvación para el resto de la humanidad. Es mucho para admirar y aprender por nosotros como contemplamos la vida y la persona de la madre bendita. Por eso, hasta que usted y yo aprendamos a corresponder perfectamente con Dios, hasta que necesitemos reflexionar sobre las virtudes de María, esto nos ayudara a establecer el rumbo correcto hacia ella. La próxima semana contemplaremos las apariciones de la Santísima Madre a San Juan Diego, con el mensaje de un tierno amor maternal para el y para todas las personas. Recibámoslo y hagámoslo nuestro. “¿No estoy aquí que soy tu madre?”, como la Santísima Madre le hablo a Juan Diego. Escucha esas palabras, hazlas tuyas, percibe su amor por ti y deja de actuar como huérfano que no cree en el amor.



Cuando entramos en el Adviento, San Juan Bautista nos llama a preparar el camino del Señor. Esa preparación se compara con hacer una carretera en el desierto para que el Señor venga con salvación a nosotros. La manera de hacer esa preparación es a través del espíritu de arrepentimiento. Al deshacernos de todos nuestros pecados ante el Señor, al arrepentirnos de todas nuestras acciones incorrectas, actitudes y nuestros pensamientos malvados, nos convertimos en esa carretera abierta a través de la cual el Señor viene a nosotros con la experiencia de su salvación. El quita nuestros pecados, nos hace personas libres y felices. ¿Eres esta persona feliz que permitió que el Señor entrara en tu corazón? ¿O eres la persona miserable que siempre es infeliz, amargada, que critica al reto de la humanidad por no atender tu visión del mundo y no corresponder a tus planes? Si eres una persona infeliz, debes reparar tus pecados para que puedas permitir que la gloria de Dios entre en Tu corazón, tu vida. Aferrarte a tus pecados, a los pecados de otras personas nos hace infelices y miserables. Si eres feliz debe ser el Señor quien te de la felicidad. Si no esta contento, es usted quien se aferra a su propia visión infeliz de la vida. Complicamos nuestra relación con el Señor al poner los obstáculos en nuestro camino hacia la salvación y nuestra felicidad. Preguntémosle al Señor, que es lo que me hace infeliz, eso me hace sentir mal y se lo entregamos al Señor. El desierto de nuestros corazones se convertirá en la belleza de un jardín florido, donde el Señor resalta la belleza de todos los seres vivos.

Disfruta la belleza de este Adviento mientras esperas al Señor que viene! Ven Señor Jesús, soy tuyo! Como dije en algunas Misas del Domingo pasado, quiero mencionar a todos los tristes sucesos de encontrar una Hostia, abandonada después de las Misas en el Agua Bendita a la salida de la iglesia. Sucedió pocas veces después de la misa del Domingo a las 5 PM., Y el Sábado pasado ocurrió después de la misa de las 5. PM No es normal, y debe detenerse. Seguramente es una persona mentalmente confundida, porque no le vendría a la mente a una persona normal hacerlo. Parece ser rencoroso para toda la comunidad y para lo que creemos como Iglesia. La Hostia Consagrada, creemos que es el Cuerpo de Cristo y debemos el mayor respeto. Si alguien no tiene la intención de recibirla y comerla respetuosamente, no debería recibirla en absoluto. Como comunidad, debemos estar atentos para identificar a esta persona perturbada. Tiene que parar. Quienquiera que sea esta pobre persona, debemos evitar que esta persona no respete la Eucaristía. Nadie esta obligado a asistir a la misa, y nadie esta obligado a recibir la Sagrada Comunión. Solo aquellos que creen que es de Cristo deben recibir la Hostia. Pediré a los ujieres que apoyen a los ministros de la Eucaristía y observen:

Estemos atentos, ya que alguien puede estar actuando mal porque están sufriendo de alguna manera y no saben como expresar su dolor. Pueden estar confundidos acerca de ser presionados para recibir la Comunión, ya que están en la fila de personas que salen de los asientos en la iglesia. Aquellas personas que sienten presión por la respuesta de la Sagrada Comunión pueden ser agresivas e inapropiadas para responder cuando son abordadas por otros. Por favor, sea atento y cuidadoso, amable y educado. Mientras hacemos esto, reconsiderare activamente colocar cámaras en diferentes áreas del edificio y propiedad de nuestra iglesia para ayudar a controlar cualquier comportamiento extraño, que todos los que tomen la Hostia la consumirán justo después de recibirla frente a los ministros. Recordemos decir “Amen”, como dicen los ministros, “las palabras de” el Cuerpo de Cristo, “lo mismo que la palabra” la Sangre de Cristo “la respuesta de ellos es :”Amen”, que significa ¡!!Yo creo!!!

Por favor, ayudemos a toda la comunidad identificando a esta persona con trastornos mentales mediante la acción y la vigilancia. Esa vigilancia se extenderá a todas nuestras actividades en la parroquia. Si usted ve algo extraño o fuera de lo normal, hágamelo saber o comuníquelo a cualquier persona del personal de la parroquia. Esto se hará para ayudarnos con la seguridad en los terrenos de la parroquia. Es nuestro hogar y tenemos que asegurarnos de que sea seguro para todos. Quiero agradecer a todos los que están preocupados, y les pido su ayuda para ser responsables de todo lo que tenemos y hacemos. Dios les bendiga a todos!!! Fr. Stan

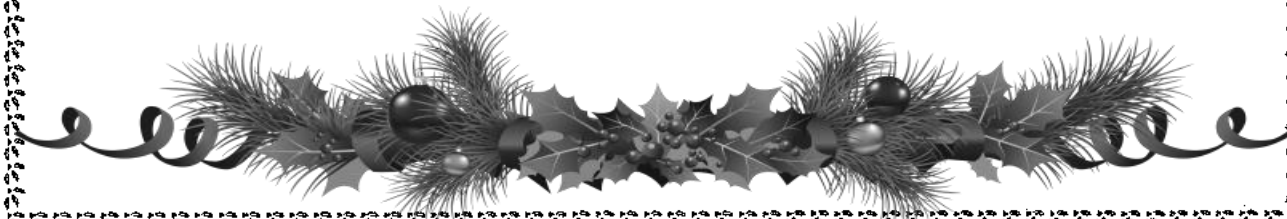

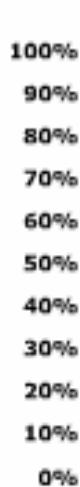
