The Story of Anne

Message from Our Pastor

Anne and Joaquín do not appear in the Bible. What we know about them, as well as about the parents of John the Baptist (Zacharias and Elizabeth, the latter daughter of Ismeria, sister of Anne, comes to us from the later hagiographical tradition and from the apocryphal gospels.

Legend has it that both were members of the Jewish priestly class, although there are different versions that attribute to Ana some degree of illustrious kinship with other figures in religious history, such as Joseph of Arimathea, the man who was in charge of the recovery and burial of the body of Christ, who would have been his uncle.

The truth is that although both were noble and virtuous, Anne and Joaquín could not have children, just like Zacharias and Elizabeth.

The shame of this fault led Joaquín to retire to the desert, among the shepherds, but precisely at that moment an angel appeared to both him and his wife Anne, announcing the imminent birth of a child. Under the instructions of the angel, the two met at the Golden Gate of Jerusalem, and here, thanks to a single kiss, their child would have been conceived.

When, as the angel had promised, a girl was born who would have changed the history of the world forever, Anne and Joaquín named her María, which in Hebrew means 'beloved by the Lord'.

This is how the Virgin Mary, the future mother of Jesus Christ, was born. She was born without sin, preserved immune to it from conception, according to the dogma of the Immaculate Conception.

In most countries with a Christian culture, grandparents are remembered and celebrated on July 26. This is because on this day St. Anne, the mother of Mary, is remembered, who in addition to being the protector of mothers and pregnant women, together with her husband St. Joaquín, is also the patron saint of grandparents. It is not difficult to imagine the reason for this patronage: in fact, St. Anne and St. Joaquín are also the grandparents of Jesus.

Children should be encouraged to spend as much time as possible with their grandparents, not only because they are kind and loving, but also because of the immense wealth of experience and knowledge they can pass on through their stories. We would not be who we are without those who preceded us, and grandparents are the very symbol of a distant but extraordinarily close historical heritage. They are our link with the past, they are the very root of our present, and their example and their love can give us hope in the future, for when we will be grandparents in our turn.

The name Anne derives from the Hebrew Channah, or Hannahe, which means 'grace', 'graceful', 'full of grace'. Although the name of Mary's mother is not mentioned in the Bible, other women bearing this name are mentioned in the Sacred Texts, such as the mother of the prophet Samuel and the old prophetess who recognized the child Jesus as the Messiah when he was presented in the Jerusalem Temple.

Historia de Santa Ana

Mensaje de Nuestro Pastor

Ana y Joaquín no aparecen en la Biblia. Lo que sabemos de ellos, así como de los padres de Juan el Bautista, es decir Zacarías e Isabel, esta última hija de Ismeria, hermana de Ana, nos viene de la tradición hagiográfica posterior y de los evangelios apócrifos.

Cuenta la leyenda que ambos eran miembros de la clase sacerdotal judía, aunque existen diferentes versiones que atribuyen a Ana algún grado de parentesco ilustre con otras figuras de la historia religiosa, como José de Arimatea, el hombre que se encargó de la recuperación y entierro del cuerpo de Cristo, quien habría sido su tío.

Lo cierto es que aunque ambos fueron nobles y virtuosos, Ana y Joaquín no lograban tener hijos, al igual que Zacarías e Isabel.

La vergüenza de esta falta llevó a Joaquín a retirarse al desierto, entre los pastores, pero precisamente en ese momento se le apareció un ángel tanto a él como a su esposa Ana, anunciándoles el inminente nacimiento de un niño. Bajo las instrucciones del ángel, los dos se encontraron en la Puerta Dorada de Jerusalén, y aquí, gracias a un solo beso, habría sido concebida su criatura.

Cuando, como había prometido el ángel, nació una niña que habría cambiado la historia del mundo para siempre, Ana y Joaquín la llamaron María, que en hebreo significa 'amada por el Señor'.

Así es como nació la Virgen María, futura madre de Jesucristo. Ella nació sin pecado, preservada inmune a él desde la concepción, según el dogma de la Inmaculada Concepción.

En la mayoría los países de cultura cristiana los abuelos son recordados y celebrados el 26 de julio. Esto se debe a que en este día se recuerda a Santa Ana, la madre de María, quien además de ser la protectora de las madres y las mujeres embarazadas, junto con su esposo San Joaquín es también la patrona de los abuelos. No es difícil imaginar el motivo de este patronato: de hecho, Santa Ana y San Joaquín son también los abuelos de Jesús.

Los niños deben ser alentados a pasar el mayor tiempo posible con sus abuelos, no solamente porque son amables y cariñosos, sino también por la inmensa riqueza de experiencia y conocimiento que pueden transmitirles con sus historias. No seríamos quienes somos sin los que nos precedieron, y los abuelos son el símbolo mismo de una herencia histórica lejana pero extraordinariamente cercana. Son nuestro vínculo con el pasado, son la raíz misma de nuestro presente, y su ejemplo y su amor pueden infundirnos esperanza en el futuro, para cuando seremos abuelos a nuestra vez.

El nombre Ana deriva del hebreo Channah, o Hannahe, que significa 'gracia', 'graciosa', 'llena de gracia'. Aunque el nombre de la madre de María no se menciona en la Biblia, en los Textos Sagrados se mencionan otras mujeres que llevaban este nombre, como la madre del profeta Samuel y la anciana profetisa que reconoció al niño Jesús como el Mesías cuando fue presentado en el Templo de Jerusalén.

Reflexionemos brevemente sobre el contenido de la oración que Jesús nos enseñó:

Padre: Nos dirigimos a Dios en forma personal, Padre. Y san Pablo nos recuerda que este título debe entenderse en el nivel más cálido e íntimo. Él nos dice que llamemos a Dios Abba, Ah Ba, "Papá" - títulos usados cariñosamente por niños pequeños en todo el mundo. Y así nosotros también debemos dirigirnos a él. Pero el hecho de que cada uno de nosotros lo llame "Padre" implica otra implicación, a saber, que todos somos sus hijos y, por lo tanto, también hermanos y hermanas unos de otros, miembros de una gran familia.

Que tu nombre sea santificado: Su santidad de ninguna manera depende de nosotros. Lo que estamos pidiendo más bien es que la santidad de Dios sea reconocida por nosotros no sólo por nuestras palabras sino por nuestra forma de vivir. En otras palabras, es una oración para que la santidad de Dios se refleje en nuestra propia vida y en la vida de cada persona.

Venga tu reino: al decir esta invocación, no solo estamos pidiendo la ayuda de Dios, sino que nos recordamos nuestra responsabilidad de trabajar con Dios para hacer realidad el Reino.

Danos cada día nuestro pan diario: al orar de esta manera expresamos nuestra confianza en un Dios bondadoso. Es también la aceptación de un desafío por parte de todos nosotros para ver que cada persona tenga sus necesidades de hoy satisfechas. No hay necesidad de preocuparse y angustiarse por el futuro.

Perdona nuestros pecados, porque nosotros mismos perdonamos a cada uno de los que nos deben. Oramos para que Dios nos perdone todo lo que hemos hecho mal, PORQUE ya hemos perdonado a todos aquellos que sentimos que nos han hecho mal.

No nos pongas a prueba: Finalmente, oramos por protección de futuras pruebas que puedan abrumarnos. Pruebas en las que podríamos fallar y traicionar nuestro seguimiento de él.

Ce dimanche nous offre une excellente occasion pour réfléchir sur la prière chrétienne. Dans la première lecture, Abraham, implore le Seigneur pour Sodome et Gomorrhe, démontrant une confiance totale en Dieu. Et Jésus propose ensuite, dans l'évangile, la prière par excellence, modèle de toutes les prières: le Notre Père.

Aujourd'hui st Luc nous présente Jésus comme un homme de prière.

Et ses disciples, le voyant souvent se retirer pour prier, lui demandent de leur apprendre à prier.

Pourtant, Jésus n'a pas enseigné à ses apôtres une prière, mais une manière d'entrer en contact avec Dieu. Chaque phrase du Notre Père pourrait faire jaillir une prière.

Frères et Sœurs Bien-Aimé, Le Christ nous invite donc à prier d'abord pour que le Royaume de Dieu arrive, pour que ces injustices soient éliminées et que la paix et l'amour règne parmi nous.

Après avoir prié pour le règne de Dieu, le Notre Père nous invite à prier pour nous-mêmes.

Il ne s'agit pas d'une prière privée, mais d'une prière communautaire : «donne-nous notre pain de tous les jours... remets-nous nos offenses, comme nous les remettons... libère-nous du mal...» Nous prions toujours au pluriel, au nom de la communauté.

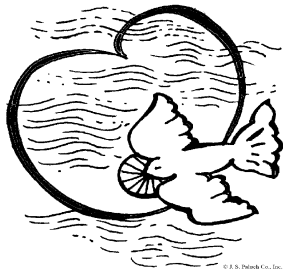

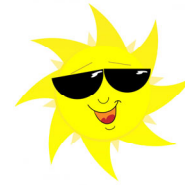
