Dear Sisters and Brothers,

HAPPY EASTER TO YOU!!! HAPPY EASTER TO ALL!!!

The significance of Easter is much greater than the significance of Christmas. Revelation of Christ's humanity in Christmas is beautiful, very comforting and consoling to have Emmanuel, that is: God is with us, but revelation of the Resurrection is much greater, it shows us Christ's divinity and his power over death, our greatest enemy. It is the revelation of Christ's greatest gift to us, it is the gift of salvation, it is the gift of eternal life.

Resurrection of Christ becomes a promise to us, that we can be with God in eternal life, if only we deposit our trust in God. Christ became human, to make us somewhat divine through rising us from the dead to eternal life. By defeating death, Jesus brings the greatest victory into the perspective of everyone's life. He turns the greatest sadness's of human life, into the promise of unthinkable life forever in the kingdom of heaven.

This perspective is so big and so seemingly remote to our "today and now" thinking, because we are very materialistically oriented. Our images of resurrection do not adequately transmit the message with its depth. In our culture, the Resurrection and Easter are represented to us by images and concepts that are like parables, talking to us through images and concepts that are comparable in its effects. But to think about Resurrection and experience Resurrection, or to think about the death and experience death it is two different worlds. These two experiences, are the last experiences of our existence, and we all talk about it on the basis of our faith experience. How many of us had an experience of the resurrection, or how many of us experienced death?

So, when we speak about Easter using the images of: an Easter bunny, or Easter eggs, Easter lamb, Easter bread, Easter food, Easter basket, Easter flowers, empty tomb, Easter cloth, Easter water, Easter candle, they all speak of Resurrected Christ, but the experience of suffering, pain and death is already transformed into this new imagery of the life after. These are the two extremes of human experience that we all are scared to experience. We all know, that there will be no glorious experience of the Resurrection, before the scary experience of death. These are the two last experiences of our human earthly, and then heavenly existence. It is a dramatical, yet beautiful transformation. It is the transformation from the caterpillar into the butterfly, or from the seed into the flower, beautiful yet dramatic. Faith makes it sound simple; rationality makes it seem impossible. For Christ it is natural, for us it's supernatural. It is amazing and almost unthinkable; it is the best possible thing that can happen to a human being by becoming almost divine.

Jesus, save us from the eternal damnation, save us from our sins, save us from our death. Jesus, remember us when you come into your kingdom!

El significado de la Pascua es mucho mayor que el significado de la Navidad. Es hermosa la revelación de la humanidad de Cristo en Navidad, muy reconfortante y consolador tener el Emmanuel, es decir: Dios está con nosotros, pero la revelación de la Resurrección es mucho mayor, nos muestra la divinidad de Cristo y su poder sobre la muerte, nuestro mayor enemigo. Es la revelación del don más grande que Cristo nos ha dado, es el don de la salvación, es el don de la vida eterna.

La resurrección de Cristo se convierte en una promesa para nosotros de que podemos estar con Dios en la vida eterna, si tan solo depositamos nuestra confianza en Dios. Cristo se hizo humano, para hacernos algo divinos al resucitarnos de entre los muertos a la vida eterna. Al derrotar a la muerte, Jesús trae la mayor victoria a la perspectiva de la vida de todos. Él convierte las mayores tristezas de la vida humana en la promesa de una vida impensable para siempre en el reino de los cielos.

Esta perspectiva es tan grande y aparentemente remota para nuestro pensamiento de “hoy y ahora”, porque estamos muy orientados materialistamente. Nuestras imágenes de la resurrección no transmiten adecuadamente el mensaje con su profundidad. En nuestra cultura, la Resurrección y la Pascua se nos representan mediante imágenes y conceptos que son como parábolas, hablándonos a través de imágenes y conceptos que son comparables en sus efectos. Pero pensar en la Resurrección y experimentar la Resurrección, o pensar en la muerte y experimentar la muerte, son dos mundos diferentes. Estas dos experiencias, son las últimas experiencias de nuestra existencia, y todos hablamos de ello en base a nuestra experiencia de fe. ¿Cuántos de nosotros tuvimos una experiencia de resurrección, o cuántos de nosotros experimentamos la muerte?

Entonces, cuando hablamos de Pascua usando las imágenes de: un conejito de Pascua, o huevos de Pascua, cordero de Pascua, pan de Pascua, comida de Pascua, canasta de Pascua, flores de Pascua, tumba vacía, paño de Pascua, agua de Pascua, cirio de Pascua, todos hablan de Cristo Resucitado, pero la experiencia del sufrimiento, del dolor y de la muerte ya nos transforma en esta nueva imagen de la vida futura. Estos son los dos extremos de la experiencia humana que todos tenemos miedo de experimentar. Todos sabemos que no habrá una experiencia gloriosa de la Resurrección antes de la aterradora experiencia de la muerte. Estas son las dos últimas experiencias de nuestra existencia humana terrenal y luego celestial. Es una transformación dramática, pero hermosa. Es la transformación de oruga en mariposa, o de semilla en flor, hermosa pero dramática. La fe hace que parezca simple; la racionalidad hace que parezca imposible. Para Cristo es natural, para nosotros es sobrenatural. Es asombroso y casi impensable; es lo mejor que le puede pasar a un ser humano al volverse casi divino.

Jesús, sálvanos de la condenación eterna, sálvanos de nuestros pecados, sálvanos de nuestra muerte. ¡Jesús, acuérdate de nosotros cuando vengas a tu reino!

NUESTRAS CELEBRACIONES DE PASCUA forman el corazón de nuestra vida cristiana. Nuestra fe está profundamente arraigada y encuentra su verdadero significado en la resurrección de Jesús. San Pablo dice que, si Cristo no ha resucitado, entonces vana sería nuestra fe.

El tema de la Misa de hoy incluye tanto la proclamación como el testimonio.

En la Primera Lectura de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, Pedro enfatiza la importancia de que los discípulos de Jesús no solo experimenten y disfruten el gozo de su Maestro y Señor Resucitado, sino también de compartir esa experiencia y gozo con tantas personas como sea posible. Es algo que debemos hacer también. No compartir nuestra alegría pascual y lo que significa para nosotros es dejar la Pascua sólo a medio celebrar. En efecto, para el verdadero cristiano, cada día es una jornada de Pascua vivida con alegría en la estrecha compañía del Señor resucitado.

"Ahora", dice Pedro, "somos los testigos", es decir, de la predicación de Jesús, de su arresto, ejecución y muerte y también de su resurrección a la vida. "Hemos comido y bebido con él después de su resurrección de entre los muertos", continúa. ¿No es eso algo que nosotros también hacemos cada vez que participamos en la Eucaristía: comer y beber con Jesús Resucitado? ¿Y qué mensaje viene de eso? ¿Hemos satisfecho nuestra responsabilidad cristiana con sólo estar en la iglesia el domingo?

La resurrección de Cristo es prenda de nuestra propia resurrección. Sobre este fundamento descansa nuestra fe. Es la garantía de nuestra redención y la seguridad de Dios de que nuestros pecados son perdonados y que somos llamados a la vida eterna. "Este es el día que hizo el Señor; alegrémonos y regocijémonos en él. Alabemos al Señor, porque es bueno, porque eterna es su misericordia. Aleluya". FELICES PASCUAS A TODOS!!!

Et, en tout dernier lieu, il m'est apparu à moi aussi, comme à l'avorton.» (1 Cor 15, 3-8)

Nous sommes réunis aujourd'hui grâce à la transmission de cette Bonne Nouvelle et Nous célébrons la victoire de la vie sur la mort. Nous célébrons Jésus Christ, notre espérance, qui donne un sens à notre vie, malgré les angoisses, les souffrances et les difficultés de tous les jours.

En ce jour de la résurrection, le Christ nous invite à recommencer à vivre pleinement, à passer de la peur à la joie, du passé au présent, de l'hiver au printemps, de la mort à la vie. Aujourd'hui, nous célébrons la plus grande victoire qui existe, la victoire du Christ sur la mort.


In *The Joy of the Gospel*, Pope Francis states: “Christ’s resurrection is not an event of the past; it contains a vital power which has permeated the world. It is an irresistible force...Each day in our world beauty is born anew, it rises transformed through the storms of history...Such is the power of the resurrection, and all who evangelize are instruments of that power.” (276)

We continue to live through “the storms of history” and we rely on the Risen Lord and his glorified wounds to touch the wounds in Ukraine, the Middle East, Nicaragua, Venezuela, Armenia and Azerbaijan, the region of the Sahel, the Horn of Africa and Sudan, as well as Cameroon, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, South Sudan and so many other troubled areas of the world.<sup>1</sup> We ask the Risen Lord and his glorified wounds to touch the wounds experienced in our own country.

In *The Everlasting Man*, G.K. Chesterton captured the power of our Lord’s Resurrection experienced in the cycles of history. He wrote: “Christendom has had a series of revolutions and in each one of them Christianity has died. Christianity has died many times and risen again; for it had a God who knew the way out of the grave.”

This Easter and every Easter we celebrate this Everlasting Man who knew his way out of the grave and who invites us and the Catholic Church on Long Island to a great Resurrection.

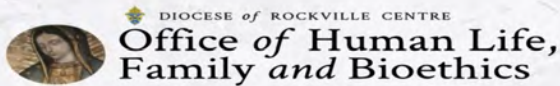
