Dear Sisters and Brothers,

In this Sunday's Gospel (Luke 10:1–12, 17–20), Jesus appoints seventy-two disciples and sends them out two by two to the towns He himself intended to visit. His instructions are clear and simple: travel lightly, depend on the hospitality of others, and proclaim, "The kingdom of God is at hand." What's remarkable is the humility and vulnerability Jesus asks of His followers. They are not to carry money, food, or even an extra pair of sandals. They go as messengers of peace, not power. And their primary task is not to argue or persuade, but simply to bless: "Peace to this household." Jesus reminds them—and us—that the mission is not about personal success but about faithfulness. Even when their efforts seem rejected, they are not to lose heart. "Shake the dust from your feet," He tells them. In other words: leave the outcome to God. When the disciples return rejoicing at their success, Jesus gently reminds them not to place their joy in their achievements, but in their relationship with God: "Rejoice because your names are written in heaven."

As modern disciples, we too are sent out—to our families, workplaces, neighborhoods, and beyond. We may not always see dramatic results, but that's not the point. What matters is that we go with the peace of Christ in our hearts, trusting that God will do the rest. Let us remember this week that we are all "sent ones"—ambassadors of Christ's peace in a world that desperately needs it. Where do I feel Jesus sending me to share His peace this week? Am I too focused on outcomes, or am I trusting in God's greater plan? Let us allow Jesus to make us his messengers of peace ready to prepare the places and hearts of others for Jesus to visit and complete his saving work in their lives.

I hope and pray that you are enjoying this long weekend of Independence Day and celebrating it as a time of total dependence on God's providence and love as was requested by Christ in the Gospel. As the children and youth entered the vacations time, let it be a time to strengthen family relationships and friendships with each other and with God himself. God bless everyone always!!!

Queridos hermanos y hermanas;

En el Evangelio de este domingo (Lucas 10, 1–12. 17–20), Jesús nombra a setenta y dos discípulos y los envía de dos en dos a los pueblos que Él mismo pensaba visitar. Sus instrucciones son claras y sencillas: viajen ligeros, dependan de la hospitalidad de los demás, y proclamen: “El Reino de Dios está cerca.” Lo que llama la atención es la humildad y la vulnerabilidad que Jesús pide a sus seguidores. No deben llevar dinero, comida ni siquiera un par de sandalias extra. Van como mensajeros de paz, no de poder. Y su tarea principal no es discutir ni convencer, sino simplemente bendecir: “¡La paz esté con esta casa!” Jesús les recuerda —y también a nosotros— que la misión no se trata del éxito personal, sino de la fidelidad. Aun cuando sus esfuerzos parezcan rechazados, no deben desanimarse. “Sacudan el polvo de sus pies”, les dice. Es decir: dejen los resultados en manos de Dios. Cuando los discípulos regresan llenos de alegría por los frutos de su misión, Jesús les recuerda con ternura que no deben alegrarse por sus logros, sino por su relación con Dios: “¡Alégrense más bien porque sus nombres están escritos en el cielo.” Como discípulos modernos, también nosotros somos enviados —a nuestras familias, lugares de trabajo, vecindarios y más allá. Tal vez no siempre veamos resultados extraordinarios, pero ese no es el punto. Lo que importa es salir con la paz de Cristo en el corazón, confiando en que Dios hará el resto. Recordemos esta semana que todos somos “enviados”, embajadores de la paz de Cristo en un mundo que la necesita con urgencia. ¿Hacia dónde siento que Jesús me está enviando esta semana para compartir su paz? ¿Estoy demasiado enfocado en los resultados, o estoy confiando en el plan más grande de Dios? Permitamos que Jesús nos haga sus mensajeros de paz, listos para preparar los lugares y corazones de los demás, para que Él los visite y complete su obra salvadora en sus vidas.

Espero y oro que estén disfrutando este fin de semana largo del Día de la Independencia, celebrándolo como un tiempo de total dependencia en la providencia y el amor de Dios, tal como Jesús lo pide en el Evangelio. Y ahora que los niños y jóvenes han comenzado sus vacaciones, que este tiempo sea una oportunidad para fortalecer los lazos familiares y la amistad entre ustedes y con Dios mismo. ¡Que Dios los bendiga siempre!

"Réjouissez-vous parce que vos noms sont inscrits dans les cieux"

Avec l'envoi en mission des 72 disciples, Jésus explique notre responsabilité de chrétiens. Souvent nous pensons que l'annonce de la bonne nouvelle est le travail des prêtres et des agents de pastorale. Aujourd'hui Jésus nous dit que chacun de nous a la responsabilité d'annoncer le royaume de Dieu... Nous ne sommes pas envoyés pour convertir, mais pour montrer aux gens que nous les aimons.

Marc, Luc et Matthieu ont retenu dans leur évangile la mission des Douze pendant le ministère de Jésus. Luc est le seul qui rapporte la mission des 72. Dans l'esprit de Jésus et dans l'esprit des évangélistes, tous les disciples du Christ doivent annoncer la bonne nouvelle.

Mais ils doivent l'annoncer beaucoup plus par leur mode de vie que par leur prédication. Nous devons transmettre le message dans nos familles, dans notre lieu de travail, dans le monde de l'économie, de la politique, de la culture.

Lorsque le Christ envoie ses disciples, il ne dit pratiquement rien du message à transmettre, mais il leur rappelle comment ils doivent se comporter. Il ne leur donne aucune consigne d'ordre "doctrinal". Il ne parle pas du contenu de la foi mais des comportements concrets des messagers : leur habillement, leurs bagages, leur manière d'entrer en relation. Ces consignes sont aussi valables pour nous aujourd'hui qu'elles l'étaient au temps du Christ. Tout d'abord, nous devons avoir une attitude de paix. «Je vous envoie comme des agneaux au milieu des loups... Dites d'abord paix à cette maison.»

«On saura que vous êtes mes disciples si vous vous aimez les uns les autres.» Ce que nous apportons c'est la paix et non une doctrine ou des dogmes. Notre pauvre monde a bien besoin de paix, non pas la paix des armes, mais la paix de Dieu. Enfin, le Christ nous rappelle que nous sommes envoyés en mission, non pas pour avoir du succès, mais parce que nous sommes aimés de Dieu : «Réjouissez-vous, parce que votre nom est inscrit dans les cieux». Lorsque nous nous réunissons pour célébrer l'eucharistie, nous rencontrons le Seigneur qui nous donne sa paix, qui nous donne sa force. Et nous retournons dans nos familles pour préparer, par notre manière de vivre, la venue du Seigneur auprès des enfants, des petits enfants, auprès de ceux et celles avec qui nous entrons en contact même si ceux-ci ne s'intéressent pas à la présence de Dieu dans leur vie...

Notre mission est de préparer la venue du Seigneur par notre façon de vivre... et Dieu fera le reste.
