In the Gospel of today we see the way Jesus was interacting with people in different situations. Even when he was mistreated on his way to Jerusalem, he did not want to let this hostile people be hurt by the Apostles, Jesus just went further to the next village where he was welcomed. He is patient with those who do not know him yet, and he gives them plenty of opportunities to turn to him. Even to those who are resentful of him, he responds not with hostility; he walks away giving them more time to learn about his love and mercy. Jesus is not forcing himself to enter into our life. If we find excuses to avoid him, he goes to the person that is welcoming and caring for his friendship. Let us make sure that we act with Christ in a way that is welcoming, so that He can abide with us.

We see in the Gospel, how personable Jesus is, and how different are the answers he gives to the people that approach him, but they are all life challenging answers. Let us be ready for that challenge from Christ, and he does not seem to be politically correct at all. Jesus does not tell people what they want to hear, but he tells them what is good for them. Do we believe, that Jesus is always giving us what is best for us?

When Elijah anointed Elisha it changed all of his life, it gave him a different purpose and new ways to live it. The portion of Elijah's Spirit made him to be the partner with God, called to do God's work. 13 DOMINGO DE TIEMPO ORDINARIO

El núcleo del tema de la Misa de hoy es: de qué forma damos nuestra respuesta a Jesús que nos llama a unirnos a él. Mientras Jesús se dirige a Jerusalén (y todo lo que eso significará para él), varias personas expresan su deseo de unirse a él. Obviamente, como muchos de nosotros, no entienden del todo exactamente lo que realmente significa "ir a Jerusalén" para Jesús y los que van con él. Podemos mirar con provecho a estas tres personas porque una o más de ellas me representan.

El primero le dice a Jesús con valentía y generosidad: "Te seguiré dondequiera que vayas". Tiene mucho entusiasmo, pero puede que no sea consciente de las realidades a las que se enfrenta.

El segundo hombre también quiere seguir a Jesús. Él hace lo que parece una petición razonable: "Déjame ir y enterrar a mi padre primero". La respuesta de Jesús suena dura: "Dejad que los muertos entierren a sus muertos; vuestro deber es ir y difundir la noticia del reino de Dios". No debemos concluir de esta solicitud que el padre del hombre ya estaba muerto. Es posible que haya estado diciendo que seguiría a Jesús solo después de haber cumplido con sus deberes filiales hacia su padre.

El tercer hombre dice que quiere seguir a Jesús, pero quiere despedirse primero de su familia y amigos. No es diferente al caso anterior. Quiero hacer todos mis propios arreglos primero. Quiero divertirme un poco en la vida. Pero para ser un discípulo de Jesús, no puedo dudar. El llamado es AHORA, hoy y la respuesta también debe ser ahora mismo.

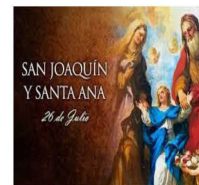
