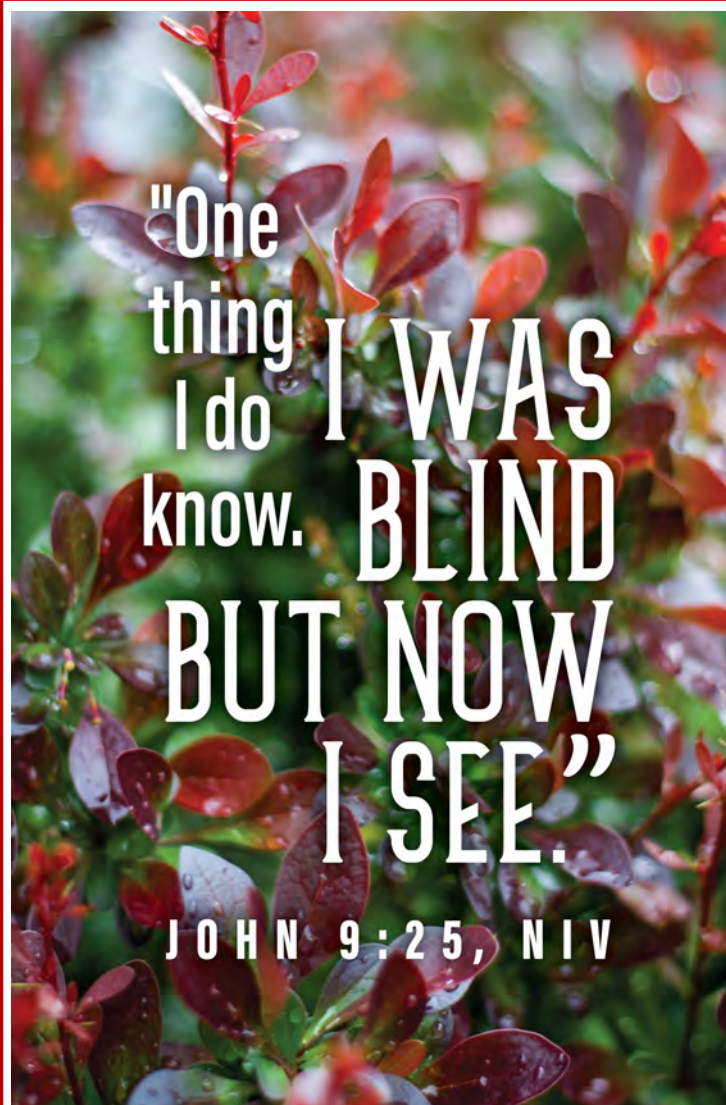

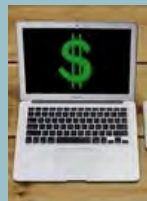

Dear Brothers and Sisters,



This Fourth Sunday of Lent the readings invite us to pause and reflect on the gift of spiritual sight—seeing the world, ourselves, and God’s work with the eyes of faith. In the Gospel this Sunday (John 9:1–41), Jesus heals a man who was blind from birth. At first glance, the miracle seems to be about physical sight. Yet as the story unfolds, it becomes clear that the deeper theme is spiritual vision. The man who was blind gradually comes to recognize who Jesus truly is, while many who claim to see—the religious authorities—remain spiritually blind.

The contrast is striking. The healed man begins with only a small understanding: “The man called Jesus made clay and anointed my eyes.” Later he calls Jesus a prophet. Finally, when he meets Jesus again, he professes faith in Him as the Son of Man and worships Him. His journey is a movement from darkness into light, from uncertainty into faith. Meanwhile, others who pride themselves on their religious knowledge refuse to see what is right in front of them. Their hearts remain closed, even in the presence of God’s saving work.

Lent is a season when the Lord seeks to open our eyes. Through prayer, fasting, and charity, God gently removes the layers of blindness that can cloud our hearts—pride, prejudice, complacency, or indifference. Like the man in the Gospel, we may not see everything clearly all at once. Faith often grows gradually. What matters is our willingness to listen to the Lord, to trust Him, and to let Him lead us into deeper truth. As St. Irenaeus reminds us: “The glory of God is man fully alive; and the life of man is the vision of God.”

As we continue our Lenten journey toward Easter, we ask the Lord for the grace of true sight. May He help us recognize His presence in our lives, see the dignity of others more clearly, and walk as children of the light. “Lord, I do believe. Help me to see.” St. Gregory the Great teaches: “Those who do not know God see the world as darkness; those who know Him see everything in His light.” Let us see the world with the eyes of God who sees all the good He has created, and gave us the potential to do good and seek his will in all things. God bless everyone always!!!

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

En este Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma, las lecturas nos invitan a hacer una pausa y reflexionar sobre el don de la vista espiritual: ver el mundo, a nosotros mismos y la obra de Dios con los ojos de la fe. En el Evangelio de este domingo (Juan 9,1-41), Jesús sana a un hombre que era ciego de nacimiento. A primera vista, el



milagro parece tratarse de la vista física. Sin embargo, a medida que se desarrolla la historia, queda claro que el tema más profundo es la visión espiritual. El hombre que era ciego llega gradualmente a reconocer quién es verdaderamente Jesús, mientras que muchos que afirman ver —las autoridades religiosas— permanecen espiritualmente ciegos.

El contraste es sorprendente. El hombre curado comienza con un entendimiento muy limitado: “El hombre que se llama Jesús hizo barro y me ungió los ojos.” Más tarde llama a Jesús profeta. Finalmente, cuando vuelve a encontrarse con Él, profesa su fe en Él como el Hijo del Hombre y lo adora. Su camino es un movimiento de la oscuridad a la luz, de la incertidumbre a la fe. Mientras tanto, otros que se enorgullecen de su conocimiento religioso se niegan a ver lo que está justo delante de ellos. Sus corazones permanecen cerrados, incluso ante la presencia de la obra salvadora de Dios.

La Cuaresma es un tiempo en el que el Señor busca abrir nuestros ojos. Por medio de la oración, el ayuno y la caridad, Dios va quitando suavemente las capas de ceguera que pueden nublar nuestros corazones: el orgullo, los prejuicios, la complacencia o la indiferencia. Como el hombre del Evangelio, tal vez no veamos todo con claridad de inmediato. La fe a menudo crece gradualmente. Lo que importa es nuestra disposición para escuchar al Señor, confiar en Él y dejar que nos guíe hacia una verdad más profunda. Como nos recuerda San Ireneo: “La gloria de Dios es el hombre plenamente vivo; y la vida del hombre es la visión de Dios.”

Mientras continuamos nuestro camino cuaresmal hacia la Pascua, pidamos al Señor la gracia de una verdadera visión. Que Él nos ayude a reconocer su presencia en nuestras vidas, a ver con mayor claridad la dignidad de los demás y a caminar como hijos de la luz. “Señor, yo creo. Ayúdame a ver.” San Gregorio Magno enseña: “Quienes no conocen a Dios ven el mundo como oscuridad; quienes lo conocen ven todo a su luz.” Veamos el mundo con los ojos de Dios, quien ve todo el bien que ha creado y nos ha dado el potencial para hacer el bien y buscar su voluntad en todas las cosas.

¡Que Dios bendiga siempre a todos!

Quatrième Dimanche de Carême(03/15/2026)

Chers frères et sœurs,

En ce quatrième dimanche de Carême, l'Église nous invite à la joie. Au cœur du chemin vers Pâques, une lumière commence déjà à briller.

Dans le premier livre de Premier livre de Samuel (16, 1b.6-7.10-13a), Dieu

choisit David. Samuel regarde l'apparence ; Dieu regarde le cœur. Voilà une parole essentielle pour nous : le Seigneur ne voit pas comme nous voyons. Nous jugeons selon l'extérieur, selon les critères humains. Dieu, lui, voit la vérité profonde de la personne.

Saint Paul, dans la Lettre aux Éphésiens (5, 8-14), nous rappelle : « Autrefois vous étiez ténèbres ; maintenant, dans le Seigneur, vous êtes lumière. » Le Carême est précisément ce passage des ténèbres à la lumière, du péché à la grâce, de l'aveuglement à la foi.

Dans l'Évangile selon Évangile selon saint Jean (9, 1-41), Jésus guérit l'aveugle-né. Ce miracle est bien plus qu'une guérison physique : c'est une illumination intérieure. L'aveugle progresse dans la foi. Au début, il parle d'« un homme appelé Jésus » ; à la fin, il proclame : « Je crois, Seigneur », et il se prosterne devant Lui.

Pendant ce temps, les pharisiens, qui voient physiquement, demeurent spirituellement aveugles.

Ils refusent d'accueillir la lumière parce qu'ils sont enfermés dans leurs certitudes.

Cette page d'Évangile nous pose une question : sommes-nous vraiment ouverts à la lumière du Christ ? Reconnaissons-nous nos zones d'ombre ? Acceptons-nous que Jésus touche notre regard intérieur ?

En ce dimanche de la joie, demandons la grâce d'une vraie conversion. Que le Seigneur ouvre nos yeux, pour que nous voyions avec le cœur. Qu'il fasse de nous des enfants de lumière, capables de reconnaître sa présence et de marcher à sa suite.
