Message from Our Pastor

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The Gospel of this Sunday is inviting us to participate in the dynamic of divine love, love that we perceive with our human hearts as we do with perceiving the human love. Jesus said: "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him" (John 14:23).

In human love we hold on to the words of love told to us by the one we love, and those words continue to stir in us more love, and it happens over and over again, every time we remember the words of love. How much more do the words of Jesus do for us, that are 100% full of love and life from God. If we give those words of Jesus our total trust, then they will transform us by empowering us from within with the power of divine love.

As experience of human love puts a smile on our face, how much more joy will the experience of divine love bring us. This dynamic of our empowerment coming from internal experience needs to be protected from our experience of troubles, sadness, cultural bombardment of ideas and news. All those negative experiences have power to become dominant in our human heart and mind and so creating in us unhappiness, sadness and depression. We need to monitor what feeds our heart, our soul. It could be the social media that often create our dependence of our need to follow and to control what is there in the web, instead of our need for peace, integrity and our own independence of life, over the life observed out there in virtual world.

This dynamic of giving our heart and soul to something or someone is important to acknowledge, otherwise we may get hacked by those who manage the world of ideas and content of the virtual world. We want to be the moderators of our own life, of our own hearts. We would like to think that we are, but in reality, it may not be so. Here, come as well all political ideas, cultural war that we experience today, gender identity confusion and manipulations, and so on. We want to nourish our heart and soul at the table of the Lord. This is why we need to ponder on his words that carry with them God's love for ever. Every time we read, hear or ponder them, every time we are nourished by God. God's Word has power to bless, to heal, to reconcile, to forgive, to renew, to empower, to bring life, to bring peace, to give love, to win over death.

If Christ and God the Father will come to you and to me, and make their dwelling within us, we will be the most blessed people in the world. Let's be aware of this dynamic so we can collaborate with God in making it happen consciously to its greater effect. This is the secret of spiritual life, this is the secret of life with God, this is the secret of happiness.

Here I would like to share with you a prayer attributed to Fr. Pedro Arrupe SJ (1907-1991), a Jesuit Father who survived nuclear bomb explosion in Japan. It's one of my preferred prayers.

Nothing is more practical than
finding God, than
falling in Love
in a quite absolute, final way.
What you are in love with,
what seizes your imagination, will affect everything.
It will decide
what will get you out of bed in the morning,
what you do with your evenings,
how you spend your weekends,
what you read, whom you know,
what breaks your heart,
and what amazes you with joy and gratitude.
Fall in Love, stay in love,
and it will decide everything.

Queridas hermanas y hermanos,

En el amor humano nos aferramos a las palabras de amor que nos dice aquel a quien amamos, y esas palabras siguen suscitando en nosotros más amor, y sucede una y otra vez, cada vez que recordamos las palabras de amor. Si confiamos totalmente en esas palabras de Jesús, entonces nos transformarán al empoderarnos desde adentro con el poder del amor divino.

Así como la experiencia del amor humano dibuja una sonrisa en nuestro rostro, cuánta más alegría nos traerá la experiencia del amor divino. Esta dinámica de nuestro empoderamiento proveniente de la experiencia interna necesita ser protegida de nuestra experiencia de problemas, tristezas, bombardeo cultural de ideas y noticias. Todas esas experiencias negativas tienen el poder de volverse dominantes en nuestro corazón y mente humanos y así crearnos infelicidad, tristeza y depresión. Necesitamos monitorear lo que alimenta nuestro corazón, nuestra alma. Podrían ser las redes sociales las que a menudo crean nuestra dependencia de nuestra necesidad de seguir y controlar lo que hay en la web, en lugar de nuestra necesidad de paz, integridad y nuestra propia independencia de vida, sobre la vida observada en el mundo virtual. .

Es importante reconocer esta dinámica de dar nuestro corazón y alma a algo o a alguien, de lo contrario, podemos ser pirateados por quienes manejan el mundo de las ideas y el contenido del mundo virtual. Queremos ser moderadores de nuestra propia vida, de nuestro propio corazón. Nos gustaría pensar que lo somos, pero en realidad, puede que no sea así. Aquí entran también todas las ideas políticas, la guerra cultural que vivimos hoy, la confusión y manipulación de la identidad de género, etc. Queremos nutrir nuestro corazón y alma en la mesa del Señor. Por eso es necesario reflexionar sobre sus palabras que llevan consigo el amor de Dios para siempre. Cada vez que las leemos, escuchamos o meditamos, cada vez que somos nutridos por Dios. La Palabra de Dios tiene poder para bendecir, sanar, reconciliar, perdonar, renovar, empoderar, traer vida, traer paz, dar amor, vencer a la muerte.

Si Cristo y Dios Padre vienen a ustedes y a mí, y hacen su morada dentro de nosotros, seremos las personas más benditas del mundo. Seamos conscientes de esta dinámica para que podamos colaborar con Dios en hacer que suceda conscientemente para su mayor efecto. Este es el secreto de la vida espiritual, este es el secreto de la vida con Dios, este es el secreto de la felicidad.

Aquí me gustaría compartir con ustedes una oración atribuida al P. Pedro Arrupe SJ (1907-1991), padre jesuita que sobrevivió a la explosión de una bomba nuclear en Japón. Es una de mis oraciones preferidas.

SEXTO DOMINGO DE PASCUA

De ahí nace una gran serenidad que nos hace ver las cosas tal como son, y no como aparecen. Siguiendo por este camino llegaremos a ser felices.

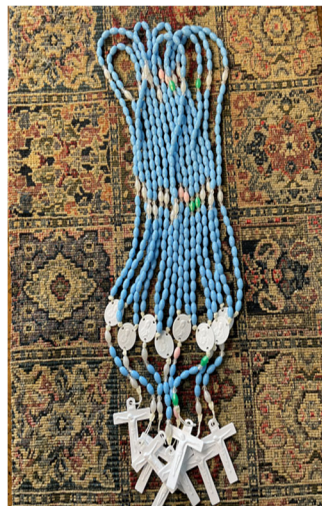

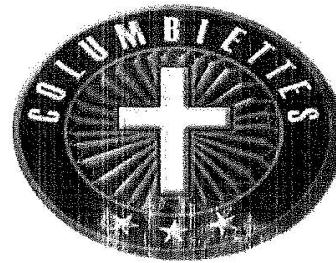
