**APOSTOLIC CONSTITUTION OF POPE PIUS XII  
MUNIFICENTISSIMUS DEUS  
DEFINING THE DOGMA OF THE ASSUMPTION November 1, 1950**



*1. The most bountiful God, who is almighty, the plan of whose providence rests upon wisdom and love, tempers, in the secret purpose of his own mind, the sorrows of peoples and of individual men by means of joys that he interposes in their lives from time to time, in such a way that, under different conditions and in different ways, all things may work together unto good for those who love him.*

*2. Now, just like the present age, our pontificate is weighed down by ever so many cares, anxieties, and troubles, by reason of very severe calamities that have taken place and by reason of the fact that many have strayed away from truth and virtue. Nevertheless, we are greatly consoled to see that, while the Catholic faith is being professed publicly and vigorously, piety toward the Virgin Mother of God is flourishing and daily growing more fervent, and that almost everywhere on earth it is showing indications of a better and holier life. Thus, while the Blessed Virgin is fulfilling in the most affectionate manner her maternal duties on behalf of those redeemed by the blood of Christ, the minds and the hearts of her children are being vigorously aroused to a more assiduous consideration of her prerogatives.*

*3. Actually God, who from all eternity regards Mary with a most favorable and unique affection, has "when the fullness of time came"(2) put the plan of his providence into effect in such a way that all the privileges and prerogatives he had granted to her in his sovereign generosity were to shine forth in her in a kind of perfect harmony. And, although the Church has always recognized this supreme generosity and the perfect harmony of graces and has daily studied them more and more throughout the course of the centuries, still it is in our own age that the privilege of the bodily Assumption into heaven of Mary, the Virgin Mother of God, has certainly shone forth more clearly.*

*4. That privilege has shone forth in new radiance since our predecessor of immortal memory, Pius IX, solemnly proclaimed the dogma of the loving Mother of God's Immaculate Conception. These two privileges are most closely bound to one another. Christ overcame sin and death by his own death, and one who through Baptism has been born again in a supernatural way has conquered sin and death through the same Christ. Yet, according to the general rule, God does not will to grant to the just the full effect of the victory over death until the end of time has come. And so it is that the bodies of even the just are corrupted after death, and only on the last day will they be joined, each to its own glorious soul.*

*5. Now God has willed that the Blessed Virgin Mary should be exempted from this general rule. She, by an entirely unique privilege, completely overcame sin by her Immaculate Conception, and as a result she was not subject to the law of remaining in the corruption of the grave, and she did not have to wait until the end of time for the redemption of her body.*

*6. Thus, when it was solemnly proclaimed that Mary, the Virgin Mother of God, was from the very beginning free from the taint of original sin, the minds of the faithful were filled with a stronger hope that the day might soon come when the dogma of the Virgin Mary's bodily Assumption into heaven would also be defined by the Church's supreme teaching authority.*

*This Apostolic Constitution continues for another 42 points, where it explains how the Holy Father with the whole Church, came at the conclusion of defining the Dogma of Assumption. I invite you to google it on internet, and read the rest of it, to be able to understand better the whole process and reasoning behind it.*

*What regards the Blessed Mother it is important for us because it regards Christ, and so it regards each one of us and the whole creation.*

*Make it your next spiritual reading.*

## Constitución Apostólica "MUNIFICENTISSIMUS DEUS"



De nuestro Santísimo Señor por la Divina Providencia Papa Pio XII,

En la que se define como Dogma de Fe que la Virgen Maria fue Asunta en Cuerpo y Alma a la Gloria Celeste (1 de noviembre de 1950)

1. El munificentísimo Dios, que todo lo puede y cuyos planes providentes hechos con sabiduría y amor, compensa en sus inescrutables designios, tanto en la vida de los pueblos como en la de los individuos, los dolores y las alegrías para que, por caminos diversos y de diversas maneras, todo coopere al bien de aquellos que le temen (cfr. Rom 8,28).
2. Nuestro Pontificado, del mismo modo que la edad presente, esta oprimido por grandes cuidados, preocupaciones y angustias, por las actuales gravísimas calamidades y la aberración de la verdad y de la virtud; pero no es de gran consuelo ver que, mientras la fe católica se manifiesta en publico cada vez mas activa, se enciende cada día mas la devoción hacia Virgen Madre de Dios y casi en todas parte es estimulo y auspicio de una vida mejor y mas santa, de donde resulta que, mientras la Santísima Virgen cumple onerosísimamente las funciones de madre hacia los redimidos por la sangre de Cristo, la mente y el corazón de los hijos se estimulan a una mas amorosa contemplación de sus privilegios.
3. En efecto, Dios, que desde toda la eternidad mira a la Virgen María con particular y plenísima complacencia, "cuando vino la plenitud de los tiempos" (Gal 4,4) ejecuto los planes de su providencia de tal modo que resplandecen en perfecta armonía los privilegios y las prerrogativas que con suma liberalidad le había concedido. Y si esta suma liberalidad y plena armonía de gracia fue siempre reconocida, y cada vez mejor penetrada por la Iglesia en el curso de los siglos, en nuestro tiempo ha sido puesta a mayor luz el privilegio de la Asunción corporal al cielo de la Virgen Madre de Dios, María.
4. Este privilegio resplandeció con nuevo fulgor desde que nuestro predecesor Pio IX, de inmortal memoria, definió solemnemente el dogma de la Inmaculada Concepción de la augusta Madre de Dios. Esto dos privilegios están, en efecto, estrechamente unidos entre si. Cristo, con su muerte, venció la muerte y el pecado; y sobre el uno y sobre la otra reporta también la victoria en virtud de Cristo todo aquel que ha sido regenerado sobrenaturalmente por el bautismo. Pero por ley general, Dios no quiere conceder a los justos el pleno efecto de esta victoria sobre la muerte, sino cuando haya llegado el fin de los tiempos. Por eso también los cuerpos de los justos se disuelven después de la muerte, y solo en el ultimo día volverá a unirse cada uno con su propia alma gloriosa.
5. Pero de esta ley general quiso Dios que fuera exenta la bienaventurada Virgen María. Ella, por privilegio del todo singular, venció al pecado con su concepción inmaculada; por eso no estuvo sujeta a la ley de permanecer en la corrupción del sepulcro ni tuvo que esperar la redención de su cuerpo hasta el fin del mundo.
6. Por eso, cuando fue solemnemente definido que la Virgen Madre de Dios, María, estaba inmune de la mancha hereditaria de su concepción, los fieles se llenaron de una mas viva esperanza de que cuanto antes fuera definido por el supremo magisterio de la Iglesia el dogma de la Asunción corporal al cielo de María Virgen.

Esta Constitución Apostólica continua por otros 42 puntos mas, donde explica, como el Santo Padre Pio XII con toda la Iglesia, llego a la conclusión de la definición del Dogma de la Asunción. Los invito a todos a buscar en el internet para leer el resto de la Constitución, para asi entender mejor todo el proceso y razonamiento que hubo sobre este tema.

Lo que tiene La Santísima Madre es importante para nosotros porque aparte de eso tiene también tiene a Jesucristo, y asi nos tiene a todos nosotros y a toda la creación. Tomen este tema y háganlo parte de su próxima lectura espiritual.

## **XX DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO**

**Is 56,6-7      Sal 66 Rom 11,13-15.29-32      Mt 15,21-28**

El 15 de agosto hemos celebrado en la Iglesia la Solemnidad de la Asunción. Hacemos la distinción de los vocablos Ascensión y Asunción, el primero refiere a Jesús y el segundo a María. El dogma dice que Dios se preservó en cuerpo y alma a la Virgen para que no “experimentara la corrupción del sepulcro”, si alguno está interesado, ‘googlee’ acerca de esto o busque información en el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica. Al hecho litúrgico unimos otro elemento también eclesial, es la fecha del nacimiento de S. Oscar Romero “de América” como lo designó Don Pedro Casaldáliga (†8/8/20), transcribo un fragmento del poema donde lo hace:

¡Pobre pastor glorioso, abandonado  
Como un hermano herido por tanta muerte hermana,  
tú sabías llorar, solo, en el Huerto.  
Sabías tener miedo, como un hombre en combate.  
¡Pero sabías dar a tu palabra, libre, su timbre de campana!  
Y supiste beber el doble cáliz del Altar y del Pueblo,  
con una sola mano consagrada al servicio.  
América Latina ya te ha puesto en su gloria de Bernini  
en la espuma-aureola de sus mares,  
en el retablo antiguo de los Andes alertos,  
en el dosel airado de todas sus florestas,  
en la canción de todos sus caminos,  
en el calvario nuevo de todas sus prisiones,  
de todas sus trincheras,  
de todos sus altares...

¡En el ara segura del corazón insomne de sus hijos!  
*San Romero de América*, pastor y mártir nuestro:  
¡nadie hará callar tu última homilía!  
Para terminar, felicitar a los ecuatorianos que el 10 de agosto celebraron su independencia. También a los paraguayos (de Asunción) que el 15 de agosto celebraron su Fiesta Patronal.

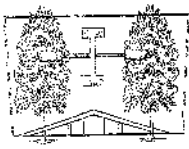

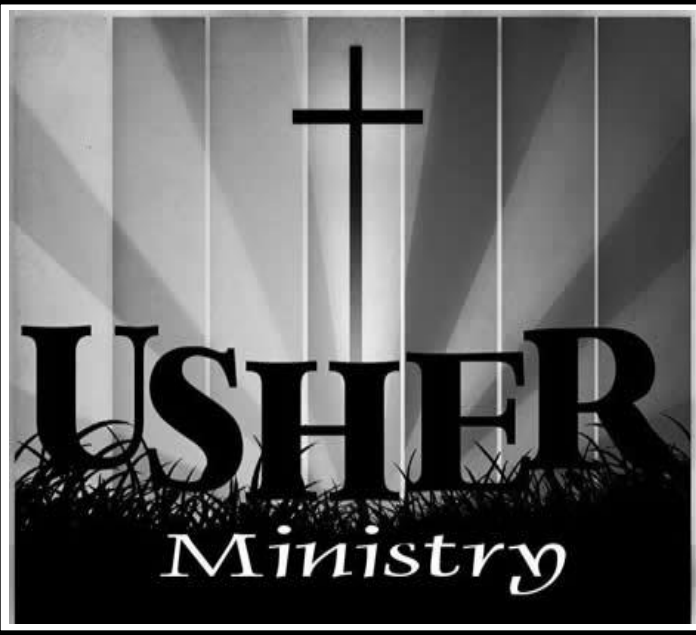

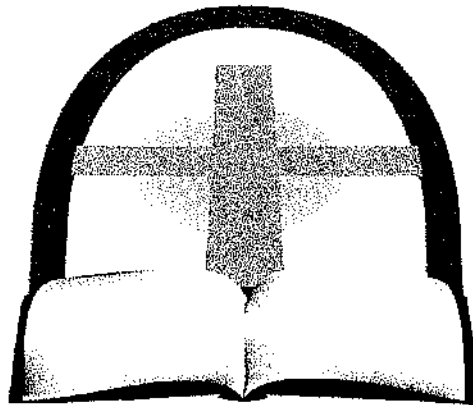

## St. Anne's Ministry of Consolation

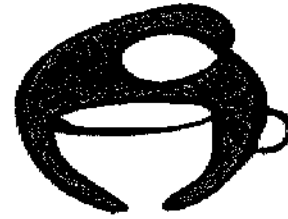
