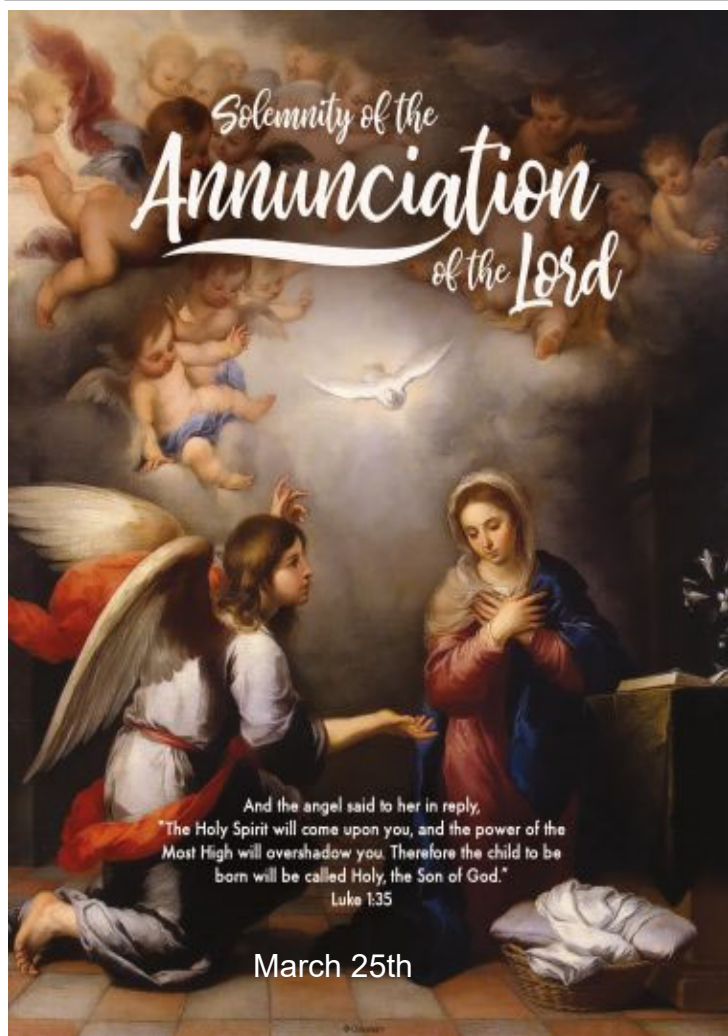

Tercer Domingo de Cuaresma

UNO DE LOS TEMAS RECURRENTES a lo largo de la temporada de Cuaresma es la compasión y la misericordia de nuestro Dios. Es algo que necesitamos recordar constantemente. Nuestro Dios es siempre fiel y consistente. Su amor por nosotros nunca cambia, no importa cómo nos comportemos, no importa cuán graves puedan ser nuestros pecados. Tiene que ser así porque nuestro Dios no solo ama, EL ES AMOR. El amor es de la esencia misma de su ser; no puede no amar.

Su amor es como el sol que da su calor a buenos y malos por igual; como la suave lluvia nutritiva que cae sobre buenos y malos por igual. Y estamos llamados, en la medida de lo posible, a imitarlo en esto: amar siempre e incondicionalmente. Debido a que encontramos eso difícil, es difícil para nosotros pensar en Dios amando de esa manera. Necesitamos deshacernos de la idea de un Dios enojado, decepcionado y vengativo que amenaza con una catástrofe en un mundo perverso, una idea que todavía fomentan algunos que afirman haber tenido revelaciones especiales.

Si el amor de Dios por nosotros es tan constante y no cambia con nuestro comportamiento, no significa eso que podemos hacer lo que queramos. Estamos llamados a vivir en el amor y encontrar nuestra salvación y eso para nosotros será imposible sin la ayuda del mismo Dios. Por lo tanto, pongamos nuestra voluntad diciendo "sí" a la Gracia porque como decía San Agustín: "El Dios que te creó sin tu consentimiento no te salvará sin tu cooperación."

« J’ai vu la misère de mon peuple. J’ai entendu ses cris. Je connais ses souffrances. Je suis descendu pour le délivrer »

Qui est Dieu ? Sur le mont Horeb Dieu a dévoilé son nom à Moïse : « Je suis ». Et depuis Dieu se fait connaître graduellement en tenant compte de nos limites et de nos perceptions. Dès le début, même sous la rigueur de la Loi juive, Dieu se révèle à Moïse comme le miséricordieux.

Les premiers versets de l’extrait d’évangile font référence à deux événements qui étaient probablement familiers au public de Luc. La mention macabre de Pilate mêlant le sang des Galiléens à leurs sacrifices semble faire allusion à un massacre d’un groupe de pèlerins galiléens à Jérusalem. C’est une description sinistre du gouverneur romain avant son apparition dans le procès de Jésus. Ces Galiléens le méritaient-ils ? Pilate était-il l’instrument du jugement divin contre eux ? Quant à la tour de Siloé, elle se serait effondrée sans prévenir en faisant des victimes innocentes. Ces événements soulèvent aujourd’hui les mêmes questions qu’au temps de Jésus. Comment Dieu peut-il permettre ce qui arrive ? Bien que ces événements puissent donner à Jésus l’occasion de défendre Dieu contre toute accusation de mauvaise gestion de l’univers, il ne va pas dans cette voie. Jésus n’a pas dénoncé avec indignation la brutalité romaine, mais a averti ses auditeurs de se convertir. Il est plus préoccupé par l’éternel que par le temporel. Jésus n’était pas venu pour régler des conflits politiques, il était venu inaugurer le Royaume de Dieu.

Aujourd’hui, nous semblons ne voir que les tours qui tombent, que les figiers stériles, que l’escalade de la violence auprès de civils innocents, que les migrants qui meurent en mer, que la violence qu’il y a dans le cœur humain. Dieu n’est pas un créateur qui abandonne son œuvre à elle-même, il n’est pas un magicien qui donne de temps à autre un coup de baguette magique pour nous aider ou un coup sur les doigts pour nous punir. Voulons-nous que la résignation soit le moteur de notre vie ? Voulons-nous que l’accoutumance s’empare de nos vies ? Comment faire pour que notre cœur ne s’anesthésie pas ? Au milieu des événements tumultueux de notre monde, nous avons besoin d’être habités par la présence de Dieu dans nos cœurs. Oublions un instant nos préoccupations, nos angoisses, nos inquiétudes. Écoutons Dieu nous dire : « J’ai vu la misère de mon peuple. J’ai entendu ses cris. Je connais ses souffrances. Je suis descendu pour le délivrer ».

La conversion demandée par Jésus est toujours de multiples et petites décisions pour mettre notre vie en cohérence avec la foi en Jésus. Comme Moïse, nous devons répondre me voici quand il nous appelle à marcher à sa suite vers la terre nouvelle. Nous espérons en Dieu, et Dieu espère en nous. Dieu est patient, il désire que nous portions des fruits et il sait que les fruits ont besoin de temps pour croître et mûrir. Dieu nous appelle avec patience à incarner sa volonté d’amour là où nous sommes, par des petits gestes qui peuvent aller loin. Jésus propose un chemin de tendresse et de fragilité, il nous invite à faire confiance à Dieu, en dépit de nos faiblesses et de nos manques d’amour.

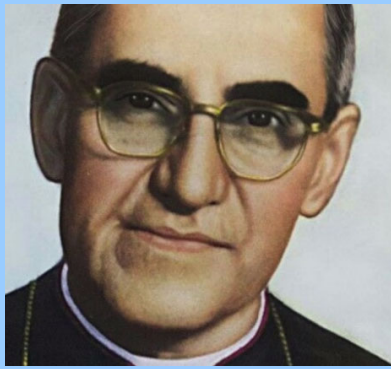
