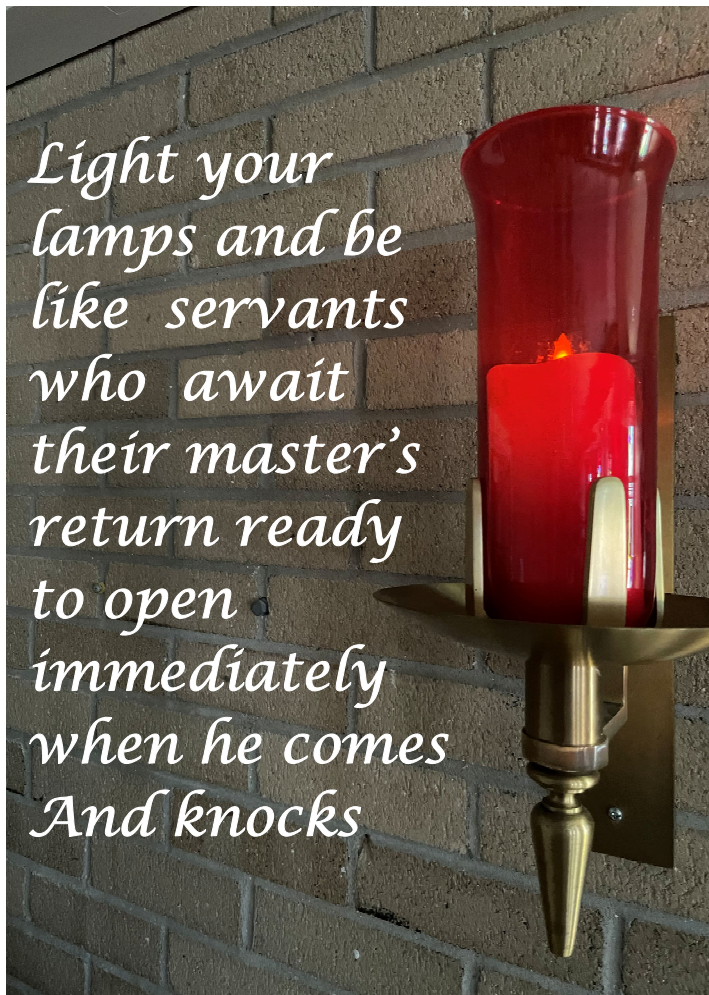

19 Domingo Tiempo Ordinario

El pasaje del Evangelio de hoy nos dice que estemos listos, que estemos listos cuando venga el Maestro. A pesar de todos nuestros cuidados y precauciones, no hay absolutamente ninguna manera de que podamos saber cuándo o cómo el Maestro vendrá a llamarnos a sí mismo.

Actualmente las personas son evaluadas por el dinero que tienen, por la clase y categoría social a la que pertenecen y, por su prestigio, por su poder. ¡Pero todo eso, a los ojos de Dios, no vale absolutamente nada! Supongamos que te enteras hoy de que tienes una enfermedad incurable, y te dan solo un mes de vida..., ¿qué harás con todo tu dinero? ¿De qué te servirá todo tu poder, tu prestigio y tu clase social? No servirán para nada. Entonces, te das cuenta de que todos estos activos tan valiosos aquí, finalmente cuando llegue el momento para ti, no valdrán nada. Y, si luego miras hacia atrás, a tu alrededor, ves que todos esos valores se desmoronan: los verdaderos tesoros están en los valores que permanecen, la presencia de Dios en nuestras vidas, en las personas que nos rodean, en su cuidado amoroso, en esa mirada pacífica de comprensión; todos se convierten en los verdaderos valores, los verdaderos tesoros que nosotros—detrás de los dioses de este mundo—fácilmente subestimamos.

¡Pidamos la inteligencia evangélica para discernir cuáles son los verdaderos valores! Que los tesoros de nuestro corazón sean, en lugar de estos dioses del mundo, el amor, la paz verdadera, la sabiduría y todos los dones que recibimos y cultivamos por la gracia de Dios.

Les premiers mots de l'Évangile d'aujourd'hui sont un appel à bannir la peur: « Soyez sans crainte... parce que le Père a trouvé bon de vous donner le Royaume. »

Luc a délibérément placé cette parole de Jésus dans un temps de peur, au cours de cette longue "montée à Jérusalem". Jésus se dirige vers sa condamnation à mort (Lc 9,51), et ses disciples effrayés le suivent avec appréhension. Selon toutes apparences, c'est l'échec définitif qui approche: l'échec d'un projet, l'échec d'une vie.

Chacune de nos vies a un peu la saveur de la défaite... occasion manquée, désillusion dans nos projets de vie, maladie débilitante, incapacité de mettre fin à une habitude qui porte atteinte à notre santé (cigarette, drogue, alcool), manque de temps pour réaliser nos rêves, échec dans la carrière, chicanes de famille, vieillesse, souffrances, etc.



Dans la vie quotidienne, les gens vivent dans la peur : peur de la solitude, du terrorisme, des pertes d'emplois, de la violence, des maladies.

Plusieurs gouvernements utilisent la peur pour conserver le pouvoir. Ils font tout pour promouvoir la peur et ensuite ils promettent de nous protéger contre ces dangers mortels. Il s'agit souvent de manipulation orchestrée pour nous faire accepter toutes sortes de mesures très couteuses qui profitent à une riche minorité.

Dieu n'est pas de ceux qui ...utilisez le mieux possible le temps qui vous est donné. utilisent la peur pour nous amener à la soumission. Bien au contraire. Il nous invite à l'espérance et l'action : «Relevez la tête, soyez sans crainte, gardez vos lampes allumées».

Notre vie a un sens, même si, pour une raison ou pour une autre, elle a une apparence d'échec, même si nous sommes trahis par nos amis, démolis par nos adversaires, incompris par notre famille, terrassés par la maladie.

Dieu nous invite à aller de l'avant, comme Abraham qui, à un âge avancé, a quitté son pays, sans trop savoir où il allait. Comme les Hébreux qui ont fui l'esclavage d'Égypte pour se diriger vers la terre promise.

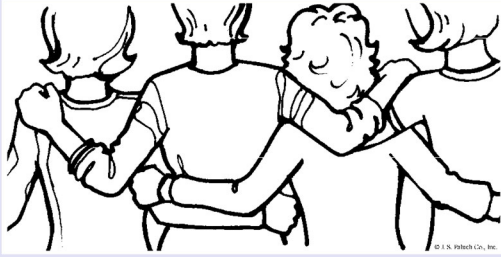


IMPORTANT REMINDER

OUTREACH

The generosity of the parishioners of St. Anne Parish allows us to reach out to people in our Brentwood/Bay Shore neighborhood who struggle each day to make ends meet. Thank you to all who generously donate to our food pantry. During June 2022, we were happy to assist 169 families, 46 seniors, 230 adults and 192 children. We also helped 8 new families.

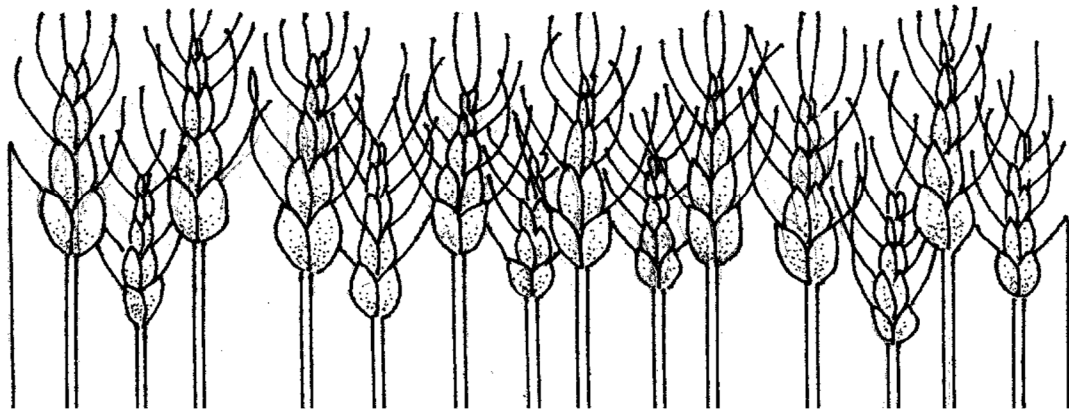

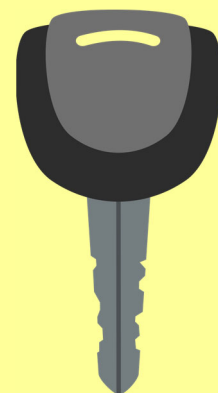
