Every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat (and items made with meat) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent. Every person between the age of 18 and 59 (beginning of 60th year) must **fast** on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

3rd Sunday of Lent

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

With this weekend we are already in spring and close to half way through Lent. It moves so fast as those themes of subsequent Sunday Gospel readings as follows: after Ash Wednesday's reminder, that we are dust and unto dust we shall return, reminding us of our total dependence on God.

On 1st Sunday of Lent we have heard of Temptations of Jesus by the Devil, awakening us to the reality of what we are facing. Then on the 2nd Sunday of Lent we heard the Gospel of Transfiguration of Jesus, showing us the rewards of following Jesus already in this life.

And now on 3rd Sunday of Lent in the first reading we have God revealing himself to Moses, sending him on the mission to lead the chosen people to the promised land. So in the Gospel of this Sunday, after the previous revelation of our human state of affairs of sin and temptation, than Christ's revelation of himself; today He asks us to use our knowledge of what we have learned and be on the mission of bearing the fruits of conversion and repentance, by doing good works of faith. Without conversion and good fruits of our life we will perish, we will become those ashes of the earth as we heard on Ash Wednesday, forgotten by others and unworthy of God's company and his glory of heaven. Unworthy of his friendship and love.

What a powerful sequence of events that comes our way every day, as we realize that life never stops. God wants me to bear good fruits **TODAY**, because tomorrow may be gone and never be mine. My chance to make a difference is only **TODAY**, because every successive day becomes a **TODAY**, so we all deal with, and affect reality by making it a **TODAY's** effort in my relationships to others and to God himself. To do good **TODAY**, to pray **TODAY**, to forgive **TODAY**, to be patient **TODAY**, to be humble **TODAY**, to serve **TODAY**, to learn **TODAY**, to teach **TODAY**, to help **TODAY**, to listen **TODAY**.

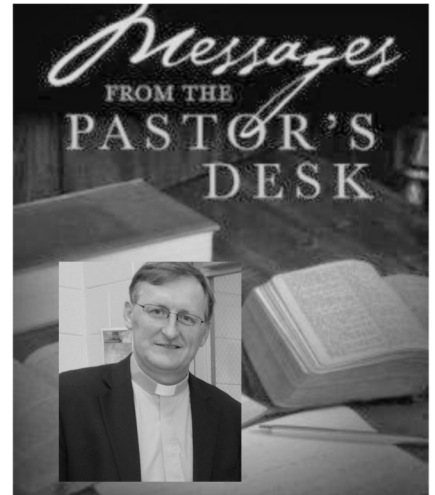
Because God is present to me now and always in this perpetual **TODAY**, as God told it to Moses: *I AM WHO AM*. God is always in the present moment. The past is gone, and the future didn't materialize yet, so the only way to correspond to anything in life is by using well the present moment - PERPETUAL NOW - PERPETUAL **TODAY**.

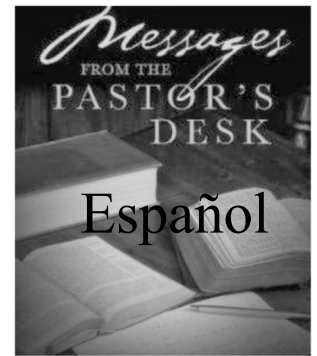
Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos.

El tiempo se mueve tan rápido como esos temas del Evangelio del Domingo subsiguiente que leen lo siguiente: después del recordatorio del Miércoles de Ceniza que somos polvo y al polvo volveremos, recordándonos nuestra total dependencia de Dios. El 1er Domingo de Cuaresma hemos escuchado sobre las tentaciones de Jesús por el demonio, despertándonos a la realidad de lo que enfrentamos. Luego, en el Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma, escuchamos el Evangelio de la Transfiguración de Jesús, que nos muestra los beneficios de seguir a Jesús en esta vida. 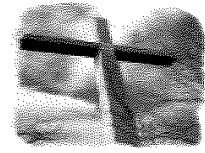

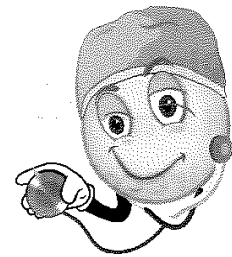

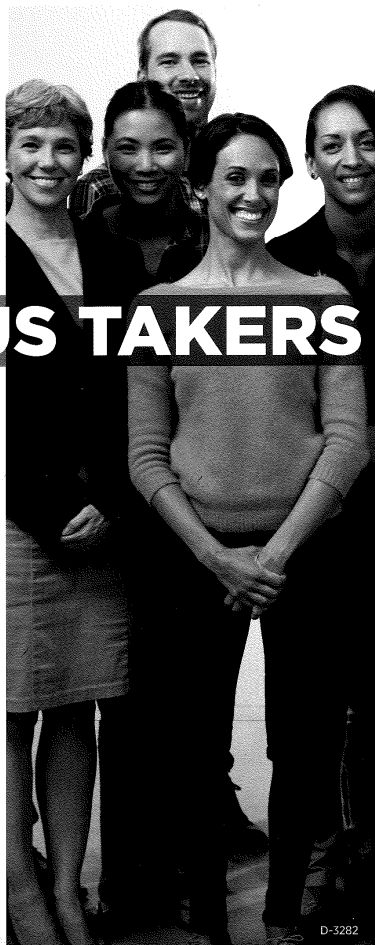
