Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This Sunday's readings remind us that the Gospel is not always comfortable. In Jeremiah 38, the prophet's faithfulness lands him in a muddy cistern. He speaks the truth God gives him, and for that he faces rejection and danger. Yet God raises up an unlikely rescuer, Ebed-melech, to pull him from the pit. Fidelity to God can bring conflict—but also His quiet, decisive care.

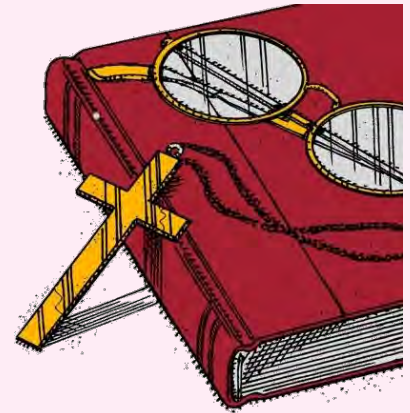
The letter to the Hebrews urges us to “persevere in running the race,” keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus. The Christian life is not a leisurely stroll—it's an endurance race marked by resistance, sacrifice, and a call to lay aside the weight of sin. Like Jeremiah, we may feel the pressure of opposition, but we are not running alone.

In Luke's Gospel, Jesus speaks startling words: “I have come to set the earth on fire... Do you think I have come to establish peace on the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division.” This is not a call to violence, but a recognition that His message cuts to the heart. True discipleship forces a choice: will we stand with Christ even when it strains relationships, challenges our comfort, or invites misunderstanding? Following Jesus means allowing His fire—the fire of truth, mercy, and holiness—to ignite our lives. That fire will burn away complacency and light the path for others. Yes, it may bring division, but it also brings the only peace that lasts: peace rooted in God's will. It is about our personal choice for Christ, in following him with the total trust that comes from experience of his presence and power in our lives without looking into what others decide for themselves. It is about belonging to the one who gave everything to save us. The fire that Jesus brings is the fire of love that transforms us from within to be his joyful followers. Jesus alone suffices, as St. Theresa said.

This week, let us ask the Lord for courage—courage to witness His truth with our lives like Jeremiah, to run with perseverance like the saints before us, and to welcome the refining fire Christ longs to set ablaze in our hearts.

We thank the Lord for the safe return of our youth and young adults from the Jubilee Pilgrimage to Rome. We will invite them to give a witness of their experience to our Parish community at the end of summer. We pray for all children, youth and young adults as they are finishing their summer vacations, may they all encounter God in their time of rest with their families and friends. God bless everyone always!!!

Hebrews 12:2

Queridas hermanas y hermanos:

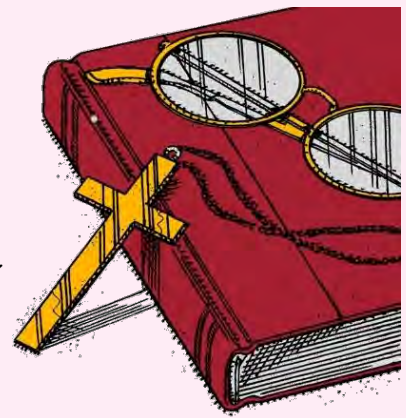
Las lecturas de este domingo nos recuerdan que el Evangelio no siempre es cómodo. En Jeremías 38, la fidelidad del profeta lo lleva a una cisterna llena de barro. Él proclama la verdad que Dios le da, y por eso enfrenta rechazo y peligro. Sin embargo, Dios suscita a un rescatador inesperado, Ebed-melec, para sacarlo del pozo. La fidelidad a Dios puede traer conflicto, pero también su cuidado silencioso y decisivo.

La carta a los Hebreos nos exhorta a “perseverar en la carrera”, manteniendo la mirada fija en Jesús. La vida cristiana no es un paseo tranquilo; es una carrera de resistencia marcada por la oposición, el sacrificio y el llamado a dejar a un lado el peso del pecado. Como Jeremías, podemos sentir la presión de la oposición, pero no corremos solos.

En el Evangelio de Lucas, Jesús pronuncia unas palabras sorprendentes: “He venido a prender fuego en la tierra... ¿Piensan que he venido a traer paz a la tierra? No, les digo, sino división.” No es un llamado a la violencia, sino el reconocimiento de que su mensaje llega al corazón y exige una decisión. El verdadero discipulado nos obliga a elegir: ¿permaneceremos con Cristo aun cuando eso tensione nuestras relaciones, desafíe nuestra comodidad o provoque incompreensión? Seguir a Jesús significa dejar que su fuego—el fuego de la verdad, la misericordia y la santidad—encienda nuestras vidas. Ese fuego quemará la complacencia e iluminará el camino para los demás. Sí, puede traer división, pero también trae la única paz que perdura: la paz enraizada en la voluntad de Dios. Se trata de nuestra decisión personal por Cristo, de seguirlo con una confianza total que nace de la experiencia de su presencia y poder en nuestras vidas, sin fijarnos en lo que otros decidan para sí mismos. Se trata de pertenecer a Aquel que lo dio todo para salvarme. El fuego que Jesús trae es el fuego del amor que nos transforma desde dentro para ser sus alegres discípulos. “Sólo Dios basta”, como dijo Santa Teresa.

Esta semana pidamos al Señor valentía: valentía para testimoniar su verdad con nuestra vida como Jeremías, para correr con perseverancia como los santos que nos precedieron, y para acoger el fuego purificador que Cristo quiere encender en nuestros corazones. Damos gracias al Señor por el regreso seguro de nuestros jóvenes y adultos jóvenes de la Peregrinación Jubilar a Roma. Los invitaremos a dar testimonio de su experiencia a nuestra comunidad parroquial al final del verano. Oramos por todos los niños, jóvenes y adultos jóvenes que están terminando sus vacaciones de verano; que todos puedan encontrar a Dios en este tiempo de descanso con sus familias y amigos. ¡Que Dios los bendiga siempre a todos!!!

"Fuego, fidelidad y esperanza: un llamado a la valentía cristiana"

Este domingo, las lecturas nos presentan un mensaje fuerte, desafiante y profundamente actual: seguir al Señor exige valentía, fidelidad y una disposición a enfrentar incomodidad por el Evangelio.

En la primera lectura (Jeremías 38:4-6, 8-10), el profeta es arrojado a una cisterna por anunciar la verdad de Dios en tiempos difíciles. Jeremías no buscó causar división, pero su fidelidad a la Palabra lo puso en conflicto con el poder y la comodidad de su entorno. ¿Cuántas veces, también hoy, decir la verdad evangélica cuesta rechazo o burla?

El Salmo 40 nos enseña cómo responder en momentos así: "Se inclinó y escuchó mi clamor... Señor, ven pronto a socorrerme." La oración del justo es su refugio. Aun en el pozo más profundo, como Jeremías, el creyente no está solo.

La carta a los Hebreos (12:1-4) nos anima a correr con perseverancia la carrera de la fe, "puestos los ojos en Jesús." No estamos solos en nuestra lucha. Una gran nube de testigos —santos, mártires, creyentes fieles— nos precede. Jesús, que soportó la cruz, es nuestro modelo y fuerza.

Finalmente, el Evangelio (Lucas 12:49-53) trae palabras que pueden sorprendernos: "He venido a prender fuego en el mundo... ¿Creen que he venido a traer paz? No, sino división." Jesús no llama a la violencia, sino a una decisión radical. Su fuego es el del Espíritu, que purifica, transforma y arde en el corazón del que se entrega a Él. Y ese fuego, a veces, divide incluso a las familias, porque seguir a Cristo implica elegirlo por encima de todo.

"Je ne suis pas venu mettre la paix, mais la division"

En fait, c'est bien la paix que Jésus apporte, mais pas la paix du monde, pas la paix facile. "C'est ma paix que je vous donne, mais je ne vous la donne pas comme le monde la donne" (Jn 14,27).

«Je ne suis pas venu établir la paix mais la division», dit le Christ.

Aujourd'hui, même à l'intérieur de nos familles, nous pouvons remarquer la lucidité prophétique de ces paroles de Jésus:

Quelle est la famille chrétienne à l'abri de ces conflits, annoncés par Jésus? Nous sommes alors tentés de nous culpabiliser ou d'accuser les autres: c'est la faute de l'Église... c'est la faute des éducateurs... c'est ma faute à moi : si j'avais fait ceci, si j'avais fait cela...

Jésus a dit à la foule : «Si quelqu'un vient à moi sans me préférer à son père, sa mère, sa femme, ses enfants, ses frères, ses soeurs, et jusqu'à sa propre vie, il ne peut être mon disciple. » (Luc 14,26). Il ne s'agit pas de renier sa famille, mais d'accorder la priorité à la parole de Dieu... et cela causera toujours des conflits.

Que de fois nous sommes confrontés à une situation qui nous oblige à choisir entre la fidélité à la parole de Dieu et les directives de la famille, des amis, de notre pays.

La parole de Dieu nous invite continuellement à remettre en question nos traditions, nos façons de faire, notre vie de tous les jours, car ces traditions et ces façons de faire vont souvent à l'encontre des préceptes de Jésus.

Je pense aux parents qui essaient d'inculquer à leurs enfants certaines valeurs chrétiennes. Très vite, ils sont accusés de ne pas vivre dans le vrai monde, de refuser de laisser leurs enfants faire comme les autres.

Et les personnes qui s'appuient sur leur foi, qui continuent à avoir confiance en Dieu, qui participent aux eucharisties du dimanche. Leurs propres enfants les accusent souvent de vivre au Moyen Âge. Et ceux qui veulent vivre les valeurs chrétiennes au travail, en politique, sur la place publique, ils sont vite ramenés à l'ordre. «La religion est chose privée. Elle n'a pas sa place dans le domaine public». Le Christ n'accepte pas tout, il ne tolère pas tout. Comme le texte d'aujourd'hui nous le montre, il est au contraire très exigeant. S'il avait été aussi tolérant qu'on veut bien le croire, il serait mort de vieillesse.

En réfléchissant sur la paix du Christ, reviennent à l'esprit les magnifiques prophéties d'Isaïe, qui nous invitent à la paix, à la justice et à la fraternité : «De leurs épées, ils forgeront des socs de charrue, et de leurs lances, des faucilles. On ne lèvera plus l'épée nation contre nation, on ne s'entraînera plus pour la guerre» (Is 2)...

Vivre pour établir cette paix véritable créera toujours des conflits et des divisions. «Je ne suis pas venu mettre la paix mais la division».

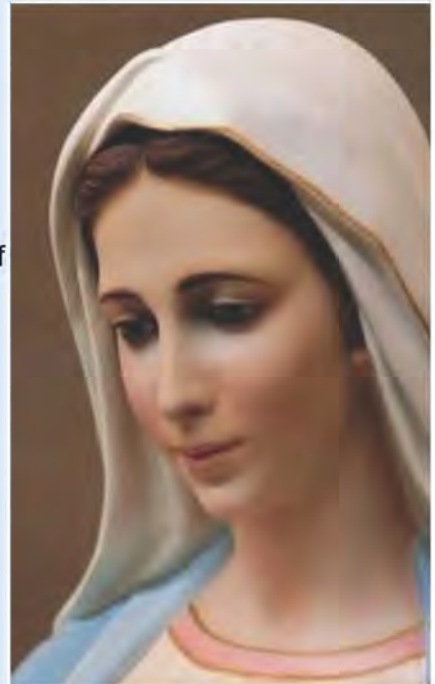
