Dear Sisters and Brothers,

“Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?” the person asks Jesus. It is a fundamental question that we all want to find answer to. Jesus answer is simple: love God and your neighbor as yourself. Our faith needs to become practical in serving the Lord and others. Jesus wants us to be his messengers, as the Gospel said last Sunday, he was sending his disciples two by two, to places that he intended to visit. Would you consider to be that instrument or messenger of Jesus? Would you consider to serve in the church in some capacity? The service in the church is the fruit of our mature faith, that makes us responsible for the message itself.

Our worldly culture, in order to attract us to its own purpose, is saying to us: “it is all about you”. This saying attracts our ego, because we all crave attention, because we all are self centered, but it tends to make ourselves the center of the universe. It distracts us from the importance of recognition, that God is the center of everything. Our service to God through community, affirms the primacy of God and his purpose for us. In order to be happy in life, we need to learn to give and to serve others. We need to sanctify our self-centeredness by perceiving in it the love of God. God who loves us from within, trying to help us to bring that love out of ourselves to others.

A happy person is the person who believes in the love of God for them, who believes in the love of others for them. So it is a fundamental experience to know how much God loves us, as it gives us the sense of self worth and lovability. This knowledge of God’s love will carry us through life. Knowing God’s love, one can compensate for limited human experience of love, and grow to fullest potential of love. Here comes the most popular Jewish prayer and commandment, that we hear this Sunday from the book of Deuteronomy repeated by Jesus: “Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might and love your neighbor as yourself.”

Let us imagine Jesus summarizing the Old and New Testament in this statement, what a powerful lesson that carries every Jew through life if only the person allows it. This is what will bring you and me to eternal life, Jesus confirmed: Do this and you shall live.

God on his part does love us completely, and if we correspond to his love it will transform us. It will enable us to love ourselves and our neighbor. Jesus answered for us the question of a lifetime. This question and answer explains to us the whole sense and purpose of our life. Thank You Jesus for making it so simple for us. Please help us to fulfill this simple commandment of love. Let us decide to love and to serve, so that we might have eternal life.

Queridas hermanas y hermanos,

“Maestro, ¿qué debo hacer para heredar la vida eterna?” la persona le pregunta a Jesús. Es una pregunta fundamental a la que todos queremos encontrar respuesta. La respuesta de Jesús es simple: ama a Dios y a tu prójimo como a ti mismo. Nuestra fe necesita volverse práctica para servir al Señor y a los demás. Jesús quiere que seamos sus mensajeros, como decía el Evangelio el domingo pasado, estaba enviando a sus discípulos de dos en dos, a los lugares que tenía intención de visitar. ¿Te considerarías ese instrumento o mensajero de Jesús? ¿Considerarías servir en la iglesia de alguna manera? El servicio en la iglesia es fruto de nuestra fe madura, que nos hace responsables del mensaje mismo.

Nuestra cultura mundana, para atraernos a su propio propósito, nos está diciendo: “se trata de ti”. Este dicho atrae nuestro ego, porque todos anhelamos atención, porque todos somos egocéntricos, pero tiende a convertirnos en el centro del universo. Nos distrae de la importancia del reconocimiento, que Dios es el centro de todo. Nuestro servicio a Dios a través de la comunidad afirma la primacía de Dios y su propósito para nosotros. Para ser felices en la vida, necesitamos aprender a dar y servir a los demás. Necesitamos santificar nuestro egocentrismo percibiendo en él el amor de Dios. Dios que nos ama desde dentro, tratando de ayudarnos a sacar ese amor de nosotros mismos a los demás.

Una persona feliz es la persona que cree en el amor de Dios por ella, que cree en el amor de los demás por ella. Entonces es una experiencia fundamental para saber cuánto nos ama Dios, ya que nos da el sentido de autovaloración y amabilidad. Este conocimiento del amor de Dios nos llevará a través de la vida. Conociendo el amor de Dios, uno puede compensar la experiencia humana limitada del amor y crecer al máximo potencial de amor. Aquí viene la oración y el mandamiento judío más popular, que escuchamos este domingo del libro de Deuteronomio repetido por Jesús: “Escucha, oh Israel: El Señor nuestro Dios, el Señor uno es. Amarás al Señor tu Dios con todo tu corazón y con toda tu alma y con todas tus fuerzas y amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo”, nos dice Jesús.

Imaginemos a Jesús resumiendo el Antiguo y el Nuevo Testamento en esta declaración, qué lección poderosa que lleva a todo judío por la vida si solo la persona lo permite. Esto es lo que nos llevará a ti ya mí a la vida eterna, confirmó Jesús: haz esto y vivirás.

Dios por su parte sí nos ama completamente, y si correspondemos a su amor nos transformará. Nos permitirá amarnos a nosotros mismos y a nuestro prójimo. Jesús nos contestó la pregunta de toda una vida. Esta pregunta y respuesta nos explica todo el sentido y propósito de nuestra vida. Gracias Jesús por hacerlo tan simple para nosotros. Por favor, ayúdanos a cumplir este sencillo mandamiento del amor. Decidámonos a amar y servir, para que tengamos vida eterna.

Lleno de compasión

"Ama a tu prójimo como a ti mismo" era la enseñanza del Testamento hebreo. El hombre que interrogó a Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy puso el dedo en la llaga cuando le preguntó a Jesús: "¿Quién es mi prójimo?" Es una pregunta que cada uno de nosotros debe hacerse y responder con la mayor honestidad posible. Otra forma de formular la pregunta también es preguntar: "¿A quién, en mi vida diaria, estoy dispuesto/a a ayudar?" "¿Cómo veo a los extranjeros en nuestra ciudad? ¿O los pobres, o los discapacitados, o los indigentes, o los que tienen problemas con la ley?"

La palabra clave en el evangelio de hoy, la parábola del buen samaritano, es "compasión" o "misericordia". Esto no es lo mismo que lástima. La compasión implica un profundo sentimiento de fraternidad por el cual uno puede entrar en el sufrimiento del otro y compartirlo. Además, el "prójimo" en la historia no es tanto el hombre que fue ayudado. El prójimo, dice el Evangelio, es "el que tuvo compasión". Un verdadero prójimo es aquel que muestra compasión por una persona totalmente desconocida que necesita ayuda.

Estamos llamados a comportarnos según esta enseñanza, como dice la Primera Lectura, esta Ley "no está en el cielo... ni más allá de los mares" fuera de nuestro alcance. No, "está muy cerca de ti, está en tu boca y en tu corazón para tu observancia". Por tanto, seamos fieles a las convicciones más profundas de nuestra fe.

La première Lecture du livre deuteronomie (30,10-14) Moïse nous invite à l'écoute du Seigneur et il est en quelque sorte définie par les trois verbes suivants : écouter, observer, revenir (au Seigneur). Tout commence par l'écoute d'une parole qui vient de loin, et qui touche et inspire au plus profond des cœurs. Elle est aussi une sagesse ouverte sur le monde.

Ce court extrait de la lettre aux Colossiens(1,15-20) présente une christologie très riche. C'est le rôle du Christ par rapport à la Création qu'à celui, à proprement parler, de Sauveur, et qui a créée toute chose : il est « premier-né avant toute créature » et « tout est créé par lui et pour lui ». Paul s'inspire à la fois du livre de la Genèse (Gn 1)

Luc 10, 25-37 Un docteur de la Loi s'adresse à Jésus avec l'intention de le mettre à l'épreuve. Sa question sur l'accès à « la vie éternelle » est pourtant légitime. Jésus lui fait confiance et l'invite à scruter davantage la Loi, c'est-à-dire à relire . L'homme n'est pas pris au dépourvu : il cite de mémoire deux passages majeurs de la Loi (Dt 6, 5 et Lv 19, 18) qui prescrivent l'amour de Dieu et du prochain. D'ailleurs, Jésus estime qu'il a répondu correctement et l'invite à mettre en pratique ce double commandement. Mais l'homme relance la discussion : « Et qui est mon prochain? » la question que nous pose chaque jour si nous sommes proches ou étrangers, si nous sommes Samaritains ou non Samaritains. Jésus lui répond avec une de ses plus belles paraboles : celle où seul un Samaritain sait prendre soin d'un homme attaqué par des bandits. Le Samaritain ne demande pas si l'homme blessé est un compatriote, un ami, un homme de la même religion. C'est une personne qui a besoin d'aide et cela suffit. Jésus donne le coup de grâce au légiste en le mettant au défi d'agir de la même façon : « Va et fais de même. nous ne serons pas évalués sur nos titres, nos appartenances ou nos connaissances, mais sur nos actes : « J'avais faim et vous m'avez donné à manger ; j'avais soif et vous m'avez donné à boire ; j'étais en prison, j'étais malade et vous êtes venus me visiter... » Au soir de la vie, rappelle Jean de la Croix, nous serons jugés sur l'amour. Frères et sœurs Bien-Aimés, À la fin de la célébration de l'Eucharistie, le Christ nous renvoie à nos occupations, à nos familles, à notre travail... en nous disant : « souviens-toi du bon Samaritain... et toi, va, fais de même, et tu vivras. » Amen.
