## *Pentecost Sunday*

*Dear Sisters and Brothers,*

*Pentecost Sunday is considered to be the birthday of the Church. Why is it so? Why not the Good Friday for example? When we listen to Jesus speak in the Gospel, when we look at his deeds, we realize, that all his life among the people, he was trying to awaken the faith of the disciples in the love of God the Father, and of Jesus Christ.*



*This, Jesus described in last Sunday's Gospel in a beautiful statement: "this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent." Jn 17,3. All Jesus' time among the disciples served this purpose, revealing this truth. But the beauty and power of this revelation was focusing the disciples on learning and absorbing that love. Jesus ultimate goal for the disciples was to make them the Apostles of that love, carrying it to the ends of the world. This passage from the absorbers of that love to carries of it was accomplished in Pentecost.*

*Receiving the fullness of Jesus' Spirit, the disciples realized that they have Jesus' love in them, that it was poured into their hearts without measure to the point of overflowing. At this moment they realized they cannot hold it just for themselves, but they must bring it to others. Finally they realized how overpowering is the knowledge of God's love. As Jesus says: it becomes a spring of life giving waters pouring out of one's heart. That knowledge, that love becomes a motivation behind the whole life of the Apostles, taking away the fear of the Jews, the fear for their own lives and pushes them to become witnesses of Jesus.*

*Being with closed doors and waiting in prayer with Mary the Mother of Jesus was a stage in transformation of individual faith of the disciples into the community faith of Apostles. This transformation is a gift of the Holy Spirit descending upon the community of believers. The Advocate, whom Jesus sends will guide and teach them the whole truth regarding Jesus and regarding the world. As the Holy Spirit descends upon the disciples they begin to speak in tongues and can not contain themselves from proclaiming the Good News to others.*

*Looks like something we need to find in ourselves, to be able to put behind the fear of pandemic and start to correspond to the needs of our own and of the community. We are still unreasonably held to limited numbers that are allowed in our celebrations, but I hope that already for this Sunday the Bishops will be able to renegotiate with the Governor the reasonable number of attending persons according to social distancing, that would allow us to have at least 300 people in the Mass.*

*Hopefully soon the vaccine will be found and we will be able to resume normal life, meanwhile we need to manage to function with those limitations in order to avoid the risk of spreading the virus infection.*

*We urge strongly everyone who is sick to stay home and to go to the doctor to get cured and tested if necessary. We pray for all the sick and we try to assist those in need. We are trying to organize and prepare for the new reality. We need everyone to cooperate. When we learn of the changes in regard to functioning of the church we will be communicating it to you through website and through group leaders.*

*The announcements mentioning the present state of activities are already on website, please check them. Until more numerous opening of the church happens, let's keep persevering in prayer asking for the out-pour of the Holy Spirit upon the whole world with the gift of healing, peace and fraternal love.*

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos,

El Domingo de Pentecostés se considera el cumpleaños de la Iglesia. ¿Por qué es esto entonces? ¿Por qué no el Viernes Santo, por ejemplo? Cuando escuchamos a Jesús hablar en el Evangelio, cuando miramos sus obras, nos damos cuenta de que toda su vida entre la gente, él estaba tratando de despertar la fe de los discípulos en el amor de Dios Padre y de Jesucristo.



Esto, Jesús lo describió en el Evangelio del Domingo pasado en una bella declaración: “esta es la vida eterna: que te conocen a ti, el único Dios verdadero, y a Jesucristo, a quien ha enviado”. Jn 17,3. Todo el tiempo de Jesús entre los discípulos sirvió para este propósito, revelando esta verdad. Pero la belleza y el poder de la revelación estaba centrando a los discípulos en aprender y absorber ese amor.

El objetivo final de Jesús para los discípulos era convertirlos en Apóstoles de ese amor, llevándolo a los confines del mundo. Este pasaje de los absorbentes de ese amor para llevarlo se realizó en Pentecostés. Al recibir la plenitud del Espíritu de Jesús, los discípulos se dieron cuenta de que tenían el amor de Jesús en ellos, que fue derramado en sus corazones sin medida hasta el punto de desbordarse. En este momento se dieron cuenta de que no pueden guardarlo solo para ellos, sino que deben llevarlo a otros. Finalmente se dieron cuenta de cuán abrumador es el conocimiento del amor de Dios. Como dice Jesús: se convierte en un manantial de vida que da agua que brota del corazón. Ese conocimiento, ese amor se convierte en una motivación detrás de toda la vida de los Apóstoles, quitando el miedo a los Judíos, el miedo a sus propias vidas y los empuja a convertirse en testigos de Jesús.

Estar con las puertas cerradas y esperar en oración con María la Madre de Jesús fue una etapa en la transformación de la fe individual de los discípulos en la fe comunitaria de los Apóstoles. Esta transformación es un don del Espíritu Santo que desciende sobre la comunidad de creyentes. El abogado, a quien Jesús envía, los guía y les enseña toda la verdad sobre Jesús y sobre el mundo. A medida que el Espíritu Santo desciende sobre los discípulos, comienzan a hablar en lenguas y no pueden contenerse de proclamar las Buenas Nuevas a los demás.

Parece algo que necesitamos encontrar en nosotros mismos, para poder poner detrás del miedo a la pandemia y comenzar a corresponder a las necesidades de los nuestros y de la comunidad. Todavía estamos sujetos a un número limitado que está permitido en nuestras celebraciones, pero espero que ya para este Domingo los Obispos puedan renegociar con el Gobernador el número razonable de personas que asisten según el distanciamiento social, lo que nos permitiría tener al menos 300 personas en la Misa.

Con suerte, pronto se encontrará la vacuna y podremos reanudar la vida normal, mientras tanto tenemos que lograr funcionar con esas limitaciones para evitar el riesgo de propagación de la infección por el virus. Recomendamos encarecidamente a todas las personas enfermas que se queden en casa y que vayan al médico para curarse y hacerse la prueba si es necesario. Oramos por todos los enfermos y tratamos de ayudar a los necesitados. Estamos tratando de organizarnos y prepararnos para la nueva realidad. Necesitamos que todos cooperen. Cuando nos enteremos de los cambios con respecto al funcionamiento de la Iglesia, se lo comunicaremos a través de la plataforma del website y de los líderes de grupo. Los anuncios que mencionan el estado actual de las actividades ya están en la plataforma del website, por favor verifíquelos.

Una vez que ocurra la apertura más numerosa de la iglesia, sigamos perseverando en oración pidiendo el derramamiento del Espíritu Santo sobre todo el mundo con el don de la curación, la paz y el amor fraterno. Dios les bendiga a todos siempre!!!
