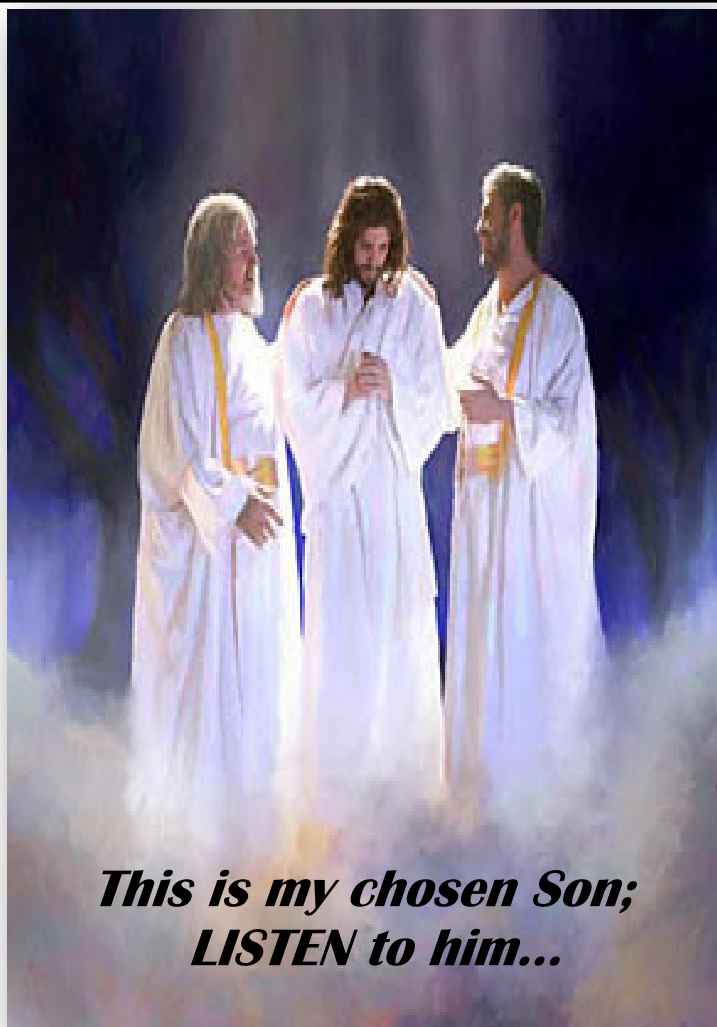

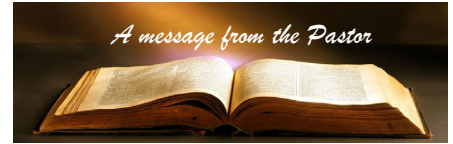

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

On the 2nd Sunday of Lent we read the Gospel of Transfiguration. Jesus is transformed before his chosen disciples to give them the glimpse of glory that he has. That glory is promised to everyone who believes in Jesus. By turning our life to God, we will experience God's glory. This is why we want to empty our hearts of our sins and attachments, and so to be prepared to receive the Lord. This is the purpose of Lent. Jesus wants to invite all of us to the mountain of Transfiguration: to pray, to be with him, to wait with him for the time when he is ready to reveal himself to us. Ultimately, He invites us to heaven to be with him forever in God's glory. Heaven it is a permanent state of glory, but here on earth we experience the glimpses of it, that extend as much as God allows us to experience it. We all would like to experience and receive his glory, so we need to walk the path that leads to it, and this is the Lenten path. This path is leading through the joys and sorrows of life, through death - grave to glory.

In order to make more space for the Lord, we need to repent and believe in the Gospel! We pray to the Lord in the secret of our hearts and the Lord will answer, as he answered the prayers of Abraham. We want to converse with God as Abraham did, and we need to listen to God tell us of his plans for us. If we don't listen, how can God show us his glory, if we are not looking his way? How much more time would you give to Jesus to predispose yourself to see his glory? We get impatient very quickly, we want to accomplish things, but do we know how to wait and listen? We need to open our senses to wonder and amazement, waiting for the One that cannot be measured.

For Jesus, it was 40 days that took him to tire the Devil, and then he was served by the angels. How much time would you give to Jesus, persevering in prayer in order to tire the Devil pulling you away from the Lord, from the truth?

Lord show us your face and don't lose patience with us. We want to see You, we want to see your glory still this Lent. Take away our weaknesses, and give us your strength and perseverance to wait and see the glory of Christ the King, Prophet and Priest. We pray for people of Ukraine, for the end of war and peace of normal life for all people of good will. How long is it going to take for them to tire the Devil with their perseverance and resolve to win this defense of their livelihood? How evil and erroneous thinking can destroy people's lives? How much death and destruction it brings? How important it is to know the truth and be able to honor it in life? God bless the people of Ukraine!!!

God bless everyone always!!!

Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma.



Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos,

El segundo Domingo de Cuaresma leemos el Evangelio de la Transfiguración. Jesús se transforma ante sus discípulos escogidos para darles el destello de gloria que él tiene. Esa gloria está prometida a todo el que cree en Jesús. Al volver nuestra vida a Dios, experimentamos la gloria de Dios. Por eso queremos vaciar nuestro corazón de nuestros pecados y apegos, y así estar preparados para recibir al Señor. Este es el propósito de la Cuaresma. Jesús quiere invitarnos a todos al monte de la Transfiguración: orar, estar con él, esperar con él, el momento en que esté listo para revelarse a nosotros. Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma

El Papa Francisco: la Transfiguración, signo concreto del amor de Dios

"El Señor – afirma el Papa nos hace ver el final de este camino que es la Resurrección, la belleza, cargando con su propia cruz, nos invita en la Transfiguración a seguir el camino de los discípulos, la "perspectiva del sufrimiento cristiano" que no es un "sodomismo", es un "paso necesario pero transitorio" hacia la luz.

“Subamos a la montaña en oración; oración silenciosa, oración del corazón, oración... Siempre buscando al Señor. Permanezcamos unos instantes en el recogimiento, cada día un rato, fijemos nuestra mirada interior en su rostro y dejemos que su luz nos impregne e irradie en nuestra vida”

“Necesitamos, pues, otra mirada, una luz que ilumine en profundidad el misterio de la vida y nos ayude a ir más allá de nuestros propios esquemas y de los criterios de este mundo. También nosotros estamos llamados a subir a la montaña, a contemplar la belleza del Resucitado que enciende destellos de luz en cada fragmento de nuestra vida y nos ayuda a interpretar la historia a partir de la victoria pascual”

Al volver de la montaña, lleno de la luz recibida, cuando se realiza la misión del creyente. En efecto, es en el rostro luminoso de los que rezan, en la llama que se ha encendido en sus corazones, donde se puede irradiar en la vida de los demás, dando testimonio de la verdad y de la fe.

“Encender pequeñas luces en el corazón de la gente; ser pequeñas lámparas del Evangelio que lleven un poco de amor y esperanza: ésta es la misión del cristiano”.

"Transformados por la presencia de Cristo y el ardor de su palabra, seremos – subraya el Papa un signo concreto del amor vivificante de Dios por todos nuestros hermanos, especialmente por los que sufren, por los que se encuentran en la soledad y el abandono, por los enfermos y por la multitud de hombres y mujeres que, en distintas partes del mundo, son humillados por la injusticia, la prepotencia y la violencia".

La Transfiguration de Notre Seigneur Jésus Christ

Pour croire, nous avons besoin de rencontrer des personnes qui vont nous illuminer. Nous avons besoin de vivre des expériences qui nous bouleversent intérieurement, comme Pierre, Jacques et Jean sur la montagne avec Jésus.

Notre foi doit être enracinée dans Jésus, mais notre relation avec lui dépend de notre capacité à croire comme croyait Abraham dans la 1ere lecture. L’histoire de Dieu et d’Abraham commence lorsque Dieu lui ordonne de migrer vers Canaan. Dieu lui fait une promesse : il sera une grande nation. Dieu a fait la promesse de nombreux descendants, autant qu’il y a d’étoiles ! Dès le début de la Bible, nous voyons l’importance d’avoir des enfants. Le premier commandement de Dieu aux humains est « Soyez féconds et multipliez-vous ». (Genèse 1 : 28). Dieu dit à Abraham de lever les yeux, de regarder à l’extérieur de lui-même. Il ne s’agit pas seulement d’une promesse, mais d’un type d’accord où les humains assurent leurs obligations par un geste symbolique. Dieu est représenté par un brasier fumant et une torche allumée qui passe entre les carcasses. Pour comprendre le sens du rituel, une histoire d’alliance entre des groupes d’humains est instructive.

La lecture de l’Épître se rapproche de la conclusion de la lettre de Paul aux Philippiens et son ton est vif, émotif, suppliant et plein d’amour pour celles et ceux à qui il s’adresse. Nous ne savons pas à quels ennemis de la croix Paul faisait référence. Mais, qui qu’ils soient, il est clair sur leur style de vie. Chaque époque et chaque lieu ont leurs ennemis de la croix. Être un ennemi de la croix, c’est vivre sur un chemin qui ne serait pas celui de Jésus. Dans la culture occidentale, le manque d’intérêt, voire l’opposition, envers la foi chrétienne est perceptible dans de nombreux lieux. Paul ne se réfère pas à des péchés individuels en tant que tels, mais à une manière d’être. En d’autres termes, l’état d’esprit de nombreux contemporains des Philippiens et leurs actions sont en guerre contre tout ce que Paul considère comme chrétien. L’antidote de Paul à ce dont ils sont témoins, son souci de leurs âmes et de leurs vies, vient à travers l’appel à l’imiter.

L’extrait d’évangile donne non seulement un aperçu du trio apostolique invité, mais nous invite à partager leur excitation. Luc écrit « Voici que deux hommes », cela détourne notre attention de la tenue et du visage étincelant de Jésus pour inclure une scène où Moïse et Élie apparaissaient également dans la gloire. La transfiguration médiatise la gloire que Pierre, Jacques et Jean avaient peut-être anticipée. Nous nous retrouvons immergés dans des images apocalyptiques : lumière éblouissante, héros de l’histoire d’Israël, gloire, nuage, voix céleste et des mortels qui luttent pour répondre à cette vision. Luc a une façon de déplacer l’attention d’un événement particulier vers l’œuvre et les objectifs plus larges de Dieu. C’est un passage où voir est très important, mais voir a besoin du soutien de la voix de Dieu pour apporter une compréhension même limitée aux trois disciples. Alors que la montagne est un symbole du lieu de rencontre de Dieu, la lumière est un symbole de Dieu. Les voix humaines ne sont pas capables d’articuler ce qui s’est passé. L’apparence transformée de Jésus n’est pas simplement parce qu’il expérimente la gloire de Dieu, mais plutôt parce qu’il est la source même de cette gloire.
