Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. The Church lifts high the Cross of Christ, the sign of our salvation and the source of our hope. This feast celebrates a double anniversary. In Jerusalem, Constantine erected the Anastasis above the empty grave of Jesus, the Martyrium basilica nearby, and in between, the Calvarium shrine marking the place of the crucifixion. Dedicated in 335, these holy sites were destroyed and rebuilt several times until the present Church of the Holy Sepulcher was completed by the Crusaders in 1149. Today also recalls the discovery of the Lord's Cross by St. Helena in 320. This history reminds us that while earthly buildings may rise and fall, the Cross itself endures forever—the sign of God's victory over sin, evil, and death.



The Cross of St. Benedict proclaims this victory in a powerful way. Around the medal are inscribed prayers of exorcism and protection: *Crux sacra sit mihi lux* — “May the holy Cross be my light.” *Non draco sit mihi dux* — “Let not the dragon (Satan) be my guide.” *Vade retro Satana!* — “Begone, Satan!” *Nunquam suade mihi vana* — “Never tempt me with your vanities.” *Sunt mala quae libas; ipse venena bibas* — “The drink you offer is evil; drink that poison yourself.” These words are not superstition or magic, but a proclamation of faith: that through the Cross of Christ, the devil is powerless. The medal is used as a prayer of exorcism against spiritual attacks, temptations, and dangers. It is a visible reminder that Christ has conquered, and that His Cross protects those who call on Him with faith.

We also see this lived devotion in the prayer many Latino families make with the triple cross before prayer: “*Por la señal de la Santa Cruz, de nuestros enemigos libranos Señor, Dios nuestro: Padre, Hijo, Espíritu Santo.*” (“By the sign of the Holy Cross, deliver us from our enemies, Lord our God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.”) With this gesture—crossing the forehead, lips, and heart—we ask God to purify our thoughts, words, and desires, and to keep us safe from every evil.

On this feast, let us lift high the Cross—not only in our churches, but in our homes and hearts. May the Cross be our light, our protection, and our strength in every circumstance of life. As St. Paul said: “May I never boast except in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ” (Gal 6:14). God bless everyone always!!!

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas:

Este domingo celebramos la Fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz. La Iglesia eleva la Cruz de Cristo, signo de nuestra salvación y fuente de nuestra esperanza. Esta fiesta celebra un doble aniversario. En Jerusalén, Constantino erigió el Anástasis sobre la tumba vacía de Jesús, la basílica del Martyrium cercana, y entre ambas, el santuario del Calvario que marcaba el lugar de la crucifixión. Dedicados en el año 335, estos lugares santos fueron destruidos y reconstruidos varias veces, hasta que la actual Iglesia del Santo Sepulcro fue completada por los Cruzados en 1149. Hoy también recordamos el hallazgo de la Cruz del Señor por Santa Elena en el año 320. Esta historia nos recuerda que, aunque los edificios terrenos se levanten y caigan, la Cruz permanece para siempre: signo de la victoria de Dios sobre el pecado, el mal y la muerte.

La Cruz de San Benito proclama esta victoria de un modo especial. Alrededor de la medalla están inscritas oraciones de exorcismo y protección: *Crux sacra sit mihi lux* — “Que la Santa Cruz sea mi luz.” *Non draco sit mihi dux* — “Que el dragón (Satanás) no sea mi guía.” *Vade retro Satana!* — “¡Apártate, Satanás!” *Nunquam suade mihi vana* — “Nunca me tientes con tus vanidades.” *Sung mala quae libas; ipse venena bibas* — “Lo que ofreces es malo; bebe tú mismo tu veneno.” Estas palabras no son superstición ni magia, sino una proclamación de fe: que por la Cruz de Cristo, el demonio queda sin poder. La medalla se usa como oración de exorcismo contra los ataques espirituales, tentaciones y peligros. Es un recordatorio visible de que Cristo ha vencido, y de que su Cruz protege a quienes lo invocan con fe.

También vemos esta devoción en la oración que muchas personas latinas hacen con la triple cruz antes de orar: “Por la señal de la Santa Cruz, de nuestros enemigos líbranos Señor, Dios nuestro: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo.” (“By the sign of the Holy Cross, deliver us from our enemies, Lord our God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit”). Con este gesto—cruzando la frente, los labios y el corazón—pedimos a Dios que purifique nuestros pensamientos, palabras y deseos, y que nos guarde de todo mal.

En esta fiesta, elevemos la Cruz, no sólo en nuestras iglesias, sino también en nuestros hogares y corazones. Que la Cruz sea nuestra luz, nuestra protección y nuestra fortaleza en toda circunstancia de la vida. Como dijo San Pablo: “Lejos esté de mí gloriarme, si no es en la cruz de nuestro Señor Jesucristo” (Gál 6,14). ¡Que Dios los bendiga siempre!!!

La Cruz que salva: un signo de amor y victoria

La Fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz nos invita a mirar con profundidad el misterio más grande del cristianismo: el amor que se entrega hasta el extremo. Las lecturas de hoy, cuidadosamente elegidas, nos conducen desde la historia del pueblo de Israel hasta la plenitud del amor revelado en Cristo crucificado.

En la primera lectura (Números 21, 4b-9), el pueblo, impaciente en el desierto, murmura contra Dios y contra Moisés. Como consecuencia, son mordidos por serpientes venenosas. Pero cuando se arrepienten, el Señor ordena a Moisés levantar una serpiente de bronce en un asta, y quien la mire con fe, será sanado. Este gesto anticipa algo más grande: una cruz que, lejos de ser castigo, se convertirá en instrumento de sanación y vida.

El Salmo 78 nos recuerda cómo el pueblo olvidaba una y otra vez las obras del Señor. Y sin embargo, Dios seguía mostrando su misericordia. El estribillo resuena con fuerza: "No olviden las acciones del Señor." La cruz es precisamente eso: la acción más grande de Dios por nosotros, que no debemos olvidar.

La segunda lectura, tomada de Filipenses (2, 6-11), nos presenta el himno cristológico más hermoso del Nuevo Testamento. Cristo, siendo Dios, se rebajó, se hizo obediente hasta la muerte, y una muerte de cruz. Y por eso fue exaltado. La cruz, entonces, no es fracaso: es el camino hacia la gloria, porque en ella se revela un amor que se abaja para levantar al otro.

Finalmente, el Evangelio de Juan (3,13-17) nos revela el sentido profundo de todo esto. Jesús mismo dice: "Así como Moisés levantó la serpiente en el desierto, así tiene que ser levantado el Hijo del hombre, para que todo el que cree en Él tenga vida eterna." El centro del mensaje es claro: la cruz es el lugar donde se manifiesta el amor salvador de Dios. No vino para condenar, sino para salvar.

Hoy, al exaltar la Santa Cruz, no celebramos el sufrimiento por sí mismo. Celebramos el amor que transforma el dolor en redención, el fracaso en victoria, la muerte en vida. Mirar la cruz es recordar hasta dónde llegó Dios por amor a ti y a mí.

24eme Dimanche du Temp ordinaire C.(9/14/2025)

"Cet homme fait bon accueil aux pécheurs et mange avec eux"

La liturgie de ce dimanche pourrait s'intituler « le chant de la tendresse de Dieu » qui se manifeste tout spécialement dans le pardon... Un chant que l'on retrouve dans la prière initiale, les lectures, le psaume, et de façon toute spéciale dans l'évangile.

Dans le psaume 50, nous trouvons la clé de lecture de cette belle liturgie de la parole : «Donne-nous, ô Père, la joie du pardon ».

Dans l'évangile d'aujourd'hui, le Christ invite ses critiques à changer leur attitude envers les pécheurs. Leur tendre la main ressemble plus à Dieu que se tenir loin d'eux. Devant la femme adultère, Jésus avait proposé la solution suivante : que celui d'entre vous qui n'a jamais péché lui lance la première pierre; ils avaient parfaitement compris, et ils s'étaient retirés, les uns après les autres, en commençant par les plus vieux... (Jn 8, 7-9).

« Dieu ne veut pas la mort du pécheur, mais qu'il se convertisse et qu'il vive » (Éz 33, 11). Dieu est le Père de tous et il ne marginalise personne. Il se réjouit lorsqu'un pécheur est sauvé et le restaure à sa dignité de fils ou de fille de Dieu.

Dans la parabole de l'enfant prodigue, le père établit de nouveau la relation filiale avec son fils perdu : « Celui-ci est mon fils qui était mort et il est revenu à la vie; il était perdu et il est retrouvé ». Celui qui avait claqué la porte et avait cru pouvoir trouver le bonheur loin du foyer paternel s'attendait à beaucoup moins de la part de son père!

Pour ce qui est du frère aîné, il est perdu lui aussi. Lorsqu'il revient des champs et entend la musique, il refuse de rencontrer son frère et de se joindre au festin. Il humilie publiquement son père devant tout le village, en l'accusant d'injustice et de faiblesse.

De nouveau, le père traite ce fils perdu avec tendresse et humilité. La différence entre le plus vieux et le plus jeune fils est leur façon de réagir à la bonté du père.

Le père, contrairement au fils qui retourne des champs, s'intéresse moins à la culpabilité de ses fils qu'à leur retour à la famille et à la joie d'être aimés.

Dieu est pour nous un père et il nous offre continuellement « un nouveau départ ». Nous ne pouvons pas changer le passé, mais nous pouvons toujours devenir de nouveau des fils ou des filles de Dieu : « Mon fils que voilà était perdu et il est retrouvé; il était mort et il est revenu à la vie ».

Ce qui frappe, dans les paraboles d'aujourd'hui, c'est l'opposition entre le rejet de Dieu par les deux fils et la joie débordante de la conversion.

Le ciel de Jésus n'est pas le ciel des comptables de la Loi pour les purs et pour les « parfaits », mais le ciel de pécheurs convertis et pardonnés... C'est un ciel beaucoup plus attrayant que celui des pharisiens, un ciel où il y a toujours de la place pour chacun et chacune d'entre nous.

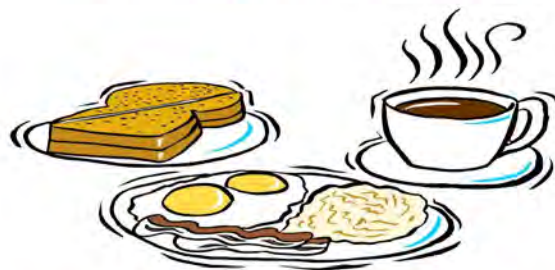
