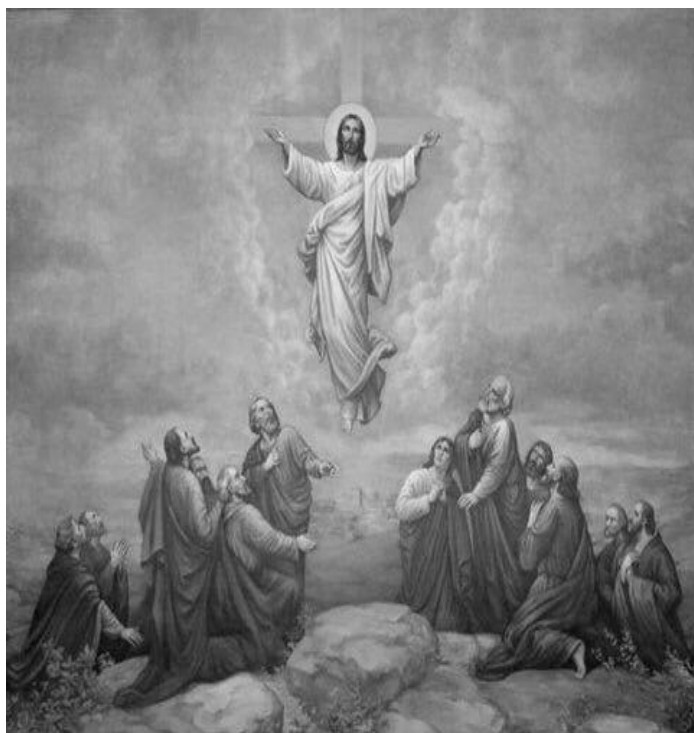

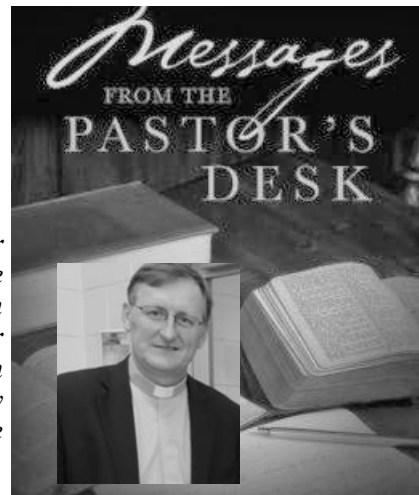

7th Sunday of Easter



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Last two Sundays we have celebrated First Communions for our 137 children. They were all so beautiful and ready to make this step forward in their friendship with Jesus. Receiving Holy Communion is reminding us, that we are the temple of God. Jesus physically is present in our body, in our soul, in our spirit, in our heart. We are given a new possibility to love Him from the depths of our hearts, and to perceive a new way of being loved by Christ from outside and from within our hearts. It is very powerful experience, and if we understand it properly it may lead us to great mysticism of love for God and of perceiving of a great love of God for us.

This is a new dialogue, new encounter, new depth of relationship which needs to be fostered and nurtured by continued religious education, personal prayer and participation at Mass. This process of spiritual growth will never stop, and it will result in holiness of life for the person that allows itself to be led by Christ.

In this process of spiritual growth, much is expected from the parents and guardians of the children, as it is obvious that they cannot make it without the example and help of adults. Let us aspire to be like Jesus, and let us allow Him to transform us from within our hearts. This is why it is so important that we consecrate our hearts and lives to Jesus. We can fill our hearts with many things or we can fill it with Jesus.

The readings of this Sunday continue to speak about God's glory. Saint Stephen was ready to sacrifice his life for Christ and his glory. In the midst of life threatening situation, Stephen contemplated God and prayed for his persecutors to be forgiven and commended his own spirit to God. In the second reading St. John continues to present to us the glory of heaven where Jesus promises to satisfy the thirst for God and for life giving water for those who believe. And Jesus continues his own prayer for those entrusted to him by the Father, desiring to share with them his love and glory.

As for us, it is important to decide to whom or to what we entrust our lives and hearts. It is crucial, because it is going to define our happiness. What or who owns your attention, your mind or heart, your love??? Only Jesus can give us true happiness and glory.

Some people are always unhappy, because they give too much attention to what is not important. Too much self absorption is not good. Too much importance given to the world is not good. Too much attention given to what others say is not good. Our heart belongs to God, who is the only one to satisfy its thirst for love, for meaning and for purpose. Here I reprint my preferred poem.

Attributed to Fr. Pedro Arrupe, SJ (1907-1991)

*Nothing is more practical than
finding God, than
falling in Love
in a quite absolute, final way.
What you are in love with,
what seizes your imagination, will affect everything.
It will decide
what will get you out of bed in the morning,
what you do with your evenings,
how you spend your weekends,
what you read, whom you know,
what breaks your heart,
and what amazes you with joy and gratitude.
Fall in Love, stay in love,
and it will decide everything.*

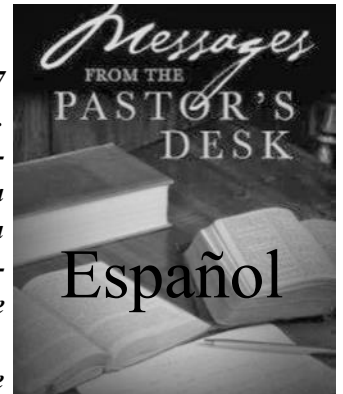

- Please do not wear deodorant, perfume, powders, lotions or creams on the breast area.
- Please bring your photo ID and insurance card, if insured.

Eligibility:

- Must be female and 40 years of age or older.
- No mammograms in the past year.
- Not pregnant or breastfeeding.
- No implants or breast issues, such as a lump or nipple discharge.
- Never diagnosed with breast cancer.
- Office visit within the past year with a gynecologist, primary care physician or internist who is willing to accept the results of the screening.

NOTE: Individuals who do not have health insurance will be processed through the Cancer Services Program of New York, if eligible.

VII DOMINGO PASCUA

La reflexión de hoy obligadamente se divide en dos partes: *la Ascensión* (que celebramos el jueves) y un fragmento de la *Oración sacerdotal* (hoy, VII Pascua).

Lucas 24:46-53 El mismo Jesús de Nazareth se presentó a sus discípulos nuevamente “con un cuerpo glorificado” ...La incredulidad de los discípulos se transformó en gozo. Ese día se encomendó “una misión” a los discípulos de Jesús, para cumplirla será necesario el envío del Espíritu Santo, por lo mismo el Señor tiene que irse y enviar al Paráclito. El acontecimiento de la Ascensión, sin embargo, encierra un Misterio más, que se resume en la Oración colecta del *jueves de la Ascensión*:

Concédenos, Dios todopoderoso, rebosar de santa alegría y, gozosos, elevar a ti fervorosas gracias ya que la Ascensión de Cristo, tu Hijo, es también nuestra victoria, pues a donde llegó él, que es nuestra cabeza, esperamos llegar también nosotros, que somos su cuerpo... Amén.

Juan 17:20-26 El texto de hoy domingo tiene un doble sentido. El primero, Jesús se ha ido, pero permanece con su pueblo, el mismo Maestro eleva una oración por los suyos, quiere llevar a sus seguidores al conocimiento del Padre, pero éste está en los cielos, por lo mismo quiere lo conozcamos a través suyo que aún está en el mundo: (...) *Les he dado a conocer tu nombre y se lo seguiré dando a conocer (...)*. El segundo, nos prepara hacia la consumación del tiempo pascual, **la fiesta de Pentecostés**. Dice la Oración colecta *este domingo séptimo de pascua*:

Muéstrate propicio, Señor, a nuestras súplicas y así como creemos que el Salvador del género humano comparte ya contigo tu gloria, así también experimentemos que permanece con nosotros hasta el fin de los tiempos, conforme a su promesa...Amén.
