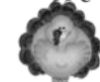

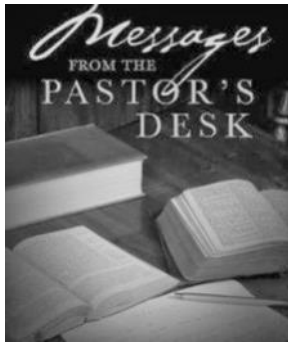

FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

We are at the end of Liturgical Year with the Feast of Christ the King of the Universe. This feast affirms for us Jesus sovereignty over the whole creation, that extends from the beginning of time into eternity that is governed by God only. No other being was there to witness the creation and no other being but God will be there in eternity except with what or whom God permits to be and to exist. None of us extends our experiential



knowledge to before our age of consciousness and it doesn't extend further beyond our time of death, yet we know that the universe existed before us and will exist after our departure for indefinite time of God's choosing. This awareness makes us small and humble before the designs of God. It makes us realize how totally we depend on God. Jesus definitely remembers always of the upcoming transformation that will occur by passing through the gate of death.

The bad thief mocked Jesus trying to escape death, but the good thief took the step in faith asking Jesus for the place in his Kingdom. Jesus doesn't delay in confirmation of it, moments before dying. He fulfills the desire of the good thief opening for him the doors of eternity.

Our celebration of Christ as the King of the Universe reaches out into the eternity, into our future life with God. It confirms that, what only faith reveals to us today, beyond the limitations of this life. It helps us to rejoice in the glory of life to come beyond our human limitations, giving us hope and joy, transforming the sadness of sin and death into the joy of eternity with God. So this celebration is a revelation of what our faith promises in the life to come, as its fullness and goal of communion with God. It is the coronation of our faith, and revelation that Jesus brings to us through his life, death and resurrection.

The best true story from the life of the saints is, that when Mother Teresa as a young girl was challenged by her brother who was a soldier, who wanted to stop her from going to become a missionary she told him: "you are a soldier serving a king of three million people, but I will be serving The King of Kings", that is Jesus himself. Than her mother whom she was never going to see again after leaving for the missions told her as an advise: "to take Jesus by hand and never let go of it ". Than as we know Mother Teresa spent her life on serving the poorest of the poor around the world. She made the best of her life giving every moment of it to God, in prayer and sacrifice of service to Jesus in the distressing disguise of the poor, unwanted, emarginated people, remembering the words of Jesus: whatever you did to the least of my brethren you did it to me. Mother Teresa lived her life for Jesus Christ the King of the Universe, seeking his face in the face of others, becoming the "pencil in Jesus' hand ". We can say what an amazing example of life lived for the mystery of Christ the King present in our midst, transforming the world by prayer, self sacrifice and service to others. This is the best proclamation of Christ the King mystery. "Long live Christ the King" was shouted by the catholic martyrs of the Mexican religious persecution in the beginning of last century before dying.

What is it going to be your manifestation of faith in Christ the King of the Universe !!!
This week we will celebrate Thanksgiving Day ! Let us remember how we can show our kindness to others and share what we have with those who may be in need. Love is about sharing what we have with others. Will you share ???

Will you love ??? Can your love for Christ be practical as Mother Teresa's was???
God bless everyone always !!!

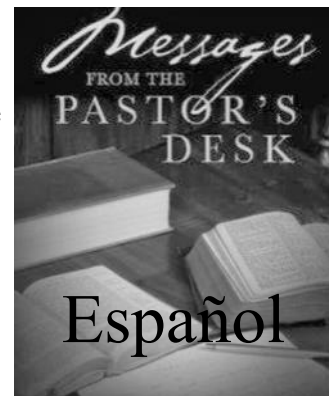

En aquel tiempo, las **autoridades** hacían muecas a Jesús, diciendo:

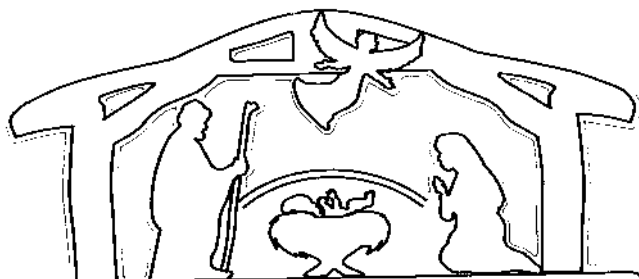

Solennité du Christ, Roi de l'Univers (Lc 23, 35-43)

La fête du Christ Roi de l'Univers, est une solennité du Seigneur qui termine la série des dimanches ordinaires du temps liturgiques. Elle tombe le 34^e dimanche ordinaire du temps simple.

Jésus est l'image de ce Roi humble, simple, humilié, honnête que plus d'un aimerait être. Car il aura pour trône le bois de la croix, pour couronne, une couronne d'épines.

Pour décrire Jésus sur la croix, Luc reprend des formules de l'Ancien Testament : Jésus est au milieu des malfaiteurs comme jadis le serviteur de Dieu (Es 53,12) ; les vêtements partagés, les moqueries, le vinaigre ... invitent à voir en lui le juste qui souffre dans les Psaumes (Ps 22, 19 ; 22, 8-9).

A la mort de Jésus, beaucoup se moquent de lui. Néanmoins, un bandit de grand chemin qu'on appelle communément « bon larron » déclara sa confiance en lui. Avec la promesse de vivre avec Jésus pour toujours, cet homme recoit le salut que Jésus est venu apporter pour l'univers entier. Mes très chers amis tout passe. Les doctrines, les courants de pensées, les systèmes, le pouvoir, l'avoir, le savoir. Mais Dieu reste et demeure. En célébrant aujourd'hui cette solennité, demandons au Seigneur la grâce de vivre en vue du royaume et de l'admettre comme étant notre unique et seul Roi. Lui seul a fait ce que personne n'osait faire en donnant sa vie pour le rachat du genre humain.
