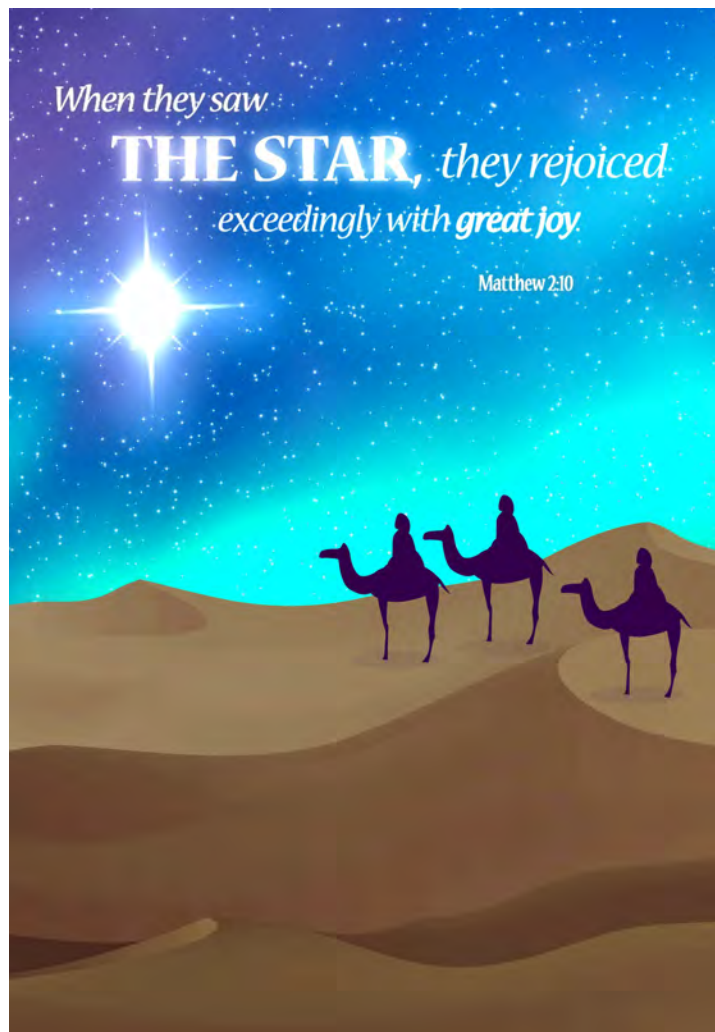

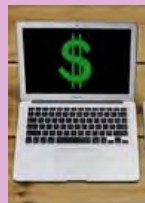

## Message from the Our Pastor – The Epiphany of The Lord

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

As we begin this New Year, I extend to you and your loved ones my warmest wishes for good health, abundant blessings of holiness, and prosperity of providing what is necessary for your family. May the year ahead be filled with God's grace, peace, and the guiding presence of Christ. I also wish to express my sincere gratitude to each of you for your continued support, kindness, and generosity to our parish and to us priests. Your faith, service, and care for one another are a true blessing to our parish, and they make Christ's presence visible in our community.



On this beautiful feast of the Epiphany, the Church celebrates revelation. The word epiphany means “manifestation” —the showing forth of Christ to the world. In the visit of the Magi, we see that Jesus is not only the Savior of Israel, but the light of all nations. Guided by a star, these wise men from distant lands set out in faith, searching for truth, and they find it not in a palace, but in a child. The journey of the Magi speaks to the journey of every believer. They leave what is familiar, follow God's light step by step, and persevere even when the path is uncertain. Their arrival at Bethlehem teaches us an important lesson: God often reveals Himself in unexpected ways and in humble places. The King of kings is found not on a throne, but in the arms of His mother.

The gifts the Magi offer are rich with meaning. Gold honors Jesus as King of the Universe. Frankincense recognizes Him as God and Priest that became the sacrifice. Myrrh points toward His suffering and death as a Prophet speaking the truth. Together, these gifts remind us that Christ comes to transform every part of our lives—our joys and sorrows, our hopes and sacrifices.

The Epiphany also challenges us. After encountering Christ, the Magi “returned to their country by another way.” A true meeting with Jesus always changes us. We are not meant to remain the same. Having seen His light, we are called to carry that light into the world—into our families, our workplaces, and our parish community. As we move forward into this New Year, may we be attentive to the signs of God's presence around us. May we follow His light with trust, offer Him the best of what we have, and allow our encounter with Christ to shape the way we live. May the Lord who has been revealed to the nations bless our parish, reward your generosity, and guide us all by His light throughout the year ahead.

As you can see in our manger this year we have more elements to it. You may figure out what is new by looking at your pictures from the last year. I want to thank everyone once more for any help in all things that we do in our parish. I am always impressed by your kindness, service and collaboration in all things doing it for the Lord. En esta hermosa fiesta de la Epifanía, la Iglesia celebra la revelación. La palabra epifanía significa “manifestación”: la manifestación de Cristo al mundo. En la visita de los Magos vemos que Jesús no es solo el Salvador de Israel, sino la luz de todas las naciones. Guiados por una estrella, estos sabios de tierras lejanas se ponen en camino con fe, buscando la verdad, y la encuentran no en un palacio, sino en un niño. El camino de los Magos habla del camino de todo creyente. Dejan lo conocido, siguen la luz de Dios paso a paso y perseveran aun cuando el camino es incierto. Su llegada a Belén nos enseña una lección importante: Dios a menudo se revela de maneras inesperadas y en lugares humildes. El Rey de reyes no se encuentra en un trono, sino en los brazos de su Madre.

Los dones que ofrecen los Magos están llenos de significado. El oro honra a Jesús como Rey del Universo. El incienso lo reconoce como Dios y Sacerdote que se hizo sacrificio. La mirra señala su sufrimiento y su muerte como Profeta que proclama la verdad. Juntos, estos dones nos recuerdan que Cristo viene a transformar cada aspecto de nuestra vida: nuestras alegrías y tristezas, nuestras esperanzas y sacrificios. La Epifanía también nos interpela. Después de encontrarse con Cristo, los Magos “regresaron a su país por otro camino”. Un verdadero encuentro con Jesús siempre nos transforma. No estamos llamados a permanecer iguales. Habiendo visto su luz, somos enviados a llevar esa luz al mundo: a nuestras familias, a nuestros lugares de trabajo y a nuestra comunidad parroquial. Al avanzar en este Año Nuevo, que sepamos estar atentos a los signos de la presencia de Dios a nuestro alrededor. Que sigamos su luz con confianza, le ofrezcamos lo mejor de lo que somos y tenemos, y permitamos que nuestro encuentro con Cristo modele nuestra manera de vivir. Que el Señor, revelado a las naciones, bendiga a nuestra parroquia, recompense su generosidad y nos guíe a todos con su luz durante todo el año que comienza. ### Epifanía del Señor: la luz que reúne a todos

La solemnidad de la Epifanía del Señor nos sitúa ante un misterio central de la fe cristiana: Dios se ha manifestado en Jesucristo como luz para todos los pueblos. No se trata de una revelación reservada a unos pocos, sino de un don abierto, capaz de atraer y reunir a toda la humanidad.

En medio de un mundo marcado por sombras, Dios hace brillar su luz y convoca a caminar hacia ella. Esa luz no anula la diversidad de los pueblos, sino que los reúne, los pone en camino y los invita a ofrecer lo mejor de sí. Allí donde Dios se manifiesta, nace la alegría, se ensancha el corazón y la historia comienza a transformarse.

Esta manifestación alcanza su plenitud en Jesucristo, en quien se revela un misterio largamente esperado: todos están llamados a la misma promesa. Ya no hay fronteras que separen, ni privilegios que excluyan. En Cristo, Dios forma un solo pueblo, un solo cuerpo, sostenido por la misma esperanza.

Los magos representan a la humanidad que busca sinceramente la verdad. Guiados por una estrella, se ponen en camino, reconocen al Niño y lo adoran. Su gesto sencillo y profundo — postrarse y ofrecer dones — expresa la actitud fundamental del creyente: reconocer a Dios presente en la humildad. Frente a esta apertura, aparece el temor de quien se siente amenazado por la verdad y se cierra a la luz.

La Epifanía nos recuerda que Cristo continúa manifestándose hoy. Su luz sigue llamando, guiando y uniendo. Celebrar esta solemnidad es aceptar la invitación a dejarnos iluminar, a caminar hacia Él y a regresar a la vida cotidiana transformados, llevando su luz a los demás.

## L'Épiphanie du Seigneur (01/04/2026)

« **Lève-toi, resplendis, car ta lumière est venue** »

Aujourd'hui, nous célébrons **L'Épiphanie du Seigneur**, la fête de la lumière : Dieu se révèle non seulement à Israël, mais à **toutes les nations**.

Dans la première lecture, le prophète Isaïe nous proclame :

« *Lève-toi, resplendis, car ta lumière est venue.* »

Jérusalem est invitée à se lever parce que la gloire du Seigneur brille sur elle. Les ténèbres couvrent encore la terre, mais la lumière de Dieu est plus forte. Cette lumière attire les peuples, qui viennent avec de l'or et de l'encens, signes d'honneur, d'adoration et de joie.

Dans l'Évangile, cette promesse s'accomplit. Les **Mages**, étrangers et venus de loin, suivent une étoile qui les conduit jusqu'à Jésus. Ils n'avaient pas les Écritures comme les savants de Jérusalem, mais ils avaient des cœurs ouverts. Ils ont cherché, ils ont marché, ils ont fait confiance à la lumière que Dieu leur donnait.

Hérode, au contraire, représente une autre attitude. Il entend parler de cette lumière, mais au lieu de se réjouir, il se sent menacé. L'Épiphanie nous rappelle que la lumière du Christ demande une réponse : **l'accueillons-nous ou la refusons-nous ?**

Quand les Mages trouvent enfin l'enfant, leur geste est simple et profond :

**ils se prosternent, ils l'adorent, ils offrent leurs dons.**

Voilà le cœur de l'Épiphanie. Jésus se révèle non dans la puissance ou la richesse, mais dans l'humilité d'un enfant. Dieu nous montre que sa lumière brille le plus dans l'humilité, l'amour et la confiance.

Aujourd'hui, l'Épiphanie nous pose à chacun une question :

- Sommes-nous prêts à suivre la lumière de Dieu, même quand le chemin est incertain ?
- Savons-nous reconnaître le Christ dans des lieux et des personnes inattendus ?

Et comme les Mages, quels dons offrons-nous au Seigneur : notre temps, notre foi, notre cœur ?

Comme le dit Isaïe : « *Tu seras radieuse en voyant cela.* »

Que la lumière du Christ brille en nous et à travers nous, afin que d'autres puissent le rencontrer.

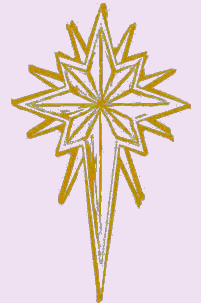
