Dear Sisters and Brothers,

On this All Souls Day, we come together to remember all who have died — those still held dearly in our hearts and those who may have no one left to pray for them. In this sacred act of remembrance, the Word of God speaks directly to both our grief and our hope.

Wisdom 3 reminds us: “The souls of the just are in the hand of God, and no torment shall touch them.” Even though death may appear to the world as loss or tragedy, God sees a deeper truth. For the faithful, death is not an end but a homecoming — a passage into the peace God has promised. Their hope, tested and refined like gold in fire, is now fulfilled in God’s presence. The Gospel echoes and strengthens this promise. Jesus assures us in John 6: “I will not reject anyone who comes to me... I shall not lose anything of what he gave me, but that I

should raise it on the last day.” This is the solid ground of our Christian faith: God’s love is relentless, protective, and victorious. No one entrusted to Christ slips from His grasp.

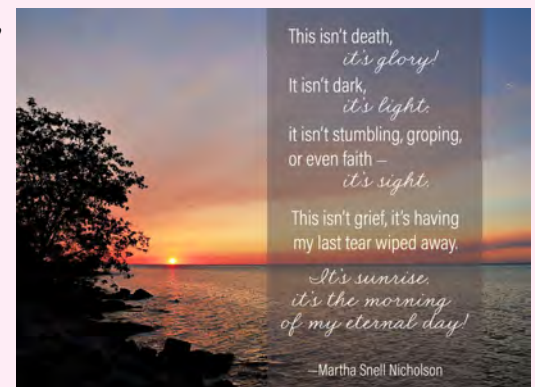
Today is a day of tender memory. We honor the lives that helped shape our own — parents, children, friends, neighbors, and generations before us. We may feel the sting of their absence, but even that pain testifies to the love that remains. In prayer, grief is transformed into trust: trust that God’s mercy is wider than our sorrow and deeper than the grave. Let us commend every soul to the Lord with confidence in His promise of eternal life. And may our remembrance inspire us to live now with the faith, compassion, and courage that our loved ones passed on to us — until we are reunited in God’s everlasting light. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them.

As we visit and honor the graves and the remains of our beloved dead, let us remember that their souls are very much alive before God — standing now in awe, adoration, and wonder at the beauty of creation and redemption, contemplating the majesty of the Creator and Redeemer. Knowing our human brokenness, we may think of our loved ones as still undergoing purification in purgatory — and that thought may give rise to concern. Yet the Church teaches that purgatory is a merciful place of purification, where every trace of selfishness is cleansed and the soul is illumined by the fullness of God’s love. It prepares the soul to stand before the Lord in complete truth and freedom. Recognizing the vastness of God’s love and the harmony of all relationships in Him, the soul is liberated for the joy of eternal life.

This is why we pray, fast, and offer sacrifices for the faithful departed — to lovingly assist them on their journey into the fullness of God’s presence.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas:

En este Día de los Fieles Difuntos, nos reunimos para recordar a todos los que han muerto: a quienes aún llevamos con cariño en nuestros corazones y a aquellos que quizás ya no tienen a nadie que rece por ellos. En este sagrado acto de memoria, la Palabra de Dios habla directamente tanto a nuestro dolor como a nuestra esperanza. El libro de la Sabiduría nos recuerda: «Las almas de los justos están en las manos de Dios y ningún tormento las alcanzará». Aunque la muerte pueda parecer al mundo una pérdida o una tragedia, Dios contempla una verdad más profunda. Para los fieles, la muerte no es un final, sino un regreso al hogar: un paso hacia la paz que Dios ha prometido. Su esperanza, probada y purificada como el oro en el fuego, se cumple ahora en la presencia de Dios. El Evangelio confirma y fortalece esta promesa. Jesús nos asegura en Juan 6: «No rechazaré a nadie que venga a mí... y no perderé nada de lo que él me ha dado, sino que lo resucitaré en el último día». Esta es la base firme de nuestra fe cristiana: el amor de Dios es incansable, protector y victorioso. Nadie confiado a Cristo se escapa de sus manos. Hoy es un día de memoria entrañable. Honramos las vidas que han dado forma a la nuestra: padres, hijos, amigos, vecinos y generaciones anteriores. Podemos sentir el dolor de su ausencia, pero incluso ese dolor da testimonio del amor que permanece. En la oración, el dolor se transforma en confianza: confianza en que la misericordia de Dios es más grande que nuestra tristeza y más profunda que la tumba. Encomendemos cada alma al Señor con plena confianza en su promesa de vida eterna. Y que nuestro recuerdo nos impulse a vivir hoy con la fe, la compasión y el valor que nuestros seres queridos nos transmitieron, hasta que nos reencontremos en la luz eterna de Dios. Dale, Señor, el descanso eterno, y brille para ellos la luz perpetua.

Al visitar y honrar las tumbas y los restos de nuestros queridos difuntos, recordemos que sus almas están plenamente vivas ante Dios: ahora en pie de asombro, adoración y maravilla ante la hermosura de la creación y la redención, contemplando la majestad del Creador y Redentor.

Conociendo nuestra fragilidad humana, podemos pensar que nuestros seres queridos aún pasan por la purificación del purgatorio, y ese pensamiento puede preocuparnos. Sin embargo, la Iglesia enseña que el purgatorio es un lugar de misericordia, donde toda huella de egoísmo es purificada y el alma es iluminada por la plenitud del amor de Dios. Prepara al alma para presentarse ante el Señor en total verdad y libertad. Al reconocer la inmensidad del amor de Dios y la armonía de todas las relaciones en Él, el alma se abre a la alegría de la vida eterna. Por eso oramos, ayunamos y ofrecemos sacrificios por los fieles difuntos: para ayudarles con amor en su camino hacia la plenitud de la presencia de Dios.

“Y yo lo resucitaré en el último día”

El día de hoy, la Iglesia nos invita a mirar el misterio de la muerte con los ojos de la fe. Recordamos con amor y esperanza a todos nuestros hermanos y hermanas que han partido de este mundo. No lo hacemos desde la tristeza sin consuelo, sino desde la confianza en la promesa de Cristo:

“El que viene a mí no lo rechazaré... y yo lo resucitaré en el último día.”

Estas palabras del Evangelio según san Juan nos revelan el corazón de Dios: un Padre que no pierde a ninguno de sus hijos, un Dios que acoge, perdona y salva.

En medio del dolor de la separación, Jesús nos recuerda que la muerte no tiene la última palabra. Su amor es más fuerte que la tumba, y su promesa de vida eterna nos sostiene.

Hoy, al recordar a nuestros difuntos, no sólo rezamos por ellos, sino también con ellos, porque siguen unidos a nosotros en el amor de Cristo. En cada Eucaristía, el cielo y la tierra se encuentran; y en ese misterio, nuestros seres queridos participan ya de la vida que no termina.

La fe en la resurrección no borra el dolor de la ausencia, pero transforma la tristeza en esperanza. Nos recuerda que cada lágrima será consolada, que cada vida entregada por amor florecerá en eternidad.

Por eso, al visitar un cementerio, al encender una vela o al pronunciar el nombre de alguien que amamos, no pensemos sólo en la muerte, sino en la vida que Dios prepara para todos los que creen en Él.

Cristo ha prometido:

“La voluntad de mi Padre es que todo el que vea al Hijo y crea en Él tenga vida eterna.”

Confiemos, entonces, en esta promesa. Pidamos al Señor que fortalezca nuestra fe, que nos ayude a vivir con esperanza y a esperar el día en que todos nos reencontremos en su presencia, donde ya no habrá llanto ni despedidas, sino alegría sin fin.

Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls' Day), Wisdom 3:1–9, Psalm 23, and John 6:37–40.

Today, we gather with tender hearts to remember and pray for all our beloved dead — parents, spouses, children, friends, and all those who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith. We call this day All Souls' Day, but truly, it is a day of hope.

The Book of Wisdom tells us: “The souls of the just are in the hand of God, and no torment shall touch them.” To our eyes, death looks like loss and separation. But in God’s eyes, it is not destruction — it is transformation. Those who lived in friendship with God are now held securely in His loving hand. What a powerful image: our loved ones are not lost; they are held.

Psalm 23 deepens this trust: “The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.” Even when we walk through the dark valley of grief, we are not alone. God Himself walks beside us, guiding us toward the green pastures of eternal life.

And in the Gospel, Jesus gives us the promise that grounds our faith:

“Everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have eternal life, and I shall raise him on the last day.”

This is the heart of our Christian hope — that death does not have the final word. Christ, who conquered death, will raise us up to life that never ends.

So today, we remember with love, we grieve with faith, and we pray with hope. Our prayers for the departed are not empty words; they are acts of love that unite heaven and earth. As we celebrate this Eucharist, let us entrust all souls into the merciful hands of the Good Shepherd, confident that He will lead them — and us — safely home.

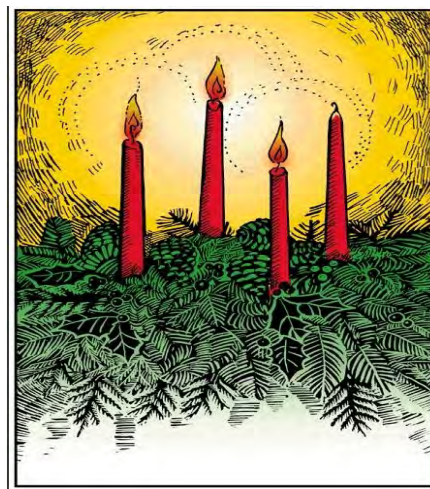
