## *Message From Our Pastor*

### SEVENTH SUNDAY ORDINARY TIME

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

It was a nice week and hopefully you did have a good Saint Valentines. Last weekend party was a successful fundraiser with happy families and friends celebrating love and friendship. It was a mixture of good company, good food, good music, good setup, good organization and service. I was impressed by it all. With Esperanza, and a crew of volunteers, cooks and others who served and helped. Thank You All for making it a success, and for raising for our parish \$ 8000. It was a good way to celebrate friends, family, and a good way to support our parish. Parties are an important way of spending fun time together, after working so much, as all of you do, and seeing all those volunteers putting it all together, it really shows what we can do when we care about the parish and community.

This Sunday's Gospel is a challenging call to love one's enemies. The old rule of an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth, calls for justice by imposing an objective evil upon the evil doers, but by doing it, the good person becomes contaminated by participating in the evil. In this system, to win is to repay with an evil for an evil and this resembles the justice. But for Christ, that is the triumph of evil and it is unacceptable.

Jesus teaches us that what is good has to replace the evil, it makes it disappear. This is why mercy and forgiveness are greater than justice and revenge, love is greater than hatred, life is greater than death. This is how the good triumphs over evil. It is humanly illogical but in divine logic the love wins by self-gift to the other. Love transforms evil by self-sacrifice and it is a divine way of making evil disappear and go away.

"Christ in my mind, Christ in my heart, and Christ in my hands." He enters into our minds by the Word of God through listening, meditating and praying it. From our minds Christ reaches to our heart and transforms it through mercy and love, then Christ manifests himself in our hands when we do good works motivated by the love of Christ for me. As St. Paul says: "Christ's love urges us to love others", this is the love that anticipates any other human way of response in relationships. It's God's way, it's Jesus' way. Love does not know the evil because it never uses it in any circumstances. There is no evil in God.

"Christ in my mind, Christ in my heart, Christ in my hands." That is the goal. Love conquers all things. As Jesus says: "Be perfect as your Heavenly Father is perfect" (Matthew 5:48). Let's get ready for lent to work at the perfecting of our love. God bless everyone always!!!!

Fue una buena manera de celebrar con amigos y familiares y a la misma vez apoyar a nuestra parroquia. La fiesta es una forma importante de pasar tiempo divertido juntos, después de trabajar tanto, como todos ustedes lo hacen, y ver a todos esos voluntarios armando todo, realmente muestra lo que podemos hacer cuando nos preocupamos por la parroquia y la comunidad.

El Evangelio de este Domingo es un llamado desafiante a amar a los enemigos. Desde nuestra mente Cristo llega a nuestro corazón y lo transforma a través de la misericordia y el amor, entonces Cristo se manifiesta en nuestras manos cuando hacemos buenas obras motivados por el amor de Cristo por mí. Como dice San Pablo: “El amor de Cristo nos impulsa a amar a los demás”, este es el amor que anticipa cualquier otra forma humana de respuesta en las relaciones. Es el camino de Dios, es el camino de Jesus. El amor no conoce el mal porque nunca lo usa en ninguna circunstancia. No hay maldad en Dios.

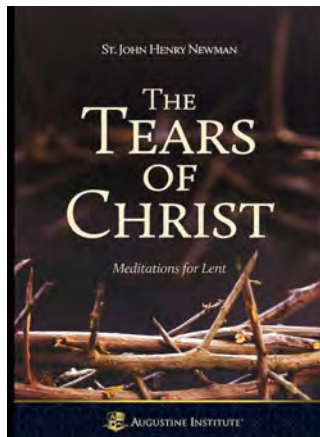

Jesús no nos pide que hagamos algo imposible e irrazonable, sino que abramos los ojos y veamos cuál es la única forma realmente sensata de vivir y relacionarnos con las personas que nos rodean. Y nos enseña que es posible con su gracia tratar a otras personas con tanta reverencia y atención. Porque, como dice san Pablo hoy, "vosotros sois templo de Dios y el Espíritu de Dios mora en vosotros. Si alguien destruye el templo de Dios, Dios destruirá a esa persona. Porque el templo de Dios es santo y vosotros sois ese templo", y esa persona que está a mi lado ahora mismo también lo es.

En general, estamos llamados a reconocer y responder a la presencia de Dios en cada persona y criatura que encontramos. Independientemente de cómo se comporten. Porque paradójicamente, cuanto peor se comporta una persona, más pide a gritos ser amada y cuidada.

7eme Dimanche du temps Ord.A «Soyez parfaits comme votre père céleste est parfait»

Nous continuons aujourd'hui la lecture du Sermon sur la montagne et nous retrouvons deux des antithèses de la Loi nouvelle.«Vous avez entendu qu'il a été dit : <Oeil pour oeil, dent pour dent.> Eh bien moi, je vous dis... de ne pas riposter au méchant.» La «loi du talion» est très mal comprise de nos sensibilités modernes. Comment la loi de Moïse a-t-elle pu imposer une telle législation?.

«Vous avez appris qu'il a été dit : Tu aimeras ton prochain et tu haïras ton ennemi. Et bien moi je vous dis : aimez vos ennemis et priez pour ceux qui vous persécutent». Jésus fait ici allusion à l'attitude courante de l'ensemble des gens, qui s'exprime dans plusieurs psaumes de «malédiction», où la haine du péché va jusqu'à justifier la guerre sainte et la haine de l'ennemi : «Si tu voulais, ô Dieu, tuer l'impie... N'ai-je pas en haine qui te hait, en dégoût, ceux qui se dressent contre toi ? Je les hais d'une haine parfaite, ce sont pour moi des ennemis.» (Ps 139, 19-21)

Pour comprendre l'invitation de pardonner à nos ennemis, il faut regarder le crucifix : Jésus, le fils du Père, a voulu du bien à ceux qui lui voulaient du mal. Il a souffert et il est mort pour ceux qui le faisaient mourir.

Ces exigences qui sont apparemment «impossibles à vivre», viennent de celui qui pardonne à ses ennemis sur la croix : «Père, pardonne-leur car ils ne savent ce qu'ils font», de celui «qui fait lever son soleil sur la terre de l'athée persécuteur, comme sur le jardin des carmélites.»

«Vous avez entendu qu'il a été dit... Et moi, je vous dis.» «Je ne suis pas venu abolir la Loi mais l'accomplir». La Christ vient accomplir la Loi, il vient la rendre plus parfaite avec un amour plus grand.

Cette force de l'amour, nous la retrouvons chez plusieurs des disciples du Christ.: «Faites-nous ce que vous voulez, mais nous continuerons à vous aimer. Jetez-nous en prison, mais nous vous aimons encore.

Soyez parfait comme votre Père céleste est parfait
