*Dear Sisters and Brothers,*

*It is amazing to see the growth of the Church right in time of Jesus as He is preparing the Apostles and other disciples for his death and resurrection, as Jesus calls it his “going away to the Father “.*



*It is such a part of the whole plan, that the attention is shifting from the human presence of Jesus in the world, to his spiritual presence in the church through his Spirit, “The Advocate”.*

*It is this step in faith, that puts the weight of responsibility for the “Good News” of salvation on the Apostles and their witness to it in faith. Jesus wants them to trust the presence of the Holy Spirit in the Body of the Church, in his disciples. He makes the step in faith, and he wants the disciples to make their step in faith. The meeting point of both is the Holy Spirit, present in Jesus and present in the disciples - the Church. Jesus puts his life in the hands of his disciples literally. First is his physical life, which he surrendered for the salvation of the world. Second is his mystical life and presence, that he offers through the Holy Spirit and the sacraments, particularly Eucharist.*

*This manifestation of Jesus presence we see in the young church, but we see as well in our church of today. Reading those readings of today’s Mass, referring to those three times: the time when Jesus walked the earth, than the time when the first Christian community was growing, and our time; we realize how parallel those times are through the Holy Spirit acting, first in Jesus, than in the Apostles and disciples, and presently through us.*

*This is why the life of Jesus will always manifest itself in the life of the believers through the Holy Spirit. It’s Jesus’ promise. We see that promise come through every time when we open ourselves to the Spirit of Jesus. This manifestation is smaller or bigger but is obvious to those who believe.*

*This is why it’s so interesting to see the life of the saints, when that manifestation is so obvious to the saints who do not take the credit for themselves, but give it to Jesus doing it through them. Jesus is real ! Jesus is alive ! Christ is Risen ! Truly is Risen !*

*Become a Saint ! Let Christ manifest himself through you ! Let the Holy Spirit take over everything in your life ! Easier to say than to do. We know it’s true, but it is so difficult to put it into practice. It is so difficult to be selfless. It is so difficult to surrender ourselves to God. It is so difficult to put all our trust and faith in God. It is difficult to be a Saint, to be like Christ. Our selfishness, our pride, our sins get in the way.*

*As I write this article, it is still unknown when the public Masses will be celebrated. When the Baptisms, Confession, Confirmation, first Communions, Marriages, Funerals will be celebrated in normal way. Our life is altered by sickness and by the government. Will we be able to overcome the obstacles and difficulties? Will we have faith? Will our faith die or survive the test of time and of trial?*

*Even if the world loses the faith, even if nobody follows the Lord, remember that Christ died for you, and if you were the only person in the world he would still come to save you because He loves you !*

Es una parte tan importante de todo el plan, que la atención esta cambiando de la presencia humana de Jesús en el mundo, a su presencia espiritual en la iglesia a través de su Espíritu, “El Defensor”.

Es este paso en la fe, lo que pone el peso de la responsabilidad de las “Noticias de Dios” de la salvación de los Apóstoles y su testimonio en la fe. Jesús quiere que confíen en la presencia del Espíritu Santo en el Cuerpo de la Iglesia, en sus discípulos. El da el paso en la fe, y quiere que los discípulos den su paso en la fe. El punto de encuentro de ambos es el Espíritu Santo, presente en Jesús y presente en los discípulos, la Iglesia.

Es difícil ser un santo, ser como Cristo. Nuestro egoísmo, nuestro orgullo, nuestros pecados se interponen en el camino.

Mientras escribo este articulo, aun se desconoce cuando se celebraran las Misas publicas. Cuando los Bautizos, Confesiones, Confirmaciones, primeras Comuniones, Matrimonios, Funerales se celebraran de manera normal. Nuestra vida se ve alterada por la enfermedad y por el gobierno. ¿Seremos capaces de superar los obstáculos y dificultades? ¿Tendremos fe? ¿Morirá nuestra fe o sobrevivirá a la prueba del tiempo y del juicio? Incluso si el mundo pierde la fe, incluso si nadie sigue al Señor, recuerde que Cristo murió por usted, y si usted fuera la única persona en el mundo, aun vendría a salvarlo porque ¡El lo ama!

## BISHOP-ELECT ROMERO, M.Id TO BE ORDAINED ON JUNE 29, 2020

ROCKVILLE CENTRE, N.Y. – May 11, 2020 – The Most Reverend John O. Barres, Bishop of Rockville Centre, announced today that Bishop-Elect Luis M. Romero Fernandez, M.Id will be ordained as an auxiliary bishop for the diocese on Monday, June 29, 2020, the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, at 2:00 p.m. in Saint Agnes Cathedral. Bishop Barres will ordain Bishop-Elect Romero. Bishop William Murphy, the Bishop-emeritus of the Diocese of Rockville Centre and Bishop Robert Brennan, the Bishop of Columbus, Ohio, will serve as co-consecrating bishops.

The original Episcopal Ordination date of April 16, 2020, was postponed due to New York State gathering requirements resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. The appointment was publicized on March 3, 2020, by Archbishop Christophe Pierre, Apostolic Nuncio to the United States.

“This is great news for the Diocese,” said Bishop Barres. “I repeat the expression of my deepest thanks to our Holy Father, Pope Francis, for this outstanding appointment to help pastor this diocese. With a humble spirit, Bishop-Elect Romero is both a true intellectual and a zealous shepherd of souls with, as Pope Francis has said, the ‘smell of the sheep.’”

The Episcopal Ordination will air live on Catholic Faith Network (CFN) at 2:00 p.m. EDT. It will be replayed later that evening at 8:00 p.m. Catholic Faith Network can be viewed on Optimum channel 29/137, Verizon FiOS TV channel 296, and Spectrum channel 162/471.

CFN is also available on selected cable and satellite systems and through 24/7 live stream at CFNTV.org. You may also watch CFN on Roku, Apple TV, Amazon Fire TV, Android, or by downloading the CFN iOS mobile app at the app store by searching “Catholic Faith Network” or “CFN”.

Pursuant to New York State Executive Order 202.10, all non-essential gatherings of individuals of any size for any reasons (e.g. worship services, parties, celebrations, or other social events) were canceled or postponed, effective March 23, 2020. As of this media release, this Executive Order remains in effect and, as of this release, the Episcopal Ordination will be virtual, meaning that it will not be open to the public. For the safety of all, only a limited number of individuals deemed integral to the celebration of the Mass will be permitted inside the Cathedral for this Ordination. If a subsequent Executive Order affecting public gatherings is enacted impacting the celebration of this Mass, the Diocese will issue an updated statement.

“Please be assured that when it is deemed safe to gather, the Diocese will schedule a Public Mass commemorating Bishop Romero’s ordination. While the COVID-19 pandemic is challenging all of us, please pray for continued strength and perseverance that we may one day soon be able to gather together as a community of communion in the celebration of Holy Mass,” said Bishop Barres.

## TIEMPO DE PASCUA

A pesar de todos estos inconvenientes, valdrá la pena intentar celebrar tanto como se pueda este tiempo. Y pueden ayudarnos algunos elementos sencillos.

Por ejemplo, la ornamentación la iglesia. Durante todo el tiempo de Pascua la iglesia debería estar bien adornada con luces y flores, y hay que evitar que esta ornamentación decaiga a medida que pasan las semanas. Y, el último día, el domingo de Pentecostés, aumentar el clima festivo celebrando la culminación del tiempo. (Y que el domingo después de Pentecostés se note el cambio, que ve vea que pasamos a un tiempo más discreto).

Igualmente, resaltar los signos litúrgicos propios de este tiempo: el cirio pascual grande y en un lugar visible (y que el resto del año no esté en el presbiterio, para que la diferencia sea clara); la aspersion del agua en el inicio de la misa; el canto frecuente del aleluya (por ejemplo, que todos los domingos la respuesta del salmo responsorial sea le aleluya, y cantar otro aleluya diferente antes del evangelio); mantener los cantos de Pascua todo el tiempo y repetirlos sin miedo: ¡No se ha de caer en la tentación de cantar cantos comunes a partir del cuarto o quinto domingo!).

Finalmente, para la espiritualidad personal, en este tiempo puede ayudar mucho leer cada día, contemplativamente, las lecturas de la misa. La primera lectura va siguiendo todo el libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, un repaso de como la Buena Noticia de Jesús se extiende y da fruto. Y el evangelio es, en la primera semana (la de la Octava de Pascua, que son los días más solemnes) una selección de apariciones de Jesús resucitado; y, el resto del tiempo, fragmentos del evangelio de Juan que nos hacen sentir muy cerca de Jesús.
