**Message from
Our Pastor**

20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This Monday we celebrate the feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Mother. It considers of the “falling asleep” of the Blessed Mother, and secondly, of her body and soul being taken to heaven. The dogma of Assumption was promulgated by Pope Pius XII in 1950. It states: "It is a dogma revealed by God that the Immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever Virgin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven." That belief was in the Church for centuries, as we see no place that would claim to be the burial place of Blessed Mother. The Blessed Mother is already in heaven with her body and soul, the reality that we will experience after the resurrection on the last day, at the beginning of new times after the last judgment.

In the Eastern Church, “the dormition” or “falling asleep” of Mary began to be commemorated in the 6th century. The observance gradually spread to the West, where it became known as the feast of the Assumption. By the 13th century most Catholic theologians accepted the belief of the Assumption. However, this doctrine did not become an article of faith until recent times, when Pope Pius XII declared it a dogma of the Catholic faith: “The Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory” (Munificentissimus Deus, Pope Pius XII, 1950).

The Assumption is not explicitly taught in Scripture. In the biblical narrative, Mary is last mentioned in Acts 1 where she is found praying with the other disciples before Pentecost. After that, the Bible is silent about her life and death. Various scriptures demonstrate the possibility of this doctrine, and that it is “fitting” that Mary should be assumed to heaven. The first biblical reference to the Blessed Mother is in Genesis 3:15: "And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel." In Luke 1:28 we read: "And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with thee, blessed art thou among women." Then in Revelation 12:1 it says: "And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars”.

The bodily assumption is said to be the natural effect of being “highly favored” or “full of grace”. A Catholic author writes: “Mary’s coronation implies her preceding bodily assumption.” We believe that Our Lady and our Mother, have already left the earth and reached the kingdom, where, as Queen, she is enthroned and intercedes for us all. The Scripture explicitly speaks of Jesus, who having lived a sinless life, died for sinners, was buried and raised from the death, and after forty days he ascended into heaven, where he is reigning in glory. We believe that the Queen of Heaven is there with him already in glory.

Happy feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary!!!

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos,

Este lunes celebramos la fiesta de la Asunción de la Santísima Madre. Considerada como “dormirse” de la Santísima Madre, y en segundo lugar: su cuerpo y su alma son llevados al cielo, El dogma de la Asunción fue promulgado por el Papa Pio XII en 1950. Dice: “Es un dogma revelado por Dios que la Inmaculada Madre de Dios, Maria siempre Virgen, cuando termino el curso de su vida terrena, fue tomada de cuerpo y alma a la gloria del cielo”. Esa creencia estuvo en la Iglesia durante siglos, ya que no vemos ningún lugar que pretenda ser el lugar de sepultura de la Santísima Madre. La Santísima Madre ya está en el cielo con su cuerpo y alma, realidad que viviremos después de la resurrección en el último día, al comienzo de los nuevos tiempos después del juicio final.

En la Iglesia oriental, “la dormición” o “dormirse” de Maria comenzó a conmemorarse en el siglo VI. La celebración se extendió gradualmente a Occidente, donde se conoció como la fiesta de la Asunción. En el siglo XIII, la mayoría de los teólogos católicos aceptaban la creencia de la Asunción. Sin embargo, esta doctrina no se convirtió en artículo de fe hasta tiempos recientes, cuando el Papa Pio XII la declaró dogma de la fe Católica: “La Inmaculada Madre de Dios, la siempre Virgen Maria, habiendo cumplido el curso de su vida terrena, fue ascendida en cuerpo y alma a la gloria celestial” (Munificentissimus Deus, Papa Pio XII, 1950).

La Asunción no se enseña explícitamente en las Escrituras. En la narración bíblica, Maria se menciona por última vez en Hechos 1, donde se encuentra orando con los otros discípulos antes de Pentecostés. Después de eso, la Biblia guarda silencio sobre su vida y muerte. Varias escrituras demuestran la posibilidad de esta doctrina, y que es “adecuado” que Maria sea asunta al cielo. La primera referencia bíblica a la Santísima Madre está en Genesis 3:15: “Y pondré enemistad entre ti y la mujer, y entre tu simiente y la simiente suya; esta te herirá en la cabeza, y tú le herirás en el calcañar”. “En Lucas 1:28 leemos: “Y el ángel se acercó a ella y le dijo: Salve, llena eres de gracia, el Señor es contigo, bendita tu entre las mujeres”. Luego en Apocalipsis 12:1 dice: “Y apareció una gran maravilla en el cielo: Una mujer vestida del sol, y la luna debajo de sus pies, y sobre su cabeza una corona de doce estrellas”.

Se dice que la Asunción corporal es el efecto natural de ser “muy favorecido” o “lleno de gracia”. Un autor Católico escribe: “La coronación de Maria implica su asunción corporal anterior: Creemos que Nuestra Señora y nuestra Madre, ya han dejado la tierra y llegado al reino, donde, como Reina, es entronizada e intercede por todos nosotros. La Escritura habla explícitamente de Jesus, quien habiendo vivido una vida sin pecado, murió por los pecadores, fue sepultado y resucito de la muerte, y después de cuarenta días ascendió al cielo, donde reina en gloria. Creemos que la Reina del Cielo esta allí con el ya en gloria.

¡¡¡Feliz fiesta de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen Maria!!!

JESÚS HACE tres declaraciones importantes en el Evangelio de hoy.

"He venido a traer fuego a la tierra".

Este no es el fuego de la destrucción, el fuego que arrasa las selvas tropicales cada año.

Es el fuego del calor y la luz.

Es el fuego que limpia y purifica.

Es el fuego de la presencia de Dios, como en la zarza ardiente que vio Moisés, como en la columna de fuego que acompañó a los israelitas en el desierto, como en las lenguas de fuego de Pentecostés donde se mandó traer fuego a los discípulos, a la Iglesia, a todos nosotros.

Como fuego purificador, también puede traer dolor y purificación, pero finalmente conduce a la conversión y la liberación.

2. "Hay un bautismo que debo recibir y grande es mi angustia hasta que termine". Esto no significa que Jesús va a ser rebautizado en el Jordán. El bautismo de la pasión. La palabra bautismo implica inmersión total. Existe una estrecha relación entre el catecúmeno sumergido en la pasión y muerte de Cristo, el amor que se entrega, camino a la resurrección.

3. "No he venido a traer paz sino división". Porque quien se decide seguirle a Jesús tendrá que enfrentar las corrientes contrarias y hacer un buen combate como decía San Pablo. Pero siempre con caridad no con las armas del mundo sino de la fe. "Ámense los unos a los otros como yo los he amado. En esto conocerán todos que son mis discípulos".

C'est un texte étrange. Étrange pour nous qui sommes habitués à nous représenter Jésus entouré d'une auréole de douceur et de bonté qui frôle la mièvrerie. En fait, c'est bien la paix que Jésus apporte, mais pas la paix du monde, pas la paix facile. "C'est ma paix que je vous donne, mais je ne vous la donne pas comme le monde la donne" (Jn 14,27).

Il existe des paix trompeuses, des sécurités dangereuses, qui endorment, qui sont construites sur des compromis, qui ne font que masquer les vrais problèmes. Les prophètes, avant Jésus, avaient dénoncé ces fausses paix sans exigence morale et religieuse: «Du plus petit au plus grand, tous sont avides de vols et de rapines; prophètes comme prêtres, tous ils pratiquent le mensonge. Ils pensent à la légère la blessure de mon peuple en disant : «Paix! Paix! Alors qu'il n'y a point de paix. (Jér 6, 13-14).

Jésus a dit à la foule : «Si quelqu'un vient à moi sans me préférer à son père, sa mère, sa femme, ses enfants, ses frères, ses soeurs, et jusqu'à sa propre vie, il ne peut être mon disciple. » (Luc 14,26). Il ne s'agit pas de renier sa famille, mais d'accorder la priorité à la parole de Dieu... et cela causera toujours des conflits. Que de fois nous sommes confrontés à une situation qui nous oblige à choisir entre la fidélité à la parole de Dieu et les directives de la famille, des amis, de notre pays.

La parole de Dieu nous invite continuellement à remettre en question nos traditions, nos façons de faire, notre vie de tous les jours, car ces traditions et ces façons de faire vont souvent à l'encontre des préceptes de Jésus. En réfléchissant sur la paix du Christ, reviennent à l'esprit les magnifiques prophéties d'Isaïe, qui nous invitent à la paix, à la justice et à la fraternité : «De leurs épées, ils forgeront des socs de charrue, et de leurs lances, des faucilles. On ne lèvera plus l'épée nation contre nation, on ne s'entraînera plus pour la guerre» (Is 2)...

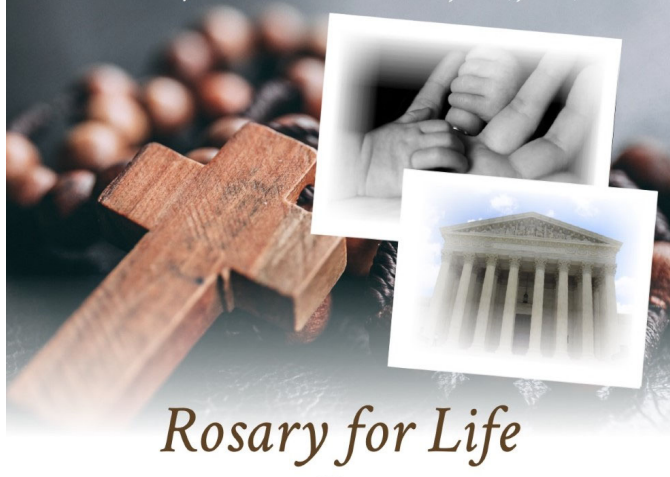
