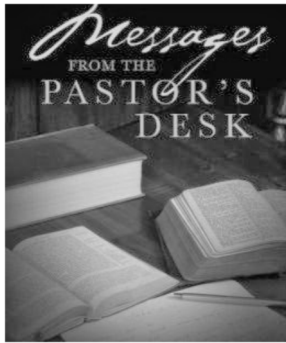

30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Today's readings bring us to the heart of our relationship with God, talking about prayer. All the readings mention the Lord's support and attentiveness to the cry of the poor, needy and humble persons. Any disadvantage of anyone is seen by the Lord and he will save them, he will redeem them. The readings are filled with hope and assertions of God's knowledge and assistance given to the needy. The Lord undoubtedly is present to anyone in trouble.



In the second reading we have Saint Paul assures us of God's saving power, and he does it as he awaits his trial and even death. But in his faith he looks beyond this life, talking about his departure after finishing the race, and now he awaits the crown of victory not only for himself but for all who have longed for Christ's appearance. Paul is satisfied with the completion of his proclamation of the Gospel for the sake of all the Gentiles to hear it through his witness. And Paul feels safe to arrive at Christ's heavenly kingdom, and all that matters now is the glory of God's name.

As we can see, St. Paul doesn't ask for anything of this earth, but of the glory of what is to come in heaven. We can ask ourselves how far is our faith take us, how far reaching are our prayers ??? Are they reaching out to heaven or are they keeping us here on earth forever ??? Where do your prayers take you ??? Are we concerned with getting up to heaven or are we just earthly consumed ???

In the Gospel of this Sunday Jesus gives us the best example of prayers, prayed by a sinner. He humbly gets to the point of his need for God's mercy and God answers him. As Jesus said, the Pharisee spoke his prayer to himself. God didn't have to listen to him because he was not speaking from his heart, but it was his own pride speaking to himself. God will always exalt the humble and proud will be humbled by life and by God.

This week we celebrate All Saints. These are the people who gave all their love for God, who loved God above all things and their neighbor as themselves or even more. Each one of the Saints shows us the path to heaven by the example of their lives. Each one is worthy of being imitated in their faith and virtues. Each one of us should find our preferred Saint and we should try to follow their example of holiness. Their paths show us a true way to heaven, they show us practical ways of living the Gospel, one that St. Paul so generously proclaimed to us and was so willing to loose life for it.

Let us accept the challenge and invitation, as Mother Theresa would say: "holiness, it is not a privilege of the few, but a simple duty of all baptized." Accept this invitation and try to be holy as God is holy !!! God bless everyone always !!!
