## Second Sunday of Easter

A Message from our Pastor



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Since the year 2000, the 2nd Sunday of Easter is called Divine Mercy Sunday, when the Holy Father John Paul II canonized St. Faustina, and officially designated that Sunday to be called so. The origin of the feast goes back to year 1935, when it was first celebrated publicly in Vilnius, today it is the country of Lithuania, then it was part of Poland.

The whole devotion is based on revelations made by Jesus to the nun, Sister Faustina Kowalska, who had those revelations starting on February 22, 1931. Jesus asked her to paint the image of himself, as she had seen him. He wanted her to spread his message of mercy and trust. The message is to make us aware of God's Love and Mercy for all. Forgiveness and being forgiven, is the basis for healing to our hearts that are broken by hurts of life and by our sins.

God wants us to know, that his Mercy is greater than all our sins, and he wants to heal all who would come to him in trust. So, God wants us to ask for his mercy, like the good thief on the cross, who was immediately invited to heaven by Jesus. God wants us to be merciful to others, and he wants us to have trust in him. He asks us to abandon ourselves to his merciful love, and so to experience the joy and healing of knowing Jesus' heart, as was the case of the woman caught on adultery. Jesus did not condemn her but showed her his mercy.

Jesus, in his revelations to Faustina, calls her his secretary, as he was encouraging her to write a diary of what she had received from him. Jesus' friendship with Faustina, should teach us how close we can be to him, who is waiting for our response to his love.

There are few aspects of devotion that Jesus proposes to Faustina:

- Honoring the Image of the "Divine Mercy Jesus." It is the image of a risen Jesus, with the hand raised in blessing and with the open heart, from which the red and white rays shine forward, with the words "Jesus I trust in You" written under it.  
The Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday: is the 2nd Sunday of Easter celebrated with public veneration of the image of Divine Mercy, with Confession and Indulgence attached to it for those who participate.
- The Chaplet of Divine Mercy; it is a prayer on the rosary beads, that Jesus thought to St Faustina.
- The Novena of Divine Mercy; it is nine days of prayer with special intentions for every day in preparation for the feast of Divine Mercy.
- The Hour of Mercy; it is the prayer at 3:00pm every day, in commemoration of Jesus death on the cross.
- The whole message of Jesus is recorded by Saint Faustina in "a diary" - the book that she wrote recording all that Jesus wants to teach about his Mercy for all people.

Saint Faustina died of tuberculosis on October 5, 1938 at the age of 33. In her Diary, we find many promises of Jesus to those who will venerate his Image, who will pray the Chaplet, who will promote his Mercy.

John Paul II made Saint Faustina the first saint of the Third Millennium on Divine Mercy Sunday in year 2000, establishing that feast for the whole Church, as a way to meet the challenges facing humanity, and a way to prepare the whole world for the Second Coming of Christ.

Jesus said to Faustina that whoever recites the chaplet, will receive his mercy at the hour of death. Priests should recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even in the case of the most hardened sinner, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from Jesus' infinite mercy and at the hour of their death, Jesus will defend them as his own. The chaplet can be said for dying person to help them in peaceful transition to God.

Through the chaplet Jesus promises that we will obtain everything, if what we ask for is compatible with his will.

## Segundo domingo de Pascua

### Mensaje de Nuestro Pastor



Queridas hermanas y hermanos,

Desde el año 2000, el segundo domingo de Pascua se llama Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, cuando el Santo Padre Juan Pablo II canonizó a Santa Faustina, y designó oficialmente ese domingo para que se llamara así. El origen de la fiesta se remonta al año 1935, cuando se celebró públicamente por primera vez en Vilnius, hoy es el país de Lituania, entonces fue parte de Polonia.

Toda la devoción se basa en las revelaciones que Jesús le hizo a la monja Sor Faustina Kowalska, quien tuvo esas revelaciones a partir del 22 de febrero de 1931. Jesús le pidió que pintara la imagen de sí mismo, tal como ella lo había visto. Quería que ella difundiera su mensaje de misericordia y confianza. El mensaje es para hacernos conscientes del Amor y la Misericordia de Dios para todos. Perdonar y ser perdonado, es la base para sanar nuestros corazones quebrantados por las heridas de la vida y por nuestros pecados.

Dios quiere que sepamos que su Misericordia es mayor que todos nuestros pecados, y quiere sanar a todos los que vendrían a él con confianza. Entonces, Dios quiere que pidamos su misericordia, como el buen ladrón en la cruz, quien fue inmediatamente invitado al cielo por Jesús. Dios quiere que seamos misericordiosos con los demás, y quiere que tengamos confianza en él. Nos pide que nos abandonemos a su amor misericordioso, y así experimentemos la alegría y la sanación de conocer el corazón de Jesús, como fue el caso de la mujer sorprendida en adulterio. Jesús no la condenó sino que le mostró su misericordia. Jesús, en sus revelaciones a Faustina, la llama su secretaria, ya que la animaba a escribir un diario de lo que había recibido de él. La amistad de Jesús con Faustina, debe enseñarnos cuán cerca podemos estar de él, que espera nuestra respuesta a su amor.

Algunos aspectos de la devoción que Jesús propone a Faustina son:

- Honrarla Imagen de “Jesús de la Divina Misericordia”. Es la imagen de Jesús resucitado, con la mano alzada en señal de bendición y el corazón abierto, de donde resplandecen los rayos rojos y blancos, con las palabras “Jesús en Ti confío” escritas debajo.
- La Fiesta del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia es el segundo domingo de Pascua que se celebra con veneración pública de la imagen de la Divina Misericordia, con Confesión e Indulgencia adjunta a ella para los que participan.
- La Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia; es una oración en las cuentas del rosario, que Jesús comunicó a Santa Faustina.
- La Novena de la Divina Misericordia; son nueve días de oración con intenciones especiales para cada día en preparación a la fiesta de la Divina Misericordia.
- La Hora de la Misericordia; es la oración de las 3:00 todos los días, en conmemoración de la muerte de Jesús en la cruz.
- Todo el mensaje de Jesús está registrado por Santa Faustina en “un diario” - el libro que ella escribió registrando todo lo que Jesús quiere enseñar acerca de su Misericordia para todas las personas.

Santa Faustina murió de tuberculosis el 5 de octubre de 1938 a la edad de 33 años. En su Diario encontramos muchas promesas de Jesús a los que venerarán su Imagen, a los que rezarán la Coronilla, a los que promoverán su Misericordia.

Juan Pablo II hizo de Santa Faustina la primera santa del Tercer Milenio el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia del año 2000, instituyendo esa fiesta para toda la Iglesia, como una forma de afrontar los desafíos que enfrenta la humanidad, y de preparar al mundo entero para el Segundo venida de Cristo.

Jesús le dijo a Faustina que quien rece la coronilla, recibirá su misericordia en la hora de la muerte. Los sacerdotes deberían recomendarla a los pecadores como su última esperanza de salvación. Incluso en el caso del pecador más empedernido, si recitara esta coronilla una sola vez, recibiría la gracia de la infinita misericordia de Jesús y en la hora de su muerte, Jesús los defenderá como suyos. La coronilla se puede decir para la persona moribunda para ayudarlos en una transición pacífica hacia Dios.

A través de la coronilla Jesús promete que todo lo obtendremos, si lo que pedimos es compatible con su voluntad.

« Avance ton doigt ici, et vois mes mains ; avance ta main, et mets-la dans mon côté : cesse d’être incrédule, sois croyant. »

Ce jour-là, bien sûr, n’était un jour pas comme les autres. Après la terrible réalité de la crucifixion et de la mise au tombeau de Jésus, ce dimanche avait son lot d’événements étranges et inquiétants. Tôt ce matin-là, Marie-Madeleine était venue, affligée, dire aux disciples que le corps de Jésus avait disparu. Pierre et « l’autre disciple » s’étaient rendus au tombeau et avaient vu par eux-mêmes que c’était vrai. Ils avaient vu les draps qui avaient été enveloppés autour de la tête et du corps de Jésus et qui étaient là, sans cadavre. Puis un peu plus tard dans la journée, Marie-Madeleine était de nouveau allée voir les disciples, cette fois à bout de souffle, et leur avait dit : « J’ai vu le Seigneur ».

« Le soir venu, en ce premier jour de la semaine, alors que les portes du lieu où se trouvaient les disciples étaient verrouillées par crainte des Juifs, Jésus vint, et il était là au milieu d’eux. » Nous avons tendance à oublier que pour les premiers disciples, il y avait de la peur, du doute, de la douleur et de la confusion avant que la compréhension et la joie ne s’installent. Nous pourrions nous attendre à ce que les disciples fêtent. Au lieu de cela, nous les trouvons blottis derrière des portes verrouillées. Ils ont peur des dirigeants responsables du complot contre Jésus. Ils ont probablement peur pour leur propre vie et craignent pour leur avenir. Jésus, cependant, ne sera pas arrêté par des portes verrouillées. Celui qui est lui-même la porte des brebis franchit ces portes verrouillées et apparaît au milieu du troupeau apeuré. Il ne vient pas pour confronter ses disciples avec leurs échecs, mais pour leur accorder la paix, une bénédiction qui dit plus que la tranquillité, une bénédiction qui dit un sens profond du bien-être. Jésus s’identifie en montrant ses mains et son côté.

Thomas était absent et a manqué cette première rencontre du dimanche soir avec Jésus ressuscité. Huit jours plus tard, Thomas répond par une déclaration de confiance et de relation : « Mon Seigneur et mon Dieu ! » Il est important de réaliser que le récit ne concerne pas seulement Thomas. Il traite plutôt des réponses variées à la réalité de la résurrection. En fin de compte, la réponse appropriée à la réalité de Pâques implique d’être transformé par la Parole. Comme Thomas, notre foi en la résurrection repose sur les témoignages des premiers témoins et qui croient sans avoir vu, mais à qui il appartient de manifester à ce monde la puissance de la résurrection. Notre témoignage doit être assez crédible et convaincant pour que les autres adhèrent. C’est toute une mission et une grosse responsabilité qui sont confiées aujourd’hui à tous les chrétiens que nous sommes. Les blessures de Jésus disent qu’il porte en lui toutes les blessures de tous les humiliés du monde. Elles disent aussi qu’aucune blessure, si injuste et si humiliante soit-elle, ne peut nous empêcher de devenir des personnes debout au cœur du monde. Puisque Jésus est ressuscité, cela signifie qu’il est vivant, agissant aujourd’hui en nous et dans nos lieux de vie.
