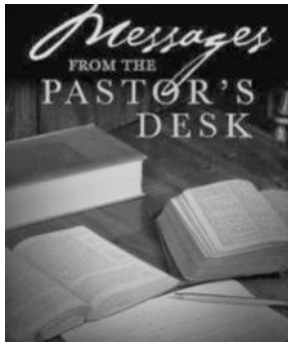

27th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

“Increase our faith “, the Apostles requested of Jesus seeing their own shortness of it, humbly admitting the need for its growth in essence and in response, in practicality of it, in common sense application of it.

As Pope Francis urges us- our faith can not be rigid and cold, it has to be understanding and shared with others to the point of catching the “smell of the sheep “. Probably disciples had

seen how Jesus adopted to every situation and people, trying to win them to the Good News. He ate with tax collectors and sinners, he spoke to anyone and attended to everyone who would come to him. And Jesus never changed, he continues to be attentive to his Church, he continues to search for the lost sheep, he continues to respond to everyone who seeks him.

Who has to change is us, who needs greater faith in Jesus is us, who needs to be more like Jesus in practice of our faith is us, who needs to love our neighbor is us, and who needs to do it humbly is us.

As we remember from last Sunday, -poor Lazarus gained heaven by humbly suffering through his life, carrying the burden of life’s circumstances, but the rich man went to hell not because he was rich, but because he didn’t care about others, he didn’t care about God, he was selfish and self centered carrying only about his own pleasures and enjoyment, totally ignoring others. This indifference and self reliance lost him. It was the lack of faith that became destructive to himself.

Sometimes people openly say that they don’t have faith in God, but in their humanity they are open to the goodness towards others and they treat others with dignity and respect, and in their case God will judge them not by what they say about Him, but God will judge them by how they treated others. This is why the way of salvation is open to everyone: even to atheists, agnostics, people of every creed and faith. We all will be judged by our deeds, and God knows perfectly how much faith we have, what are our intentions and motivations. God doesn’t care of who we are, but he cares about how we treat others, because it is through our words and actions that He ultimately sees who we truly are before him and before others.

This is why the great faith of the saints is manifested in great love for others and for God. Their great faith becomes spectacular in their deeds, miracles, prayers, sacrifices, because God himself accomplishes those deeds through them. The humility of the saints attracts the power and blessings of God. Then on the end they know that, and acknowledge the fact, that it was not they themselves doing it, but it was the Lord accomplishing it through them. This is why the Lord needs humble people to do his work. As Fr. Cirilo reminded us that Saint Mother Theresa of Calcutta would often say: “let’s pray we don’t spoil God’s work”.

Saint Paul, Saint Francis, Saint Faustina would say about themselves: “we are the useless servants and we have done what we supposed to do “, by cooperating with God’s grace, mercy and love. Let us not spoil God’s work in our parish, in our homes, in our hearts and lives, but let us correspond to the faith that we have received, small or big but let it be humble. Humility will carry us through many dangers and troubles and through success as well.

May God be praised in all things! Who found God lacks nothing! My God and my everything! Jesus I trust in you! Jesus I believe in your tender love for me, I love you! I will satiate the thirst of Jesus! Totus Tuus! My Lord and my God! I can do all things through him who strengthens me!

These are some sayings of the saints who were in love with God and with others. Those sayings summarize their faith and their lives.

What summarizes yours ???

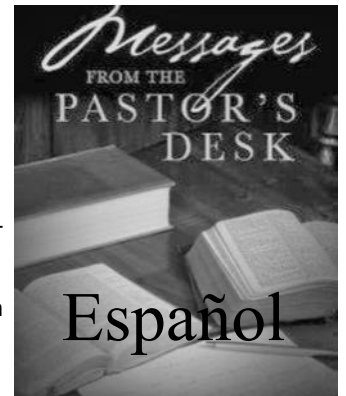

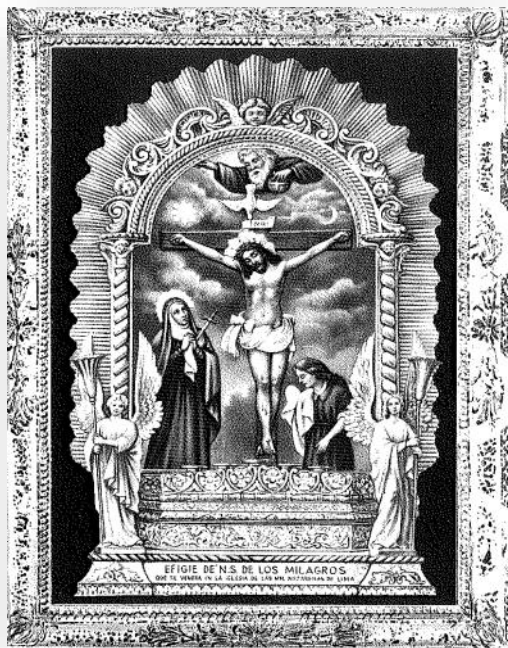

XXVII DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Hab 1:2-3;2:2-4 Sal 94:1-2,6-9 2Tm 1:16-8,13-14 Lc 17:5-10

Esta semana hemos celebrado a tres santos: S. Jerónimo, S. Francisco de Asís y Sta. Faustina. Me detengo en S. Jerónimo (30 de setiembre) a él debemos la primera traducción de la Biblia (del griego al latín): *la Vulgata*, ésta posibilitó que tengamos hoy la Biblia en nuestro idioma... una nota curiosa del Santo: se cuenta que tuvo una revelación de Cristo en la cual el mismo le pedía que le diera algo...Jerónimo le decía: “te doy mi oración, mis estudios bíblicos, hago ayunos, etc.”, y Jesús le dijo: “solo dame tus pecados para poder tener misericordia de ti...”.

Importantes reflexiones sobre la historia encontramos en la **1L**. El profeta se atreve a protestar contra Dios debido a los padecimientos de Israel (violencias, catástrofes, guerras). La respuesta de Dios llegará, aunque por el momento no entienda las cosas: *“el justo vivirá por la fe”*.

La **2L** es como un *testamento espiritual*, S. Pablo escribe desde la cárcel a su discípulo Timoteo quien esta al frente de una comunidad, misión que no resulta nada fácil: *“los duros trabajos del evangelio”*, dirá. Además, le recuerda el día en que le fueron impuestas las manos, por lo mismo deducimos que S. Pablo ejerce funciones *episcopales* y que, por tanto, Timoteo es un *presbítero (sacerdote, cura, padre)*. El texto trae a cuenta un sin numero de buenas cualidades necesarias par un pastor, pero también para todo cristiano que tiene una misión en el mundo.

El **Evangelio** de hoy es uno que hasta ha inspirado componer una canción: *“si tuviera fe como un granito de mostaza...”*, sin embargo, esta frase que quizá cantamos a la ligera, tiene un sentido más profundo que el de recibir un “milagrillo”. La FE es como una pequeña semilla cuyos frutos tendremos “a largo plazo”, la podemos relacionar con la Evangelización, hoy mismo estamos querido entrar en algunos hogares para llevar la Palabra de Dios a través del V Encuentro y que este hermoso proceso se vaya desarrollando y que al igual que Timoteo (2L), podamos “avivar la gracia de Dios que se nos dio en el bautismo” y cuya máxima expresión es la Eucaristía

October is one of our favorite months of the year because the Church sets aside thirty-one days to focus on the Holy Rosary. October 7th is the day designated to honor **Our Lady of the Rosary**.

This date marks the victory at the Battle of Lepanto for which Saint Pius V gives credit to the Blessed Mother. In 1571, St. Pius V asked all of Europe to rally together by praying the Holy Rosary and begging Mary to intercede for a victory in what appeared to be a hopeless battle. Though the Christians were significantly outnumbered, they miraculously managed to defeat the Turks and save Europe.

All of the glory was given to Our Lady of Victory and attributed to the thousands of people who had joined together in praying the Holy Rosary. St. Pius immediately established a day to commemorate and honor Mary. This later became know as the Feast of the Holy Rosary and we continue to celebrate it in the Church today!

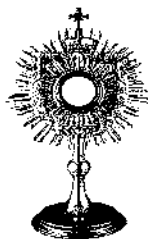
