Message from Our Pastor

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

In the Gospel of last Sunday, Jesus made it simple for us how to obtain eternal life. He told us that, if we love God and our neighbor as ourselves, then we will get to heaven. He explained, that we have to be good to others as the Good Samaritan was to the stranger and the person in need.

Today's Gospel teaches us how to love and serve Jesus, how to care about his desire to communicate his love to us, and how to spend our time with him so we can receive his love. We need time in order to tell God what we carry in our hearts, and we need to listen, to be able to perceive what God has to tell us in return. If we want to know the love of God, we need to spend time with God.

Martha and Mary were already friends with Jesus, yet their attitude was quite different. Martha worried about all things too much, trying to serve Jesus with all her human perfection, to the point of accusing Mary and Jesus about not caring, what was totally false.

The activism of Martha was overwhelming, and was motivated by her perfectionism and not by her love. Jesus and Mary found a way to communicate love mutually in the encounter of adoration, as Mary sat at the feet of Jesus. That attitude of adoration was strange to Martha, who could not find meaning in spending peaceful time with Jesus. In fact, the prayer of adoration is not easy. We need to learn how to spend time with God.

Are you like Martha? Always doing something without stopping and taking time for God? Are you thinking that all the world depends on you and on your hard work?

It is true, we need people committed to serving in our church, in parish, at home, but it has to be done in the right attitude. If your service makes you angry and brings you anxiety, there is something wrong in your attitude, and you should talk about it with God or another spiritual person to see the reasons for your unhappiness. Service always should bring us joy and satisfaction.

Surely, we have plenty to learn from Mary. We want to foster this mutual relationship of love with Jesus, as we would want to do in regard to a person, whom we discover, loves us and we love them. It is nothing more and nothing less, it is true relationship between God and us. This is where love is found, in the encounter of two hearts that care about each other. We want to find those moments of silence and listening of Jesus, be it in the church, or be it in private moments. We need more of those personal moments of quiet and adoration to foster this communication of love with God.

Do you need more of God's love? Then you need to do like Mary, sit at the feet of Jesus, and give him the chance to communicate his love to you, and be a happy person, aware of the greatness of Jesus' love for you.

Necesitamos tiempo para decirle a Dios lo que llevamos en el corazón, y necesitamos escuchar, para poder percibir lo que Dios tiene que decirnos a cambio. Si queremos conocer el amor de Dios, necesitamos pasar tiempo con Dios.

Marta y Maria eran amigas de Jesus, pero su actitud era bastante diferente. Marta se preocupaba demasiado por todas las cosas, tratando de servir a Jesus con toda su perfección humana, hasta el punto de acusar a Maria y a Jesus de no preocuparse, lo que era totalmente falso.

El activismo de Marta fue abrumador, y estaba motivado por su perfeccionismo y no por su amor. Jesus y Maria encontraron una manera de comunicarse mutuamente el amor en el encuentro de adoración, cuando Maria se sentó a los pies de Jesus. Esa actitud de adoración era extraña para Marta, que no encontraba sentido en pasar un tiempo tranquilo con Jesus. De hecho, la oración o adoración no es fácil. Necesitamos aprender a pasar tiempo con Dios.

¿Eres como Maria? ¿Siempre haciendo algo sin parar y tomando tiempo para Dios? ¿Estás pensando que todo el mundo depende de ti y de tu arduo trabajo?

Es cierto, necesitamos personas comprometidas a servir en nuestra iglesia, en la parroquia, en casa, pero hay que hacerlo con la actitud correcta. Si tu servicio te hace enojar y te trae ansiedad, hay algo malo en tu actitud, y debes hablarlo con Dios o con otra persona espiritual para ver las razones de tu infelicidad. El servicio siempre debe traernos alegría y satisfacción.

Seguramente tenemos mucho que aprender de Mary. Queremos fomentar esta relación reciproca de amor con Jesus, como querríamos hacer con las personas a las que descubrimos que nos aman y nosotros las amamos. Es nada más y nada menos, es la verdadera relación entre Dios y nosotros. Es ahí donde se encuentra el amor, en el encuentro de dos corazones que se quieren. Queremos encontrar esos momentos de silencio y escucha de Jesus, sea en la iglesia, sea en momento privados. Necesitamos más de esos momentos personales de quietud y adoración. Para fomentar esta comunicación de amor con Dios.

¿Necesita más del amor de Dios? Entonces necesitas hacer como Maria, sentarte a los pies de Jesus, y darle la oportunidad de comunicarte su amor, y ser una persona feliz, consciente de la grandeza del amor de Jesus por ti.

16 Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario

Jesús estaba cansado del viaje y llega a una familia de Betania. Aprovechará la ocasión para hacernos saber qué es “lo más importante”.

En la actitud de estas dos hermanas se acostumbra a ver reflejadas dos maneras de vivir la vocación cristiana: la vida activa y la vida contemplativa. María, «sentada a los pies del Señor»; Marta, atareada por muchas cosas y ocupaciones, siempre sirviendo y contenta, pero cansada. —«Calma», le dice Jesús, «es importante lo que haces, pero es necesario que descanses, y más importante aún, que descanses estando conmigo, mirándome y escuchándome». Dos modelos de vida cristiana que hemos de coordinar y de integrar: vivir tanto la vida de Marta como la de María. Hemos de estar atentos a la Palabra del Señor, y vigilantes, ya que el ruido y el tráfico del día a día —frecuentemente— esconde la presencia de Dios. Porque nuestra vida cristiana solamente se mantiene firme y crece si permanecemos unidos a la verdadera vida, de donde nos viene la vida, el amor, las ganas de continuar adelante... y de no mirar atrás.

Jesús nos recuerda que lo más importante no es lo que podamos hacer, sino la Palabra de Dios que ilumina nuestras vidas, y, así por el Espíritu Santo nuestras obras quedan impregnadas de su amor.

Descansar en el Señor solamente es posible si gozamos de su presencia real ante la Eucaristía. ¡Oración ante el sagrario!: es el tesoro más grande que tenemos los cristianos. Recordemos el título de la última encíclica de san Juan Pablo II: La Iglesia vive de la Eucaristía. El Señor tiene muchas cosas que decirnos, más de lo que nos imaginamos. Busquemos, pues, momentos de silencio y de paz para encontrar a Jesús y, en Él, reencontrarnos a nosotros mismos. Jesucristo nos invita hoy a hacer una opción: escoger «lo mejor».

Réflexion sur l'Évangile du 16ème Dimanche Ordinaire, C
« Ta parole Seigneur, est lumière pour mes pas »

Le texte que nous avons médité la semaine dernière (la parabole du Bon Samaritain) et celui d'aujourd'hui (la visite de Jésus à Marthe et Marie) sont complémentaires. Ils présentent deux aspects importants d'une même réalité chrétienne : l'action en faveur de ceux qui sont dans le besoin et l'écoute de la parole de Dieu.

L'action est le fruit de notre engagement envers les autres, mais le fondement de cette action est l'écoute de la parole de Dieu.

Luc, dans son Évangile nous permet de mettre en pratique la parabole du Bon Samaritain avec la visite de Jésus à Marthe et à Marie pour souligner l'importance de « s'asseoir aux pieds de Jésus pour écouter sa parole ».

Frères et sœurs bien- Aimé , Jésus semble critiquer Marthe pour le bon travail qu'elle fait en préparant le repas. En réalité, elle reçoit le Seigneur, comme Abraham l'a fait dans la première lecture. Le Christ ne lui reproche pas de vouloir accueillir ses invités, mais d'être trop inquiet, de trop s'inquiéter.

Dans le livre de l'Apocalypse, saint Jean utilise une belle image pour décrire la vie chrétienne : « Voici, je suis à la porte et je frappe. Si quelqu'un m'ouvre, je dînerai avec lui et je ferai ma maison chez lui. (Apocalypse 3:20).

La parole de Dieu clarifie nos priorités et change notre attitude envers les autres et envers Dieu. Il donne un sens aux événements quotidiens, y compris les grandes joies ainsi que la souffrance, la maladie et la mort elle-même.

Aujourd'hui, nous sommes invités à réévaluer l'aspect contemplatif de notre vie chrétienne, à redonner la primauté à la rencontre avec Dieu dans la prière et la méditation, à faire de la Parole de Dieu une nourriture quotidienne.

Jésus nous avertit, dans la parabole du semeur, que les « soucis de la vie » peuvent facilement étouffer la postérité de la Parole de Dieu (Luc 8:14) et il répétera avec force qu'il ne faut pas se laisser « alourdir le cœur par les soucis de la vie » (Luc 21:34). Celui qui écoute sa parole est comme quelqu'un qui construit sa maison sur le rocher.

« Ta parole, Seigneur, est lumière pour mes pas. » C'est ce que l'Évangile d'aujourd'hui nous enseigne.




