24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This Sunday's readings reveal to us the merciful heart of God. After the initial anger and disappointment, God changes his attitude towards the people he freed from the slavery of Egypt, and showed them the way of repentance on the request of Moses. The fact that we see God's response to the prayer of Moses, shows us the way we want to be in the time of challenges. We can modify the ways around us by humble persevering prayer and intercession.

The theme of God's mercy runs through all readings today, as Jesus reveals further the heart of God. With all the power of the parables, Jesus manifests how loving and patient God is to all, but in particular to the lost sheep for whom he leaves 99 and goes in search of the lost one. As we rejoice in finding our lost things, so God rejoices in finding repentant sinners.

With the parable of the prodigal son, Jesus opens to us the treasure of the heart of God's love. Like the good Father, God patiently waits for the love of his sons to mature. Each of them takes different road to that maturity; the only person that never changes in loving is the Father, his love is not conditioned by behavior of his sons. God's love is not conditioned by the creation, because his love is infinite, always generous, always total, always selfless, always unconditional. God loves because it is his nature to love, to create, to give, to share. The Father in the parable, is not conditioned by the behavior of any of the sons, but he is infinitely patient to make his sons to learn how to love as He loves. This is the desire of every parent; to have the love of their children returned mutually.

Is it possible for children to love their parents with full maturity of love??? We all can ask ourselves how do we love??? To whose love would you compare your love ??? To the love of the Father ?, or to the love of any of two sons from the parable ??? Or, maybe you need to find another category of love for yourself ??? What category is that ???

The love of the Father is total and self forgetful, merciful and forgiving, compassionate and generous. What is your love in regards to different members of your family ??? Is it this same for everyone ??? How is your love for your parents ??? For your children ??? For your neighbor ??? For your friends ??? For the stranger ??? Is it all the same ?, or all different for everyone ??? Is it anything like the love of the Father in the parable of Jesus ???

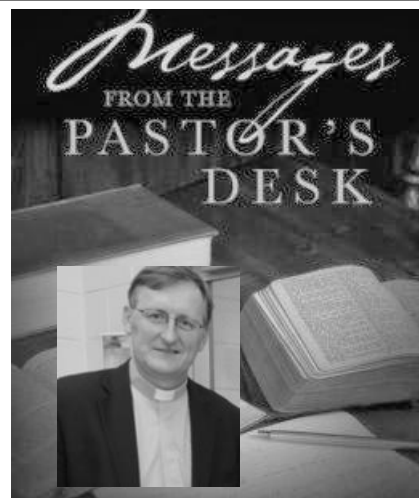
So many questions to ask and to answer, but if we want to get to the height of love of the Father we need to imitate his patient and merciful love. Both of the sons need to grow in their love, so it is probably with each one of us. Who is like God ??? Who loves like God ??? Is this parable about the prodigal son ???, or about the merciful Father ???

You may decide for yourself depending on who's personality appeals to you the most, with whom you may identify the best. Let us explore this parable, let us explore our own life and heart to understand how we perceive and give love.

In the Second Reading, Saint Paul expresses his love of God by recognition of God's love for himself. His recognition of God's love is real and it builds Paul's response to it. See the contrast that Paul presents, and see his great love of God that the contrast creates. Given, that Paul dies the martyrs death, it proves how real was his love for God and for others. It shows how real is his commentary to what God did to him through Christ.
God bless everyone always !!!

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos,

Las lecturas de este Domingo nos revelan el Corazón Misericordioso de Dios. Después de la ira y la decepciones iniciales, Dios cambia su actitud hacia las personas que libero de la esclavitud de Egipto, y les mostro el camino del arrepentimiento a petición de Moisés. El hecho de que veamos la respuesta de Dios a la oración de Moisés , nos muestra como queremos ser en tiempos de desaffios. Podemos modificar los caminos que nos rodean con humilde oración de perseverancia e intercesión .

El tema de la misericordia de Dios recorre hoy todas las lecturas, ya que Jesús revela aun mas el corazón de Dios. Con todo el poder de las parábolas, Jesús manifiesta cuan amoroso y paciente es Dios con todos, pero en particular para las ovejas perdidas por las que deja 99 y va en busca de la perdida. Cuando nos regocijamos en encontrar nuestras cosas perdidas, Dios se regocija en encontrar pecadores arrepentidos.

Con la parábola del hijo prodigo, Jesús nos abre el tesoro del corazón del amor de Dios. Al igual que el buen padre, Dios espera pacientemente a que madure el amor de sus hijos. Cada uno de ellos toma un camino diferente hacia la madurez; La única persona que nunca cambia en el amor es el Padre, su amor no esta condicionado por el comportamiento de sus hijos. El amor de Dios no esta condicionado por la creación , porque su amor es infinito, siempre generoso, siempre total, siempre desinteresado, siempre incondicional. Dios ama porque es su naturaleza amar, crear, dar, compartir.

Asi esta el Padre en la parábola, no esta condicionado por el comportamiento de ninguno de los hijos, pero esta infinitamente paciente para hacer que sus hijos aprendan a amar como El ama. Este es el deseo de cada padre; tener el amor de sus hijos mutuamente reciproco.

¿Es posible que los niños amen a sus padres con plena madurez de amor? ¿Todos podemos preguntarnos como amamos? ¿Con el amor de quien compartirías tu amor? ¿Al amor del Padre? ¿O al amor de cualquiera de los dos hijos de la parábola? ¿o quizás necesites encontrar otra categoría de amor para tí? ¿Qué categoría sería esa?

El amor del Padre es total y olvidadizo, misericordioso y perdona, compasivo y generoso. ¿Cuál es tu amor con respecto a los diferentes miembros de tu familia? ¿Es esto lo mismo para todos? ¿Cómo es tu amor por tus padres? ¿para con tus hijos? ¿Para con tu vecino? ¿Para con tus amigos? ¿Para con una persona desconocida?

¿Es todo esto los mismo? ¿O es diferente para todos?

¿Es algo así como el amor del Padre en la parábola de Jesús?

Tantas preguntas que hacer y responder, pero si queremos llegar a la altura del amor del Padre, debemos imitar su amor paciente y misericordioso. Ambos hijos necesitan crecer en su amor, por lo que probablemente sea con cada uno de nosotros.

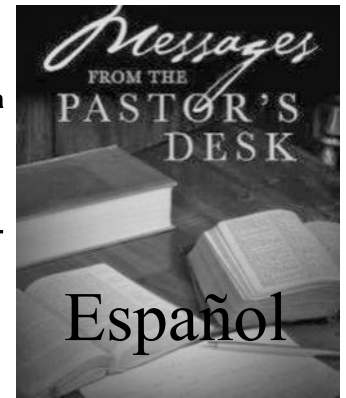
¿Quién es como Dios??? ¿Quién amo como Dios? ¿Es esta parábola sobre el hijo prodigo? ¿O sobre el Padre misericordioso? Puedes decidir por ti mismo dependiendo de la personalidad de quien te atraiga mas, con quien puedes identificarte mejor. Exploremos esta parábola, exploremos nuestra propia vida y corazón para comprender como percibimos y damos amor.

En la segunda lectura, San Pablo expresa su amor a Dios al reconocer el amor de Dios por si mismo. Su reconocimiento del amor de Dios es real y construye la respuesta de Pablo a el. Vea el contraste que presenta Pablo, y vea su gran amor a Dios que crea el contraste. Dado que Pablo muere como un Martil, demuestra cuan real fue su amor por Dios y por los demás . Muestra cuan real es su comentario de lo que Dios le hizo a través de Cristo.

XXIV DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Ex 32:7-11, 13-14 Sal 51 1Tm 1:12-17 Lucas 15:1-32

El perdón de los pecados por la misericordia de Dios, es la temática de las lecturas este domingo. Concretamente, Lucas 15 comprende 3 Parábolas de la Misericordia: *la oveja perdida, la moneda perdida* y *“el hijo perdido”*, en ellas el protagonista es Dios mismo: su amor entendido como “misericordia”, de este capítulo se ha dicho es el “corazón del Evangelio”. En estas parábolas cabemos todos: “hay más alegría en cielo por un pecador que se convierta que por noventa y nueve justos...”, Jesús lo dice en contraposición de los fariseos que se tenían por justos. El tema de la Misericordia fue tratado recientemente por Papa Francisco en su *Carta Apostólica Misericordia et Misera* (2016), podría ser una buena recomendación para su lectura meditada. *El Regreso del Hijo Pródigo* es el tema (también) de un hermoso libro del autor canadiense Henri J.M. Nouwen (†1996) ... transcribo la sinopsis del mismo: *¿Quién no ha escuchado o rezado alguna vez esta escena del evangelio de Lucas? ¿Quién es su vida no ha exigido lo que le corresponde, se ha ido y luego ha tenido que regresar con la cabeza baja; o quién no ha sido cabezota y se niega a entrar en razones como el hijo mayor... o quién, por qué no, ¿no ha sido alguna vez ese padre que acoge, perdona y entiende a quién se acerca a su lado? ... Cuando aun estaba lejos, su padre lo vio y, profundamente conmovido, salió a su encuentro, le abrazó y lo cubrió de besos... “Me acerqué a El regreso del Hijo Prodigio de Rembrandt como si se tratara de mi propia obra: un cuadro que contenía no solo lo esencial de la historia que Dios quería que yo contara a los demás, sino también lo que yo mismo quería contar a los hombres y mujeres de Dios, en él está todo el evangelio. En él está toda mi vida y la de mis amigos. Este cuadro se ha convertido en una misteriosa ventana de la cuál puedo poner un pie en el Reino de Dios.” [H. Nouwen]. Les invito a leer el Libro y contemplar el Cuadro. Buen domingo.*
