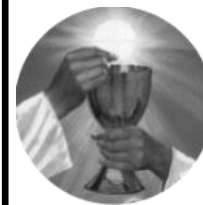

8th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This coming Wednesday we will celebrate Ash Wednesday, that is our beginning of Lent. Lent is a time of preparation for Easter Triduum, that is Holy Thursday of the Last Supper, Good Friday of the Lord's Passion and Death, and Holy Saturday the Vigil of the Resurrection. This year Easter Sunday will be on April 21st, so Palm Sunday, which will start Holy Week will be on April 14th.

Even though we all like very much Christmas, Easter is a greater feast. Christmas reveals to us Christ's humanity, but Easter reveals to us His divinity. It is through his divinity that He is able to save all of us. In his humanity, He shows us how close God is to us and how much God loves us, but it is his power of divinity that conquers death for himself and for us. Jesus' Resurrection is much bigger revelation to us than his Incarnation. The Incarnation has this aspect of wonder, but Resurrection has this aspect of victory over death; and so total power over life. Only Jesus can give us the gift of eternal life and he offers it to us through his resurrection. In his Incarnation, Jesus offers us his friendship, in his Resurrection He makes it eternal.

So Lent is our preparation for Christ's Resurrection, but as well for our resurrection. As we look at Jesus, we realize that his whole life is a preparation for his death and resurrection, and he is making us aware that it is so for us too. This is why he invites us to imitate him, so that we would prepare for heaven by good deeds. We express our faith in Christ by listening to his word and accomplishing good deeds.

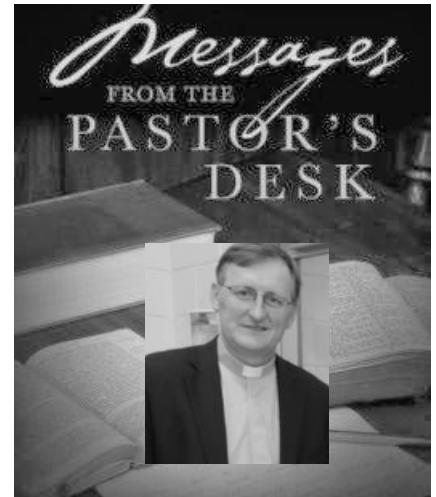
Lent prepares us for this fight with the forces of evil, with Satan himself. In order to win we must submit ourselves to Jesus and in his name we can win this battle. Without Christ we can do nothing. Satan easily manipulates the weaknesses of our ego and only Christ can defend us. This is why we set our Lenten path with Christ, so that we would not be defeated by Satan with illusions about this life and next. Only Christ can help us to win the battle with our own sins, only Christ can save us from the brokenness of our sins and from death and the grave imposed upon us by it.

Learning how helpless we are without Christ, we want to turn ourselves to him, and Lent is a way of doing it as Jesus says: by prayer, fasting and alms giving. Those three are indispensable for us in order to win the battle with evil and with our sins. So let us ponder God's Word in prayer, let us humble ourselves before God by fasting, let us see and respond to the needs of others, that is the path to victory over evil. Those three steps are indicated to us by Jesus himself. He gives us the recipe for victory. Will you try??? Did it occur to you ever to use those steps to better yourself??? To become a better person, to become closer to God??? To win against any evil??? If you didn't, try this Lenten season to experience for yourself. We will have various opportunities to participate: in the spiritual events, retreats, acts of kindness, almsgiving, prayers, fasting, way of the cross.

o remind us of the need to seek Jesus, we will be told on Ash Wednesday: "Remember man you are dust and unto dust you shall return." It is a fundamental truth about our lives, that our response is needed today in order to be prepared for tomorrow. We have only one day at the time to our disposition. We have only today, tomorrow may never be mine; and one day for sure will not.

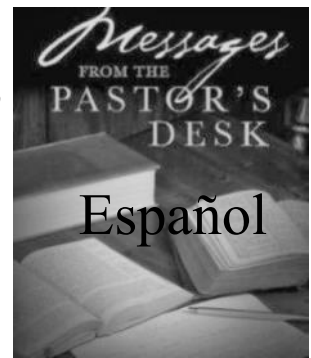

El Próximo Miércoles celebraremos el Miércoles de Ceniza, que es nuestro comienzo de Cuaresma. La Cuaresma es un tiempo de preparación para el Triduo Pascual, que es el Jueves Santo de la Última Cena, el Viernes Santo de la Pasión y la Muerte del Señor, y el Sábado Santo la Vigilia de la Resurrección. Este Año, el Domingo de Pascua será el 21 de Abril, por lo que el Domingo de Ramos que comenzara la Semana Santa será el 14 de Abril. Aunque a todos no gusta mucho la Navidad, la Pascua es una fiesta mas grande. La Navidad nos revela la humanidad de Cristo, pero la Pascua nos revela Su divinidad.



Es a través de Su divinidad que El puede salvarnos a todos. En su humanidad, El nos muestra cuan cerca esta Dios de nosotros y cuanto nos ama Dios, pero es su poder de la divinidad que conquista la muerte para si mismo y para nosotros. 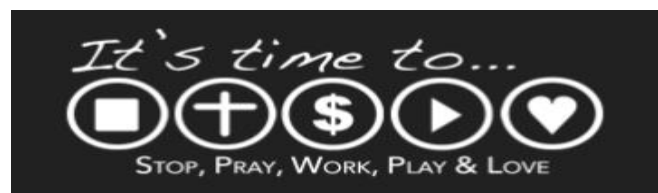

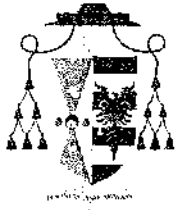

Lent 2019

Dear Friends:

As we begin our prayer, fasting and almsgiving for the needs of the poor and the suffering of the world in this Lenten season 2019, we recommit ourselves to repentance, conversion and holiness individually and as a Church. We remember in a focused way this Lent the survivors of clergy sexual abuse and all forms of abuse and we pray for the purification, reform and sanctification of the Church.

In *Rejoice and Be Glad*, Pope Francis says: "Do not be afraid of holiness. It will take away none of your energy, vitality or joy (32)...The Lord wants us to be saints and not to settle for a bland and mediocre existence (1)...Holiness is the most attractive face of the Church (9)...The Church needs passionate missionaries, enthusiastic about sharing true life. The saints surprise us, they confound us, because by their lives they urge us to abandon a dull and dreary mediocrity (138)."

One of the ways we commit ourselves to this radiant, natural and humble holiness is by expanding the breadth and depth of our daily engagement with the inspired Sacred Scriptures. We are called to live the words of Psalm 119: "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."

The saints of every decade and century inspire us since "the most profound interpretation of Scripture comes precisely from those who let themselves be shaped by the word of God through listening, reading, and assiduous meditation". (Pope Benedict XVI, *The Word of the Lord*) (48) Could each one of us individually and together, united in communion as a Church, take one step with the Holy Spirit this Lent to deepen our love for the inspired Sacred Scriptures?

In his Apostolic Exhortation *The Word of the Lord* (2010), Pope Benedict XVI gives us an excellent process of praying individual biblical passages, a process of *lectio divina* or sacred reading of the text that includes reading, meditating, praying, contemplating and living the biblical text. We need to believe with confidence and a spirit of adventure that the Holy Spirit is present in the text and that the Holy Spirit's tongues of flame are connecting the text to our souls transforming us in mysterious and profound ways.

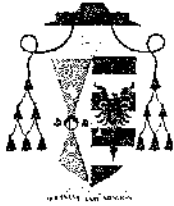
I would like to analyze and comment on the steps that Pope Benedict XVI proposes to us. (For the complete version of Bishop Barres' Lenten Letter 2019 which analyzes Pope Benedict's approach to *lectio divina*, see this link www.bishopbarreslentenletter2019.org.) The Word of God makes us realists who recognize that the Word of God is the foundation of all things. (10)

As your bishop and servant, I invite you during this Lenten Season 2019 and beyond, to discover or rediscover the power of the Word of God by reading, meditating, praying, contemplating and living the inspired Sacred Scriptures. In the end, as Father Gaston Courtois points out: "Contemplatives are the true missionaries and alone can be the true spiritual teachers".

Thank you all for your passion and daily dedication to the inspired Sacred Scriptures. Thank you for being the contemplatives, the missionaries, the spiritual teachers that are the agents and instruments of *dramatic missionary growth* on Long Island and beyond.

Carta de Cuaresma 2019

Queridos amigos:

Al comenzar nuestra oración, al ayunar y al dar limosna a los pobres y ayudar a los que sufren en el mundo en esta temporada de Cuaresma de 2019, nos comprometemos de nuevo al arrepentimiento, a la conversión y a la santidad de manera individual y como Iglesia. Recordamos de manera especial en esta Cuaresma a los sobrevivientes del abuso sexual del clero y todas las formas de abuso y oramos por la purificación, reforma y santificación de la Iglesia.

En su exhortación apostólica *Alegraos y Regocijaos*, el Papa Francisco dice: "No tengas miedo de la santidad. No quitará nada de tu energía, vitalidad o alegría (32)... El Señor quiere que seamos santos y que no nos conformemos con una existencia sosa y mediocre (1)... La santidad es el rostro más atractivo de la Iglesia (9)... La Iglesia necesita misioneros apasionados, entusiastas de compartir la verdadera vida. Los santos nos sorprenden, nos retan, porque con sus vidas nos instan a abandonar una mediocridad aburrida y monótona (138)".

Una de las formas en que nos comprometemos con esta santidad radiante, natural y humilde es expandiendo la amplitud y profundidad de nuestro compromiso diario con las inspiradas Sagradas Escrituras. Estamos llamados a vivir las palabras del Salmo 119: "Tu palabra es una lámpara para mis pies y una luz para mi camino".

Los santos de cada década y siglo nos inspiran ya que "la interpretación más profunda de las Escrituras proviene precisamente de aquellos que se dejan moldear por la Palabra de Dios a través de la escucha, la lectura y la meditación asidua". (Papa Benedicto XVI, *La Palabra de Señor*) (48) ¿Será que cada uno de nosotros individualmente y juntos, unidos en comunión como Iglesia, puede dar un paso con el Espíritu Santo esta Cuaresma para profundizar nuestro amor por las inspiradas Sagradas Escrituras?


En su Exhortación apostólica *La Palabra del Señor* (2010), el Papa Benedicto XVI nos brinda un excelente proceso para orar pasajes bíblicos, un proceso de *lectio divina* o lectura sagrada del texto que incluye leer, meditar, orar, contemplar y vivir el texto bíblico. Como su obispo y siervo, les invito durante esta temporada de Cuaresma 2019 y más allá, a descubrir o redescubrir el poder de la Palabra de Dios leyendo, meditando, orando, contemplando y viviendo las inspiradas Sagradas Escrituras. Al final, como el Padre Gaston Courtois señala: " Sólo los contemplativos son los verdaderos misioneros y los verdaderos maestros espirituales".

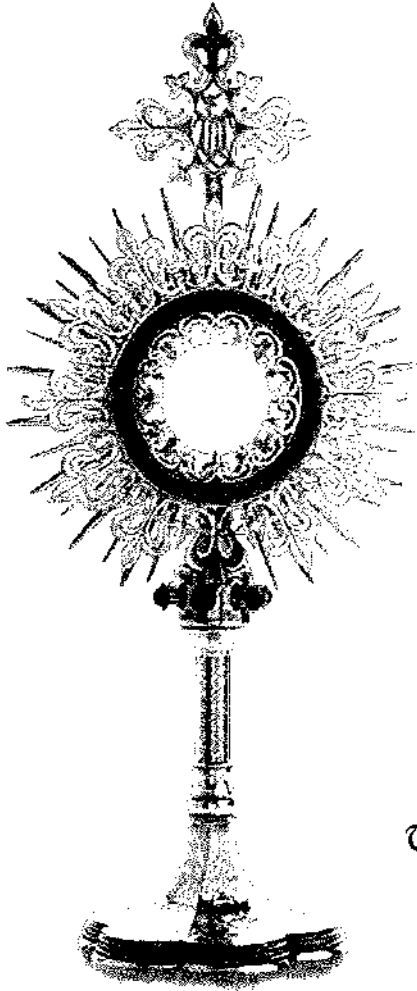

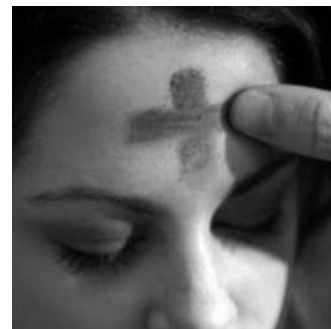

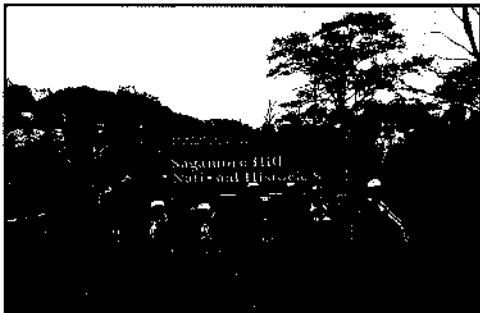
