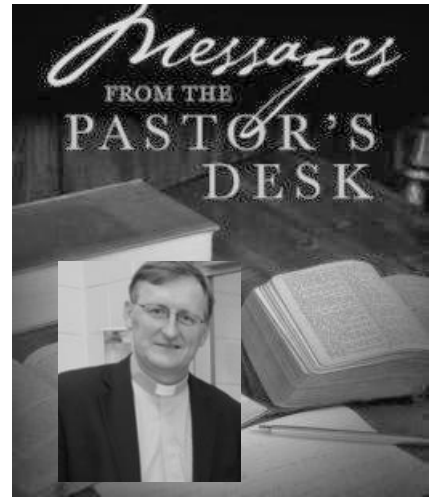
Today we are on the way to Wieliczka the salt mine. We will have a Mass underground and we will continue to pray for all of you.

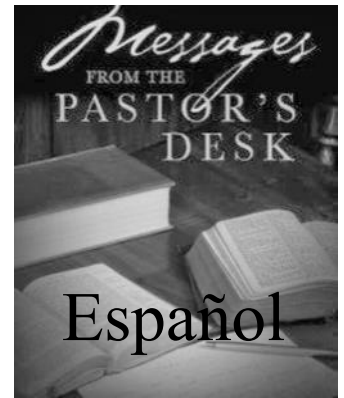
Hoy vamos de camino a la mina de Sal de Wieliczka. Donde tendremos la misa dentro de la mina y seguiremos orando por todos ustedes.

DOMINGO XXI-C DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO*

Isaías 66:18-21 Salmo 117:1, 2 Hebreos 12:5-7, 11-13
Lucas 12:22-30

El evangelio agrupa tres asuntos que confluyen como reacción a la pregunta por si son pocos los que se salvan. La salvación aparece como algo difícil de conseguir, pero no porque el pueblo escogido sea pequeño o poco numeroso, sino porque la dinámica de la salud de Dios no se ajusta los modos humanos.

La imagen de la salvación adopta la de un banquete real. Para participar d este no cuenta pertenecer a esta o aquella nación. El criterio de pertenencia no puede validar el “obrar el mal”. Los “operadores de iniquidad” de los que habla el texto griego son personas que están al servicio de intereses opuestos a los de Dios. Es el hacer lo que determina la participación en la salud, y no otra cosa. Hacer el bien esta al alcance de todas las personas, y las hermana con los padres y profetas del reino. Es un rasgo universal.

El segundo resorte para la salud es paradójico. Los sitios de privilegio serán ocupados por los despreciados y marginados, los últimos. Estos tienen asegurado su lugar en el banquete. La comunidad cristiana tiene que colocar en su horizonte de vida este llamado de Jesús que camina a Jerusalén. Lo que nos hace familiares de Dios es hacer el bien y, como el, poner en el centro de nuestra atención a los que ahora son últimos. No hay que ir muy lejos para dar con ellos. Ellos nos abrirán la puerta estrecha.

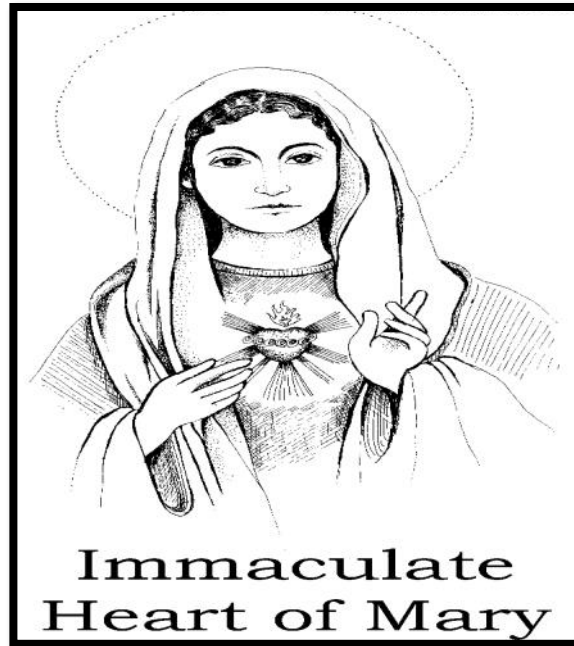

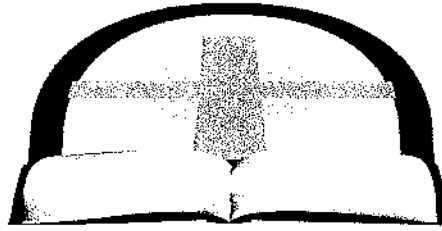
