You may need a letter to be a Godparent or a Sponsor for Confirmation or you may want to register you child for Religious Education. Whatever be the reason, you must first register in the Parish. To do so you need to fill out a registration form available in English and Spanish at the Parish Business Office during business hours. Monday through Saturday.

## *2nd Sunday of Easter-Divine Mercy Sunday*

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

**HAPPY EASTER TO EVERYONE !!!** We can wish it for 50 days, as you know the Easter Season extends till Pentecost and this year it will be on June 9th.

Today we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, as Jesus asked Saint Faustina to promote his Mercy and the love of his open heart to all who seek forgiveness and love. Let us accept His invitation through Saint Faustina.

I wish that you all meeting with the Resurrected Jesus. He can appear to you as he appeared to the Apostles, to St. Paul, to St. Faustina and to many others. A lot of Saints met the Risen Christ and left their experiences described for us, to ponder and prepare ourselves for meeting Jesus. Surely the best of all meetings with Jesus are described for us by the Evangelists. Jesus is Risen and very real like you and me.

He comes to spend time with the Apostles helping them to understand the resurrection. He explains to them the Scriptures on the way to Emaeus and shares with them the meal and as He breaks the bread with them they recognize him and are happy, they return to Jerusalem to share the experience with the Apostles.

In the Gospel we read today Jesus brings to the Apostles the gift of peace. It is the gift of the Risen Christ to all who believe. As He forgives our sins, He leaves us in peace with ourselves, with others and with God. He recalls us to deeper love and commitment as he asks us through Peter: “- Peter do you love me ???”, asking him three times, to give him a chance to forgive himself and be assured of Jesus continuous love and call.

Unbelieving Thomas, gets his chance to meet Jesus and touch his wounds on his hands and Jesus' open side. He is encouraged to be a believer, and than Jesus blesses all who will believe without demanding Jesus to show them himself. Although if you should have doubts, there is nothing wrong with asking Jesus to reveal himself to you. You have to be careful to be humble, so that you would not be deceived by the Devil.

A good person to help you with that is Saint Faustina, who described her encounter with Jesus in her Diary of Divine Mercy. If you want to see Jesus you should read her book. You can get it from Reina in the back of the Church on Sundays, as she brings it for the purpose of making it easy for everyone to find what you need.

If you want to know what Jesus has in mind and heart, you need to read the Gospels and the accounts of their meetings with Christ, and so prepare your own meeting with Him, who is the Savior of the World and Redeemer of all Souls.

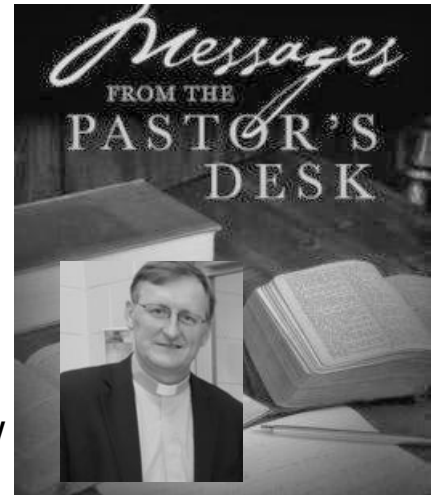
Jesus told Saint Faustina:

*“Let the greatest sinners place their trust in My mercy. They have the right before others to trust in the abyss of My mercy. My daughter, write about My mercy towards tormented souls. Souls that make an appeal to My mercy delight Me. To such souls I grant even more graces than they ask. I cannot punish even the greatest sinner if he makes an appeal to My compassion, but on the contrary, I justify him in My unfathomable and inscrutable mercy. Write: before I come as a just judge, I first open wide the door of My mercy. He who refuses to pass through the door of My mercy must pass through the door of My justice...” (1146)*

Come to the Divine Mercy Sunday Prayer Service at 2:30 today Sunday, April 28th to hear of that message and to experience the encounter with the Risen Christ. We will have Franciscan Friars and Sisters of the Renewal conduct our Hour of Mercy prayer service.

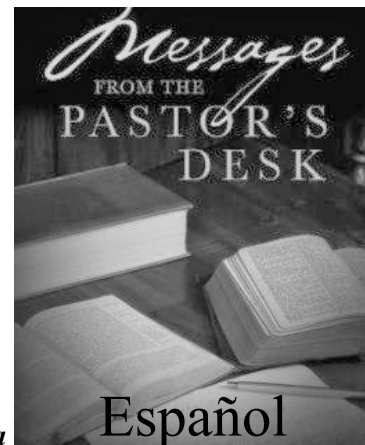

## ST. ANNE'S OUTREACH

Thank you to all who generously donate to our food pantry. During March 2019, we were happy to assist 113 families, 34 seniors 154 adults and 137 children. We helped 5 new families. The generosity of the parishioners of St. Anne's Parish allows us to reach out to people in our Brentwood/Bay Shore neighborhood who struggle each day to make ends meet.

We also distributed Easter baskets to 127 children whose parents come to our pantry each month. Teenagers from the Bay Shore/Islip area assisted in making 60 Easter baskets for these children.

A wonderful group of seniors from Islip donated 50 Easter baskets. All the baskets were given out before Easter and I know the children were delighted to receive them. Thank you to all who helped.

When items are available at our Outreach, we give our clients gently used clothing, towels and bedding. Any donated clothing or bedding should be washed or dry cleaned for sanitary reasons. Our clients are very grateful for these extra items. All donations are truly appreciated by those who cannot afford to purchase them on their own.

Here are some items we need this month: **soup, rice, beans, cereal, jelly (small jars), juices, toilet paper, tissues, paper towels, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap, deodorant, toothpaste, shaving cream, disposable razors, diapers (size 3, 4 & 5), baby wipes, feminine hygiene products, pet food and laundry detergent.** If you have any questions, please call me 631-273-8113 ext. 229.

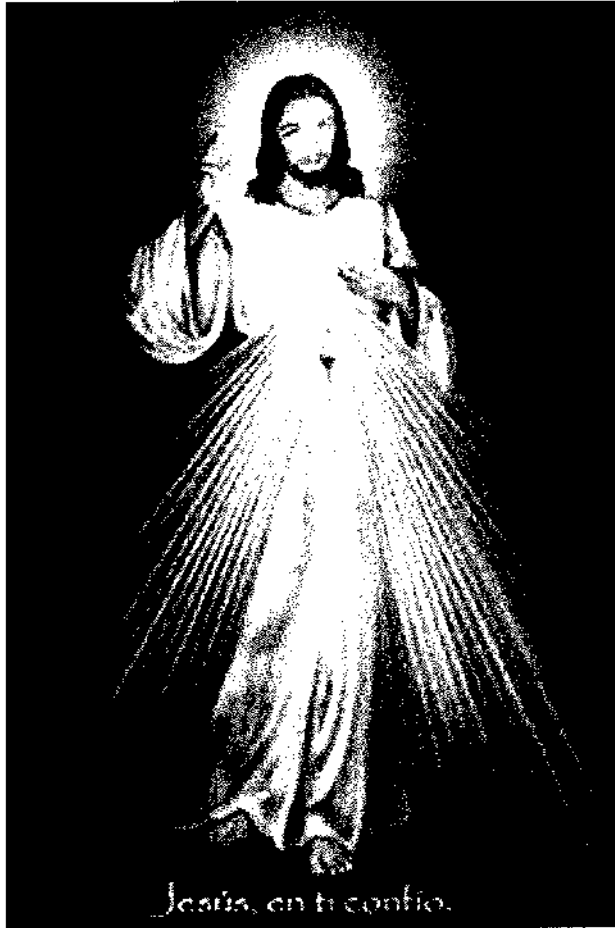

**II Domingo de Pascua (Divina Misericordia)**

Hech. 5:12-16; Sl 118; Ap. 1:9-11ss; Jn. 20:19-31

El II domingo de pascua se llamó “de la misericordia” desde siempre, aunque adquirió relevancia devocional a raíz del deseo del Papa S. Juan Pablo II en año 2000, quien inspirado en las revelaciones dadas a Sor Faustina lo “rebautizó” como Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Sin ser jactancioso, mi itinerario aquí en NY está marcado por esta bella advocación al amor infinito de Dios que llamamos Misericordia, y es qué en enero de 2017 un grupo considerable de fieles de DRVC asistimos al Congreso Mundial de la Divina Misericordia que tuvo lugar ese año en Filipinas.

Una conocida “página” católica\* en internet señala 5 los puntos fundamentales de la devoción a la Divina Misericordia:

Confiar en la Misericordia de Dios.

Confianza es la esencia y alma de la devoción y condición para recibir gracias.

La misericordia define nuestra actitud ante cada persona.

Amor activo hacia el prójimo es otra condición para recibir las gracias.

El devoto haga al menos una obra de misericordia al día.

Este breve itinerario habrá que ampliarlo, bien yendo a la internet, y mejor sumergiéndonos en el mar de conocimientos revelados a la Santa Faustina Kowalska en una amplia literatura que está al alcance de todos por medio del Apostolado de la Divina Misericordia parroquial.

El Evangelio de hoy nos presenta 2 escenas de apariciones del Resucitado. En la primera aparición ya Jesús da el Espíritu Santo que va a impulsar a los discípulos para “ir y anunciar la Buena Nueva”, podríamos decir: para “ir y comunicar la alegría”, “ir y animar a los otros”, “ir y dar testimonio” ...todas y cada una de estas expresiones en “sentido positivo” ...SIEMPRE POSITIVO, NUNCA NEGATIVO.

En la segunda aparición esta presente “el que faltaba”, “el que se había apartado del grupo”, “el que pasa algo en la comunidad y fue último en enterarse”, pero bueno, la infinita bondad de Dios permitió que también éste “fuera un testigo” de la resurrección del Señor. La interrogante hoy es: ¿seré yo Señor que no me había enterado que estas resucitado? Si así fuera, con Tomás digamos: “Señor mío y Dios mío” y vayamos a la Misión.

### *La Croix, instrument du salut de l'humanité*

Il est de l'avis de tout chrétien que le Christ en versant son sang a tout paye. Pourtant, cela n'exclut pas dans le monde actuel : le mal, la vengeance, la guerre, l'exclusion, la discrimination, la misère et la faim..... « *On arrive à l'aube qu'en traversant la nuit. Et le chemin conduisant à la délivrance est ardue.* » Les Israelites, quand ils ont vu que Pharaon s'approchait d'eux, eurent grande peur et ont préféré de rester en Egypte pour servir les Egyptiens plutôt que de mourir dans le désert (Ex 14, 12). Souvent, les gens indépendamment de leur vouloir ont tendance à tout endurer quand l'avenir est incertain. Néanmoins, à côté de tout qui peut constituer un défi, un obstacle, un échec, une défaite, une déception... Jésus octroie le gage du réconfort à ceux qui peinent : « Venez à moi, vous qui peinez et ployez sous le fardeau, et moi je vous soulagerai » (Mt 11, 28). Ainsi pouvons-nous dire avec Jean SALEM : « lorsque doute, épreuves, souffrances physique ou morale nous assaillent.... s'accrocher au Christ le seul point d'attache qui ne cède jamais. » L'épreuve est un moyen pour jauger l'intensité de notre foi, et rien n'est impossible à celui qui croit (Mc 9, 23).
