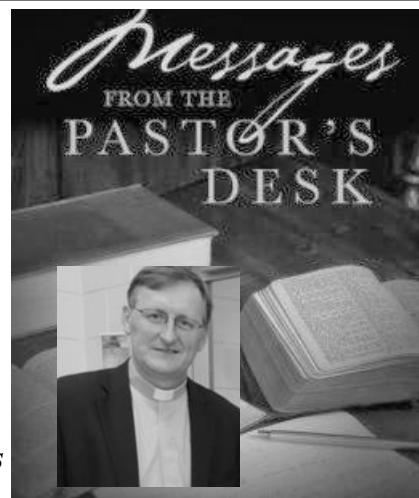

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Last Sunday we had encouragement from Fr. Steve Brown SVD sharing with us his missionary experience and faith. Our faith has to become practical in serving the Lord and others. Jesus wants us to be his instruments, his messengers as the Gospel said, they were going two by two to places that Jesus intended to visit. Would you consider to be that instrument or messenger of Jesus ???



Would you consider to serve in the church in some capacity ??? Or; all that you do is just about you ??? - as the world tells us to attract us to whatever their purpose is. If the saying - "it is all about you"- attracts our ego because we all crave attention, because we all are self centered. Most probably the one saying it is trying to catch our attention, so that we would participate in their project, whatever it is.

But in order to be happy in life we need to learn to give and to serve others. We need to sanctify our self-centeredness by perceiving in it the love of God. God who loves us from within, trying to help us to bring that love out of ourselves to others. A Happy person is the person who believes in the love of God for them, who believes in the love of others for them.

So it is a fundamental experience to know how much God loves us, as it gives us the sense of self worth and lovability. This knowledge of God's love will carry the person through life. Knowing God's love, one can survive with limited human experience of love, or grow to its fullest potential.

Here comes the most popular Jewish prayer and commandment:

Deuteronomy 6:4-5 "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might." And love your neighbor as yourself.

Let us imagine Jesus summarizing the Old and New Testament in this statement, what a powerful lesson that carries every Jew through life if only the person allows it. This is what will bring you and me to eternal life, Jesus confirmed. Do this and you shall live.

God on his part does love us completely, and if we correspond to his love it will transform us. It will enable us to love ourselves and our neighbor. Jesus answered for us the question of a lifetime. This question and answer explains to us the whole sense and purpose of our life.

Thank You Jesus for making it so simple for us. Please help us to fulfill this simple commandment of love. Let us decide to love and to serve so that we might have eternal life.

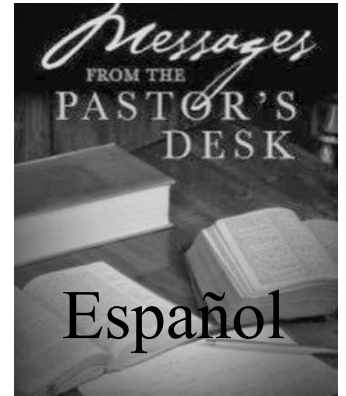

The generosity of the parishioners of St. Anne Parish allows us to reach out to people in our Brentwood/Bay Shore neighborhood who struggle each day to make ends meet. Thank you to all who generously donate to our food pantry. During June 2019, we were happy to assist 121 families, 31 seniors, 160 adults and 144 children. We also helped 15 new families.

School is almost finished for the year and our outreach is now requesting school supplies for the school year 2019-2020. The supply list is always very extensive: composition notebooks(no spiral notebooks), Ticonderoga #2 pencils, pens, Crayola crayons, glue, glue sticks, Fiscar scissors, highlighters, dry erase markers, thin washable markers, rulers, ruled index cards, pencil cases, 1" and 2" binders, loose leaf paper, 2-pocket folders (laminated or plastic), lunch bags and backpacks. Any donated school supply item will be gratefully appreciated.



Here are some items we need this month: soup, Goya beans, cereal, jelly (small jars), juices, toilet paper, tissues, paper towels, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap, deodorant, toothpaste, tooth brushes, shaving cream, disposable razors, diapers (size 4 & 5), baby wipes, feminine hygiene products, pet food and laundry detergent.
