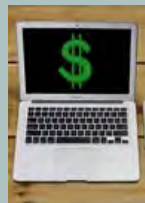

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR – 15th SUNDAY ORDINARY TIME

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The readings of this Sunday speak of the fruitfulness of God's creation. It is incredible how fertile every one of species that exists is. If any species should go into extinction, it is only because of the conditions which it requires went into disbalance and affected the procreation process. The generosity of the seeds dispersed from any plant, which keep falling off the branches and flowers into the fertile ground that provides a fitting place for its growth is overwhelming – if one would consider the numbers of seeds dispersed.

It is similar with the fertility in the animal and human world and it goes beyond the capacity to count the numbers. But all of them have a required conditioning for growth and development, for multiplication and reproduction. This, God's generously designed plan, provides for plenty of nutrition and natural selection of the best, and so the Lord has the right to expect from us the bearing of good fruit, that multiplies with some resemblance of God's creativity. For the sake of species continuity and selection of the strongest individuals, there seems to be plenty of waste that provides a base for that reproductive process.

All this is happening in the material realm of things, while in the spiritual realm of God's word, that fruitfulness is even more powerful and precise. As the first reading tells us of God's word, as of every drop of water, that never is waisted or lost without accomplishing its purpose and goal. The precision or accomplishment of God's word is total. There is no empty or fruitless word of God. This is the difference between our doing and God's doing.

God has the right to expect from us some fruitfulness in our doing and some fruitfulness in our loving. It is all based on our human capacity, our good will and our good faith. Didn't we receive enough, in order to become fruitful and to return at least some fruits? Or was God's grace or God's Love wasted in us, who became paralyzed by the fear, like the servant who did hide the talents entrusted to him by the master.

As Saint Paul said to us in the second reading: "the sufferings of this present time are nothing compared with the glory to be revealed for us" (Romans 8:18).

God bless everyone always!!!

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos

Las lecturas de este Domingo hablan de la fecundidad de la creación de Dios. Es increíble lo fértil que es cada una de las especies que existen. Si alguna especie debe extinguirse, es solo porque las condiciones que requiere se desequilibraron y afectaron el proceso de procreación. La generosidad de las semillas dispersadas de cualquier planta, que siguen cayendo de las ramas y las flores en la tierra fértil que proporciona un lugar adecuado para su crecimiento, es abrumadora, si se considera el número de semillas dispersas.

Es similar a la fecundidad en el mundo animal y humano y va más allá de la capacidad de contar los números. Pero todos ellos tienen un condicionamiento necesario para su crecimiento y desarrollo, para su multiplicación y reproducción. Este, es el plan diseñado generosamente por Dios, proporciona una nutrición abundante y una selección natural de lo mejor, por lo que el Señor tiene derecho a esperar de nosotros la producción de buenos frutos, que se multipliquen con alguna semejanza a la creatividad de Dios. Por el bien de la continuidad de las especies y la selección de los individuos más fuerte, parece haber muchos desechos que proporcionan una base para ese proceso reproductivo.

Todo esto está sucediendo en el ámbito material de las cosas, mientras que en el ámbito espiritual de la palabra de Dios, esa fecundidad es aún más poderosa y precisa. Como nos dice la primera lectura de la palabra de Dios, como de cada gota de agua, que nunca se agotara ni se perderá sin cumplir su propósito y fin. La precisión o cumplimiento de la palabra de Dios es total. No hay palabra de Dios vacía o sin fruto. Esta es la diferencia entre nuestro hacer y el hacer de Dios.

Dios tiene derecho a esperar de nosotros alguna fecundidad en nuestro hacer y alguna fecundidad en nuestro amor. Todo se basa en nuestra capacidad humana, nuestra buena voluntad y nuestra buena fe. ¿No recibimos bastante, para hacernos fructíferos y devolver por los menos algún fruto? ¿O se desperdició la gracia de Dios o el Amor de Dios en nosotros, que quedamos paralizados por el miedo, como el siervo que escondió los talentos que le confió el amo?

Como nos dijo San Pablo en la segunda lectura: “los sufrimientos de este tiempo presente no son nada comparados con la gloria que nos ha de ser revelada” (Romanos 8,18).

DECIMO QUINTO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Este Domingo se nos da para meditar la parábola del sembrador. El mensaje es claro: Dios es generoso sembrando, pero la concreción de los frutos de su siembra depende también —y a la vez— de nuestra libre respuesta, que el fruto depende de la “tierra” donde cae es algo que la experiencia de todos los días nos lo confirma. La buena tierra es nuestro corazón.

En parte es cosa de la naturaleza; pero sobre todo depende de nuestra voluntad. Hay personas que prefieren disfrutar antes que ser mejores. En ellas se cumple lo de la parábola: las malas hierbas (es decir, las preocupaciones del mundo y la seducción de las pasiones) «ahogan la Palabra, y queda sin fruto» (Mt 13,22)

Pero quienes, en cambio, valoran el ser, acogen con amor la semilla de Dios y la hacen fructificar, aunque para ello tengan que mortificarse. Así, el Señor nos enseña: «Si el grano de trigo no cae en tierra y muere, queda él solo; pero si muere, da mucho fruto» (Jn 12,24). También nos advirtió el Señor que el camino de la salvación es estrecho y angosto (cf. Mt 7,14): lo que mucho vale, mucha cuesta. Nada de valor se consigue sin esfuerzo.

El que se deja llevar de sus apetitos tendrá el corazón como una selva salvaje. Por el contrario, los árboles frutales que se podan dan mejor fruto. Así, las personas santas no han tenido una vida fácil, pero han sido unos modelos para la humanidad. «No todos estamos llamados al martirio, ciertamente, pero sí a alcanzar la perfección cristiana. Pero la virtud exige una fortaleza y perseverancia que (...) pide una obra larga y muy diligente, y que no hemos de interrumpir nunca, hasta entregar nuestra vida al Señor.

Reflection Dimanche 16 juillet 2023

"Voici que le semeur est sorti pour semer"

La parabole, en tant que genre littéraire, était très présente dans la littérature hébraïque. Nous en connaissons environ trois mille et Jésus les utilisait souvent.

Le mot «parabole», en hébreu «mâchâl», signifie «récit symbolique destiné à faire découvrir un sens caché». Pendant trois dimanches consécutifs, nous allons entendre les sept paraboles que Matthieu a regroupées dans le troisième grand discours de son évangile. Jésus est alors à un tournant difficile de son ministère

Dans la parabole du semeur, l'intérêt de Jésus est dirigé vers la semence du Royaume de Dieu. Les résultats annoncés dépassent de beaucoup toutes les espérances des fermiers de son temps. La parabole du semeur est donc d'abord et avant tout une invitation à l'espérance. nous avons plein d'expériences dans nos jardins et nos carrés de fleurs. Les légumes et les fleurs poussent en abondance et, dans les champs, nous voyons apparaître le blé, le mil, le trèfle, l'avoine le maïs et l'orge.

Jésus connaissait les obstacles que la Parole de Dieu rencontrait. Mais il savait aussi que cette Parole avait le pouvoir de transformer un terrain rocailleux en terre d'abondance. La Parole de Dieu donne du fruit en abondance et elle peut transformer «nos coeurs de pierre en coeur de chair».

Le Seigneur a raconté cette parabole du semeur afin de souligner la générosité de Dieu qui sème à tous les vents. Il a confiance en nous et invite tout le monde à devenir de la bonne terre. nous dit le Christ, la récolte sera bonne.

«Ne vous découragez pas», nous dit le Seigneur : «annoncez la bonne nouvelle de l'évangile dans votre vie, semez généreusement et un jour cela portera du fruit».

DONATION NEED IT

The generosity of the parishioners of St. Anne Parish allows us to reach out to people in our Brentwood/Bay Shore neighborhood who struggle each day to make ends meet. Thank you to all who generously donate to our food pantry. During June 2023, we were happy to assist 235 families, 65 seniors, 347 adults and 256 children. We also helped 8 new families.

School is finished for the year and our outreach is now requesting school supplies for the school year 2023-2024. The supply list is always very extensive: composition notebooks (no spiral notebooks), Ticonderoga #2 pencils, pens, colored pencils, Crayola crayons, glue, glue sticks, Fiscar scissors, highlighters, dry erase markers, thin washable markers, rulers, ruled index cards, pencil cases with zippers, 1" and 2" binders, dividers with tabs (for binders), loose leaf paper, 2-pocket folders (laminated or plastic), lunch bags and backpacks. Any donated school supply item will be greatly appreciated.

Here are some items we need this month: soup, rice, Goya beans, dry beans, cereal, jelly (small jars), juices, toilet paper, tissues, paper towels, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes, shaving cream, disposable razors, diapers (size 4, 5 & 6), baby wipes, feminine hygiene products, pet food and laundry detergent. Gift cards for Gala, Aldi, ShopRite, Target, Stop & Shop and Walmart are always appreciated.
